Important Update: CBSE Three Language Policy for Grade - VI

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

As you are aware, your ward has currently opted for three languages in Class VI, namely English (First Language), Hindi (Second Language), and Sanskrit/German/Spanish (Third Language), as per the school policy.

However, CBSE has introduced a new curriculum (2026–27) for Class VI in alignment with the Three Language Policy, which requires students to study three languages, at least two of which must be Indian languages.

Therefore, all students of Class VI will be required to study English, Hindi, and Sanskrit for the academic year 2026–27.

Parents are requested to note that if your ward has opted for German/Spanish in Class VI, she may continue studying it during this academic year as a fourth language, if you so wish.
