The competition was conducted for Classes Nursery to VIII where four students from each class

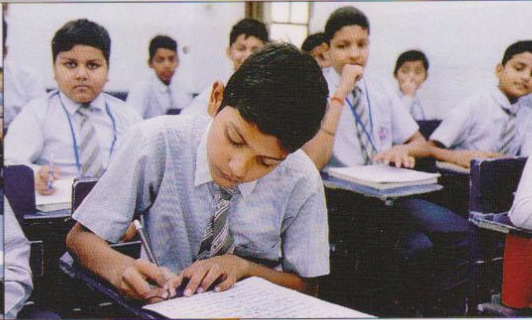
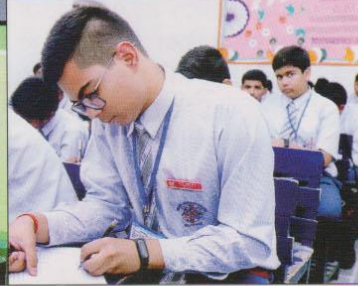

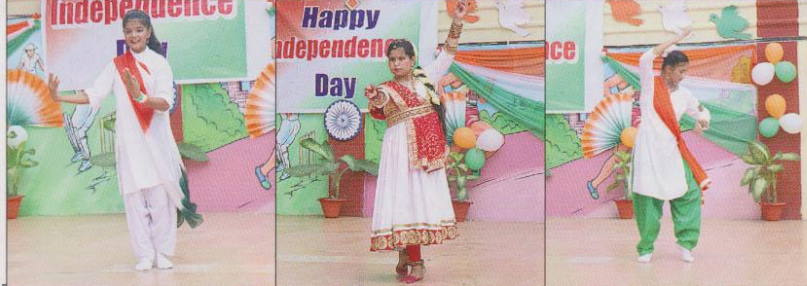
