1. Nutri-Detective Case Study:
Observe and record the meals of two family members or friends for 3 days.
 - a) Identify the nutrients present in the food items and check whether the diet is balanced or not.
 - b) Suggest healthy changes to improve the diet and add relevant drawings or pictures.
- a) Write a short conclusion on the importance of healthy eating habits and submit the work on the reopening day.

Instructions:

Prepare the activity neatly in the Activity File with a creative title page. The activity should be done for each individual on separate pages.

2. Make an herbarium. Write the common name of the plant, leaf venation, root system and the type of seed in each case. (Five leaves in your activity file)

SOCIAL SCIENCE

The Value of Work Around Us

Prepare a colourful and informative project on the different kinds of work people do in our homes, schools, and neighbourhoods. Show how every kind of work is important for society.

Instructions: -

- **Cover Page:** Design a creative cover page with a suitable title and write your name, class, and roll number.
 - **Introduction:** Write a paragraph on: What is work, why is all work important, difference between economic and non-economic work.
- **Choose and describe 4 workers around you. (2-3 pages)**
Examples: Teacher, Gardener, Driver, Doctor, Domestic worker, Shopkeeper, Sweeper.
For each worker include: Pictures (drawn or printed), Type of work, Tools used, Skills required, why their work is important.
- **Survey Activity (1 Page): -**
Conduct a small survey of 5 workers and ask:
What skills are needed for this work?
How does your work help other people?
What challenges do you face while doing your work?
Suggest any two ways in which other people help in simplifying your work.
- **Conclusion (1 Page): -**
Write a paragraph on what you learnt from the survey and from this project about: dignity of labour, importance of workers, and respecting all kinds of work.

Neatness and Presentation: -

Use A4 sheets only.

Make it neat, colourful, and creative.

Use pictures, drawings, illustrations.

Write in your own words. Avoid copying directly from the internet.

COMPUTER SCIENCE

Create a small, handmade Computer Dictionary Booklet using your creativity. Your booklet must meet the following criteria:

A to Z Format: Your dictionary must cover every letter of the alphabet from A to Z.

Word Count: Include at least two (2) computer-related words for each letter.

Clear Definitions: Write a simple, 1-line definition for each word in your own handwriting so it is easy to understand.

Visuals: Every single word must include a picture! You can draw and color them yourself, or cut and paste neatly cropped pictures from old magazines, newspapers, or printouts.

How to Structure Your Booklet:

The Cover Page: Make it bright and colorful! Include the title: "My Mini Computer Dictionary", followed by your Name, Class, Section, and Roll Number. Add a neat drawing or picture of a computer system.

The Pages: Dedicate one page (or half a page) to each alphabet letter.

Example Layout: Write the letter "B" at the top. Below it, list Binary and Bug with their definitions and a picture next to each.
