








National Heritage Quiz



last three years. During this wonderful journey,
with the help of our respected Principal ma'am not only I
have grown professionally but also personally. Now I am
able to discuss some myths about pre-primary teachers
and their classes. Often we hear comments like-

* Oh! You teach Kindergarten that must be pretty easy, right?

 Ahh! Kindergarten is fun; you get to teach them the alphabet!

Oh! It must be fun to play with the kids all day!

 Do You really like Kindergarten? I would have guessed you would like something more challenging where you

* do more.

Are not we used to it? But the truth is different.

Kindergarten is most definitely not easy. You are taking some students who come in literally not knowing any letters or numbers.

It's not simply ABC's and 123's but rather things such as fluently adding and subtracting within 20, decomposing numbers to 10, reading CVC words and much, much more.

In kindergarten basics can be the hardest of all to teach because they are the foundation pieces of future learning.

We teach them the alphabet and that is fun! We also teach them what those letters mean and how they relate to our everyday world and reading.

We also teach them much more phonemic awareness, number sense, patterning, life skills, social skills and more to prepare them for their journey in school and life. In kindergarten, I am constantly on the go, assessing,

evaluating, teaching, helping, nurturing and much more. We do have fun teaching and we do play in kindergarten. However "All day" is a bit of a stretch and I think the term "Play" is not correctly understood.

When children are engaged with centers and toys they are not "just playing". They are:

Building social skills, Taking turns, Learning how to have conversations, Learning real life skills and applications, Reading, Being inquirers, Making connections, Working on fine motor skills and much, much more.

Each job in this world has its place and is special in its own way. I truly believe that we can't fully understand someone's job unless we do it ourselves.

My hope is that these thoughts can provide a bit of a glimpse into not just a kindergarten teacher's day, but really any teacher's day!

Odyssey of my life









After the completion of second round on the third day, the exhibition was declared closed with the announcement of results and a short motivational speech from the Director of CBSE. itcoin is the first decentralised digital, virtual crypto currency in which encryption techniques are used to regulate the generation of unit of currency and verified the transfer of fund operation independently of a Central Bank. Bitcoin can be used for online transaction between individuals. Bitcoin Ripple, Ethereum and other exotics have boomed in the last two years. In 2017, Bitcoin was up 2000 percent (that is, the price has multiplied 200 times) so you might be tempted to buy these. But there are the caveats:

- There are hundreds (literally) of fraud cryptocurrencies and fraudulent schemes.
- The regulatory situation is uncertain. Most nations including India are still wondering what to do about regulating them.

- You will be asked questions by the taxman.
- It is normal for 'cryptos' to fluctuate 20 percent in a single day. You could lose that much instantly. If you lose or forget the password to your digital wallet, or you are hacked, your investment goes down the drain. There is no redress, no recourse. Your money has evaporated.
- Trades can take hours or even days, to conform.
 So may not you know if you have traded for sure?
- If you can handle uncertainty and don't mind gambling, go ahead. Please check first if the cryptocurrency is genuine. A website like coin marketcap.com can be helpful.

changed the props and conveyed to all the students to make changes in their dialogues accordingly.








Trekking In the biting chill of
