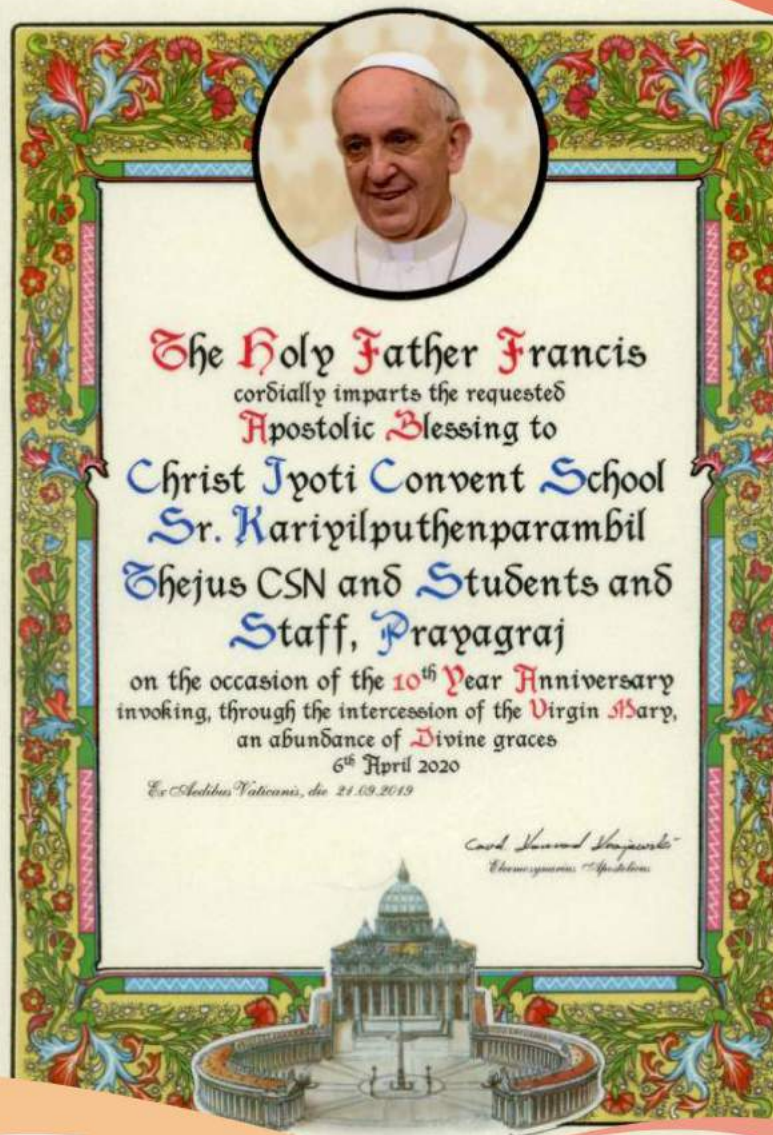

The fanatical artworks by our dynamic and ardent artist are sufficient to get you indulged and dig deeper in the curiosity to find more and more in the quest.

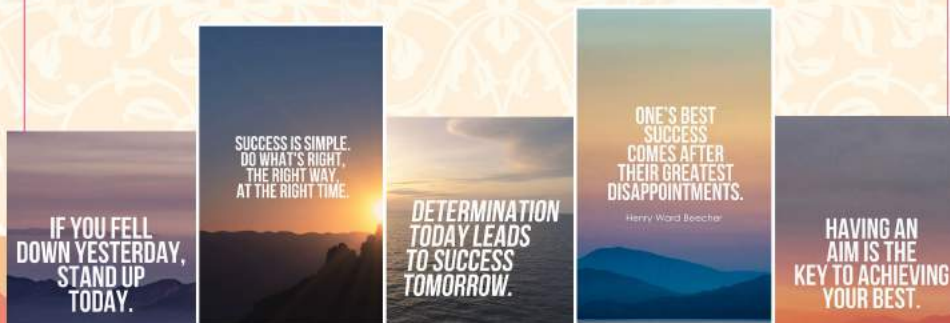

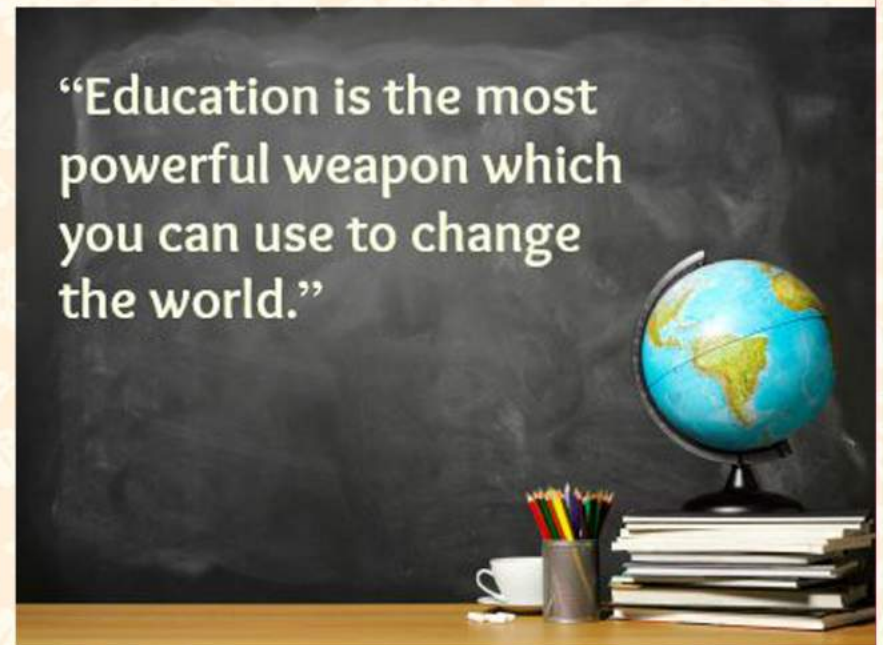
