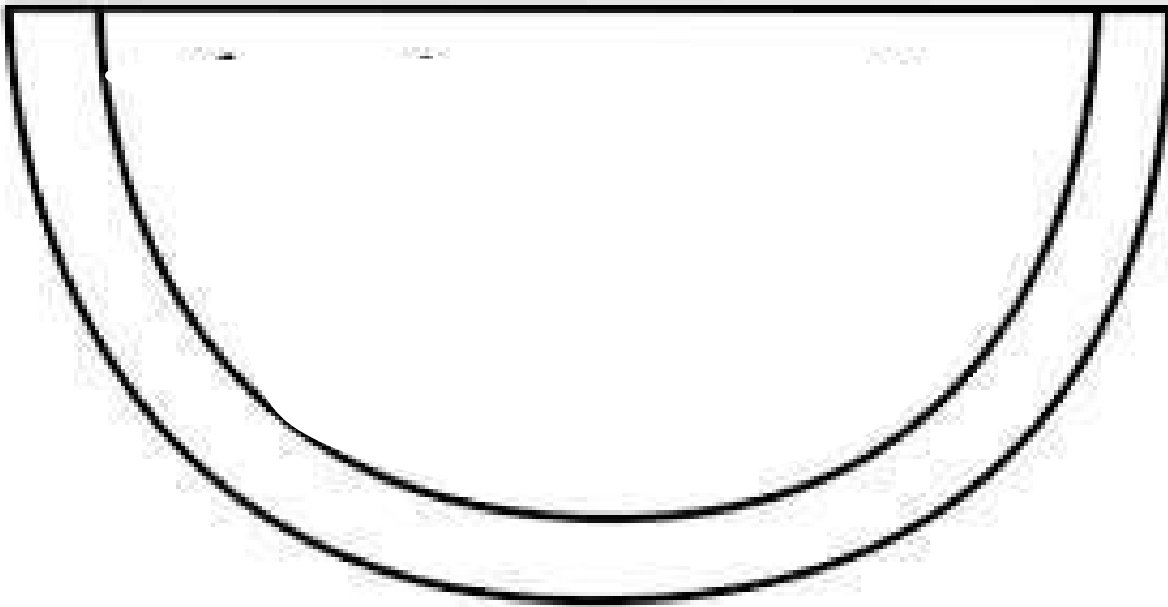
WEEK 1

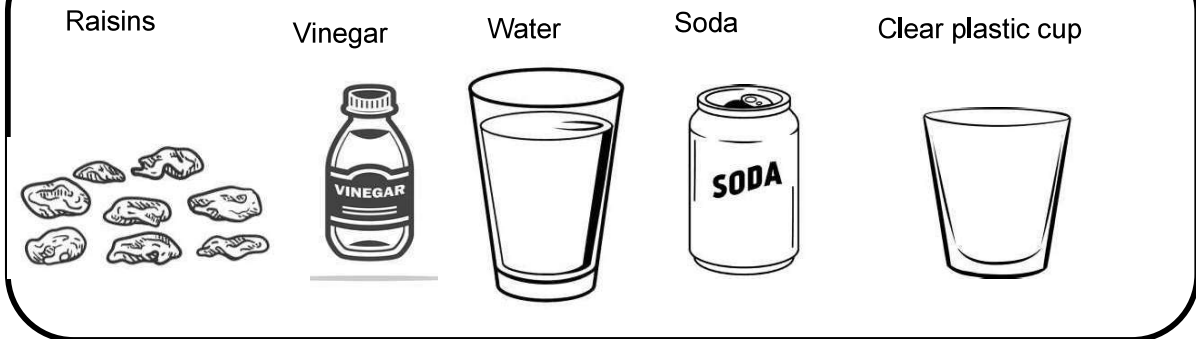
Let's make watermelon seeds with ear bud printing

Dancing Raisins Experiment!

Material

Friday	Hurry! It's time to learn about shapes.	Let's trace different shapes and colour them. (Pg-8)



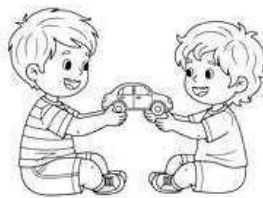
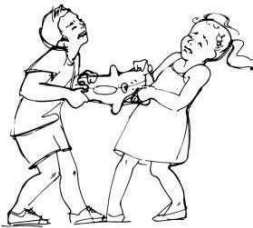

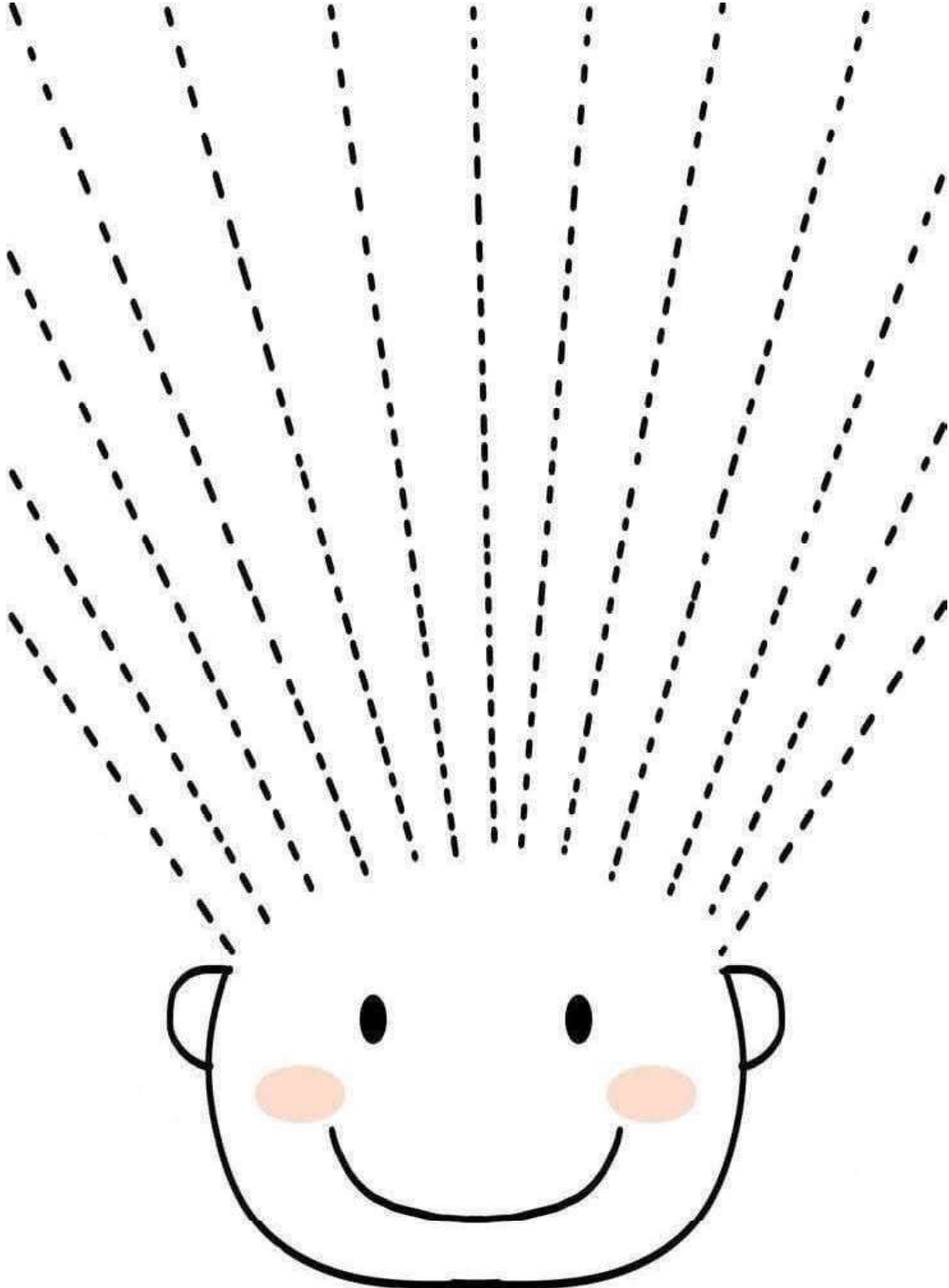


MATCH THE NUMBERS

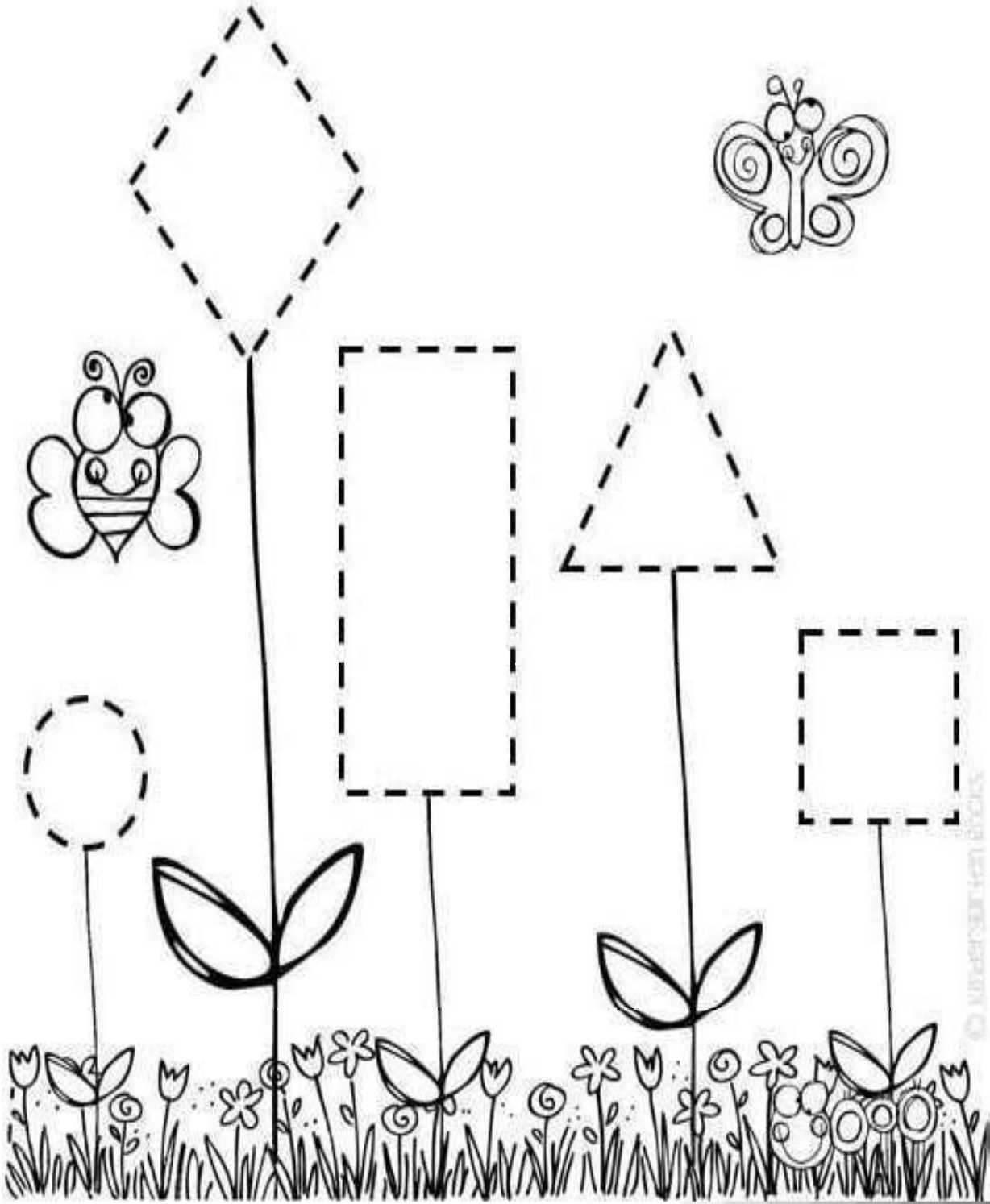
Draw lines connecting each child to the kite with the matching number.

BEAT THE HEAT

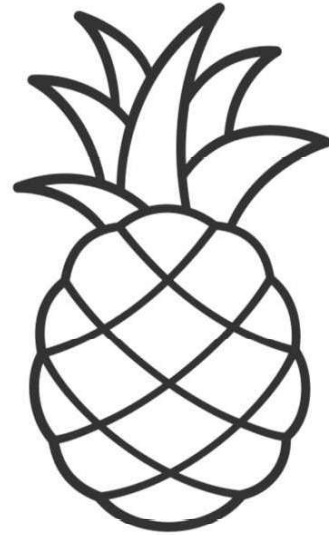

- Ice candy moulds



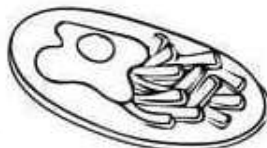
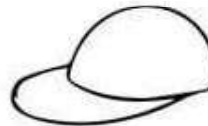
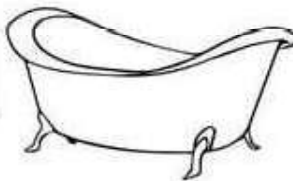
Recipe

- Enjoy your pineapple popsicle.

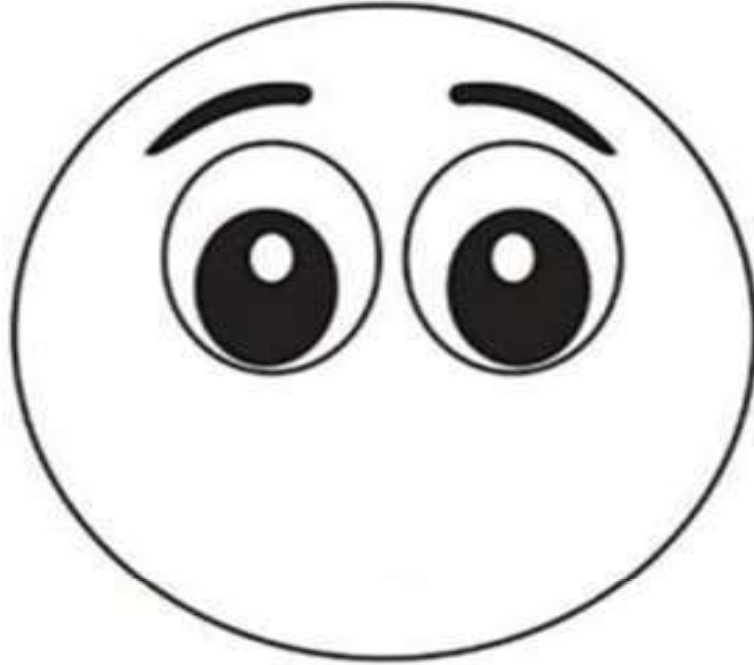
Needs & Wants

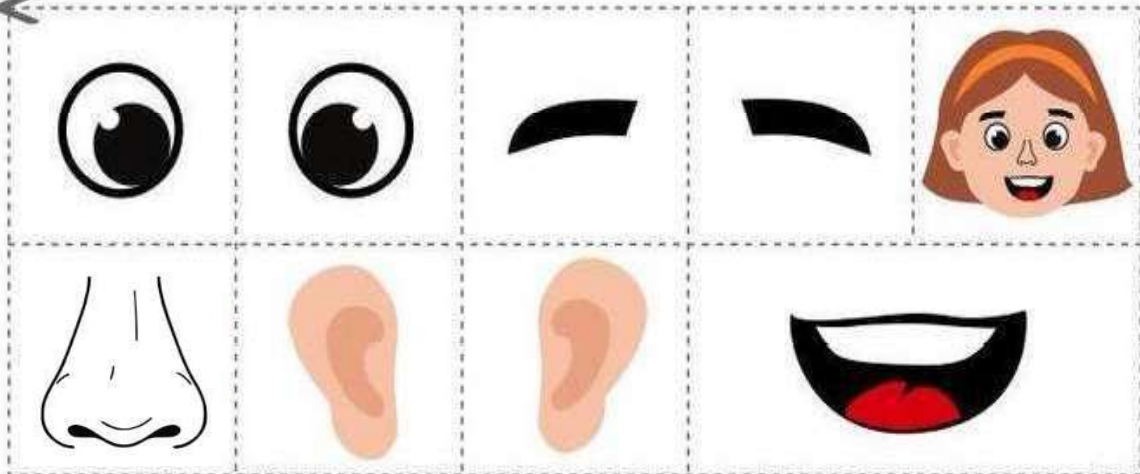
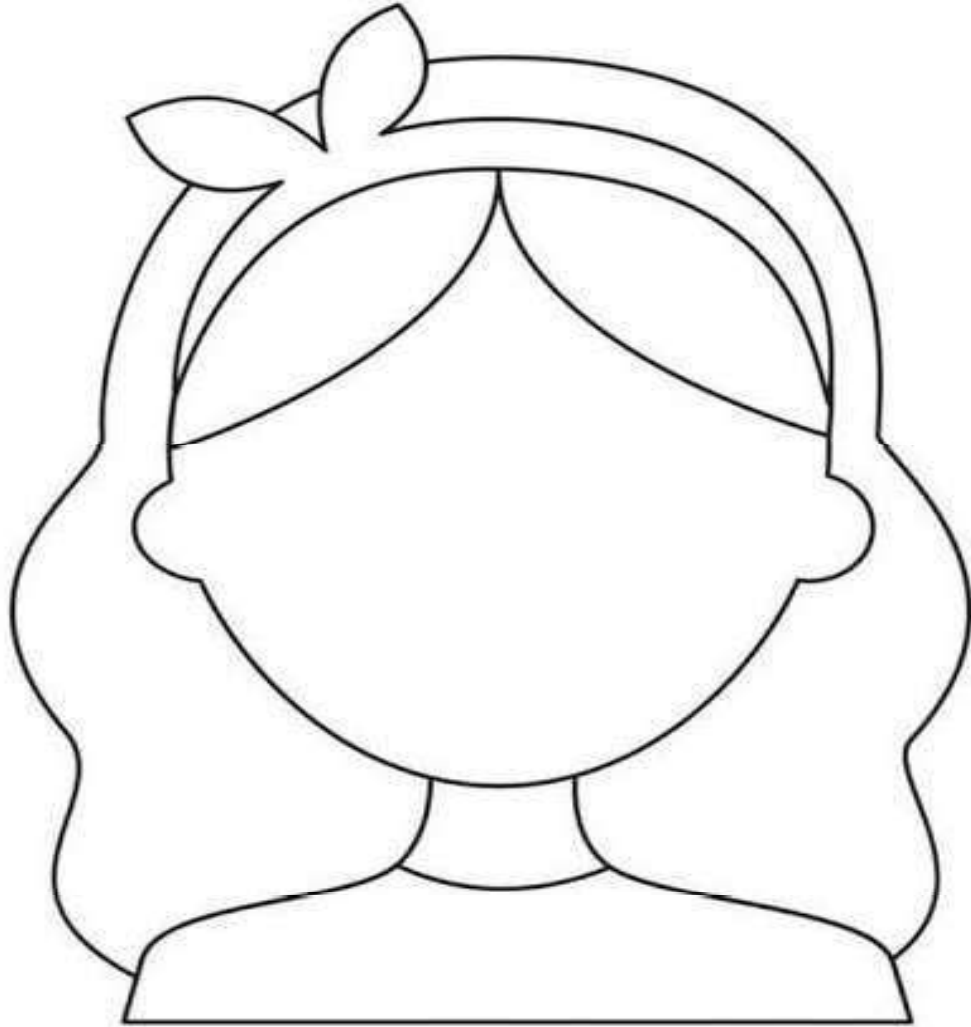

👣 Steps to follow-

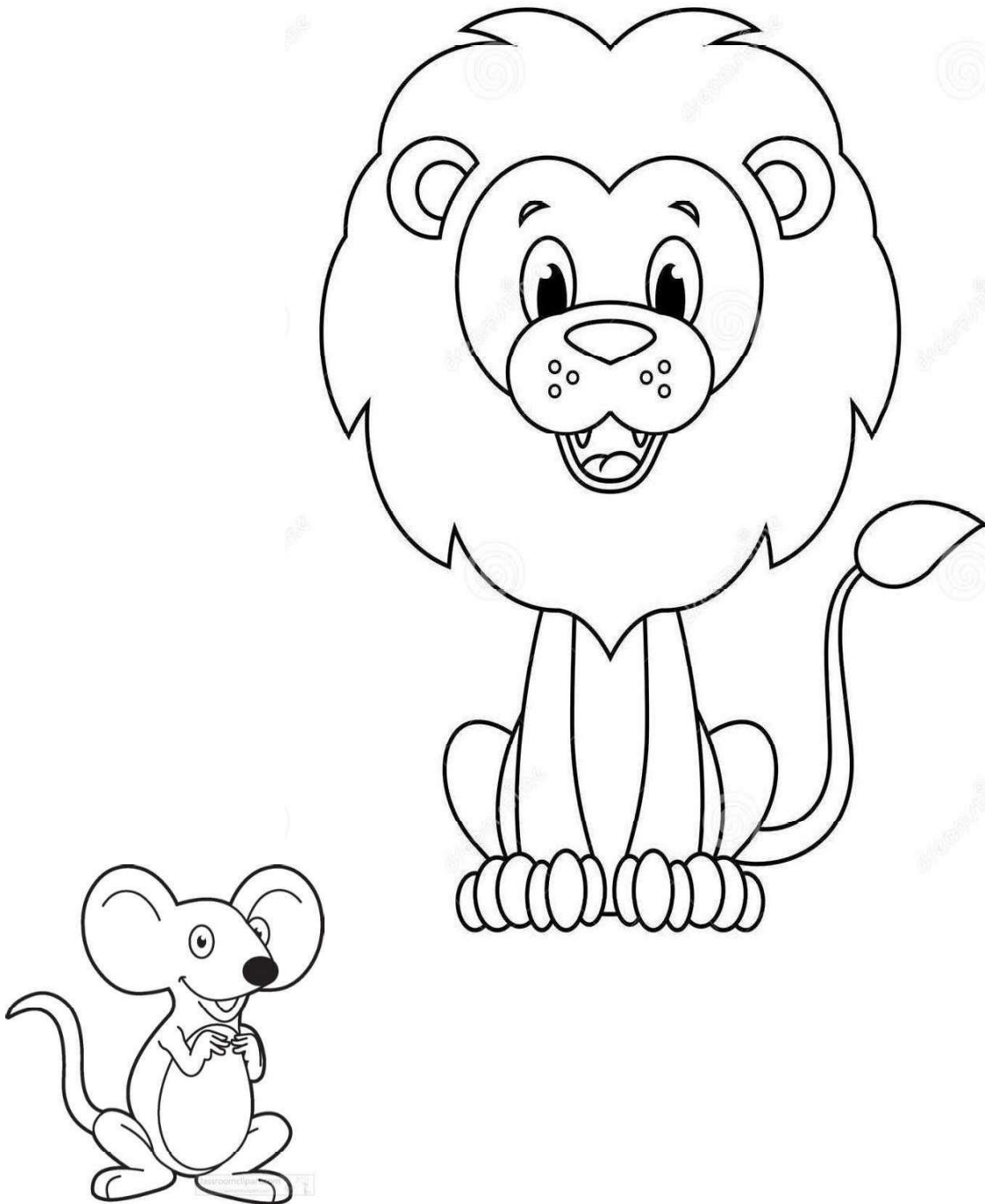
Prepare: Put on your apron and sit comfortably.

READING PLANET

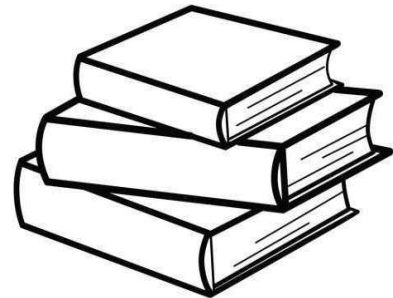


Read... Talk... Explore

- 5. Yipee!!Your face mask is ready.**



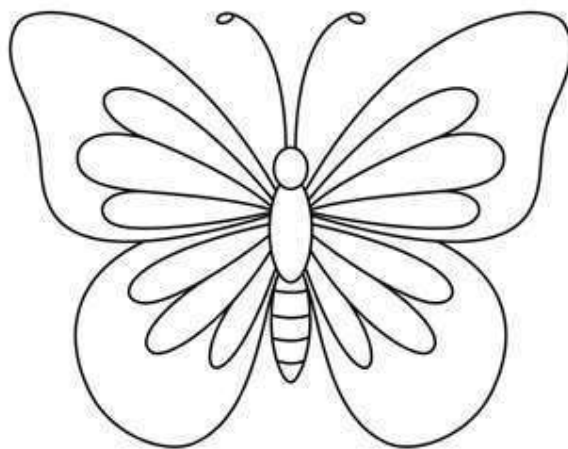

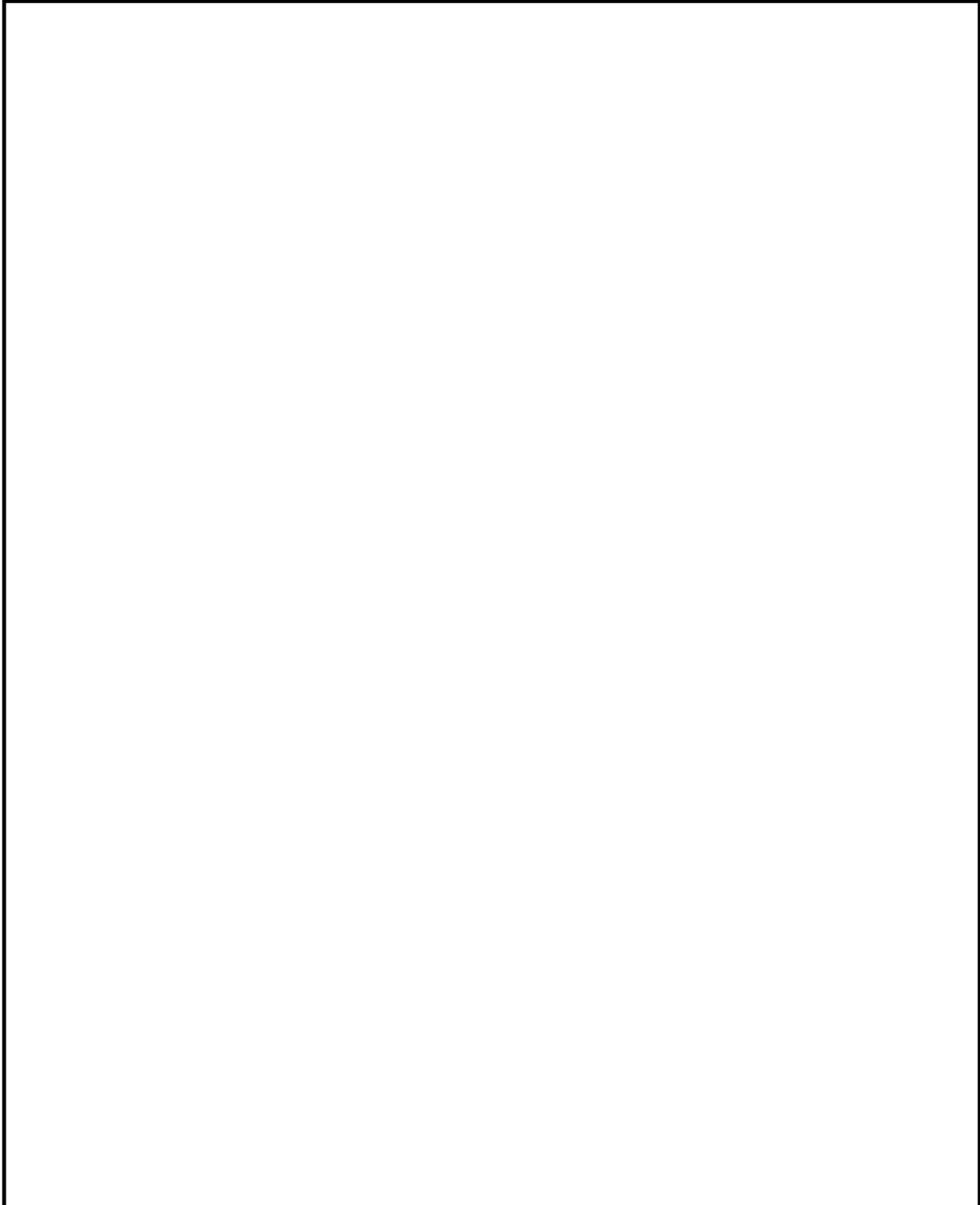

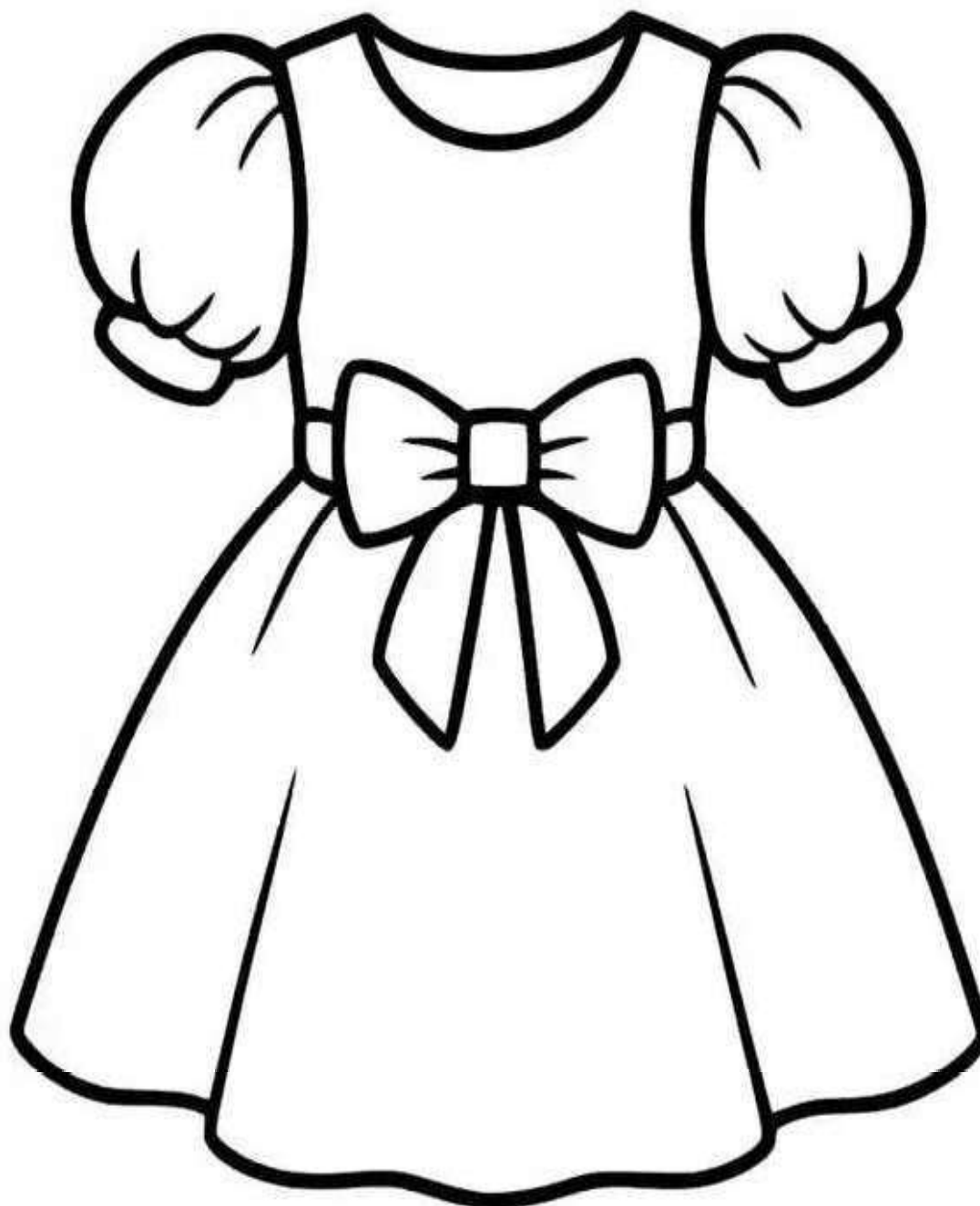
LEARNING IS FUN

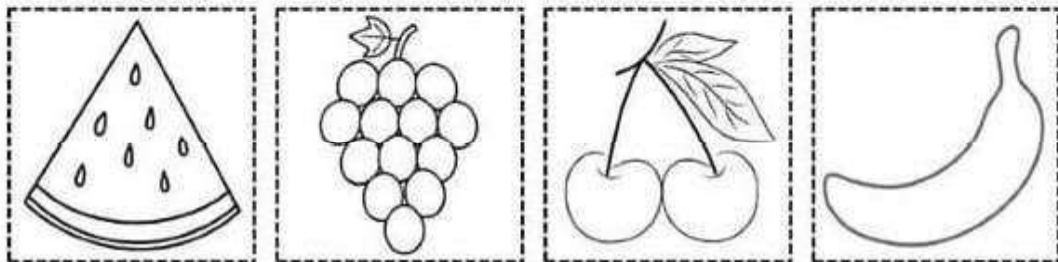
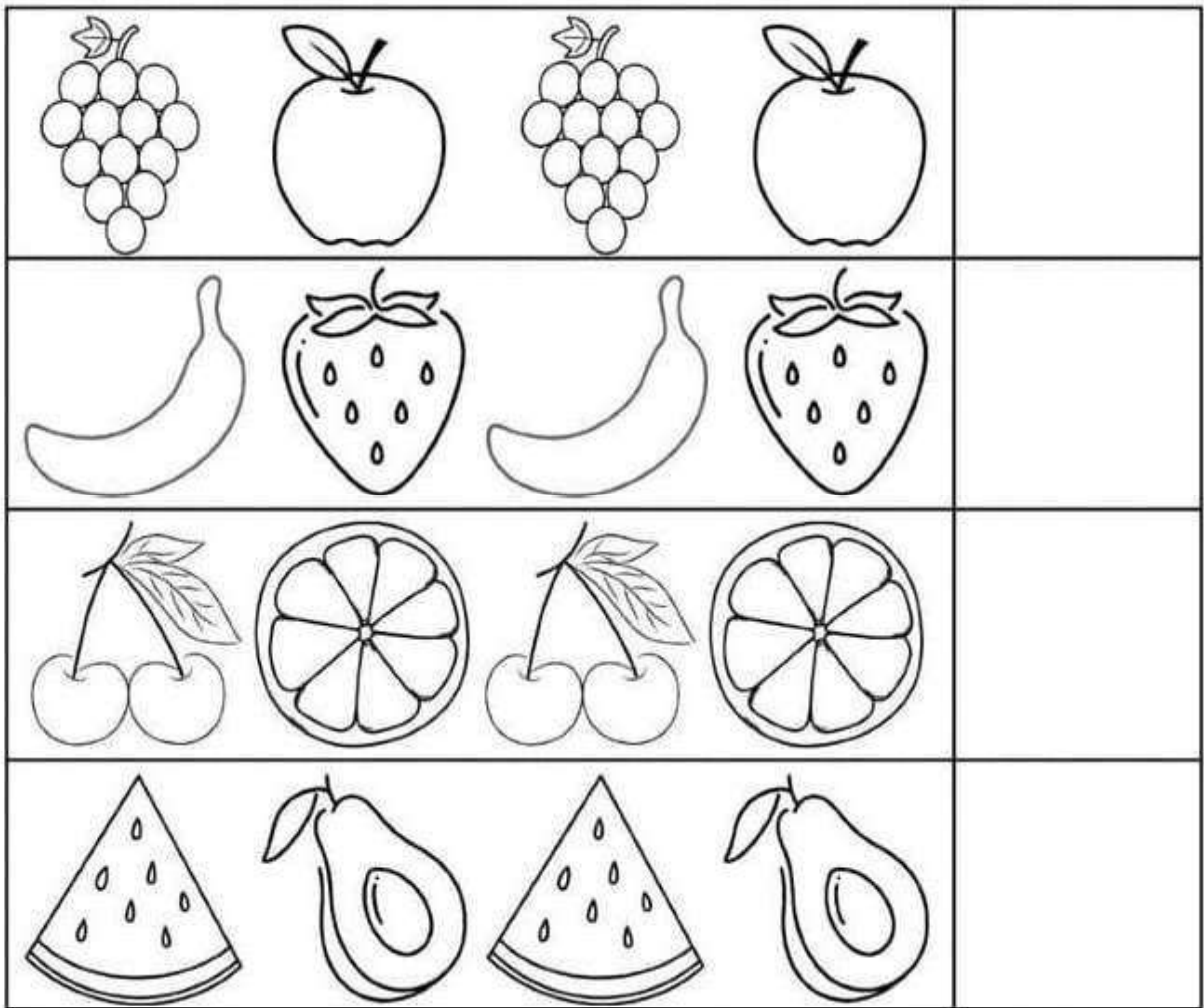

INGREDIENTS:

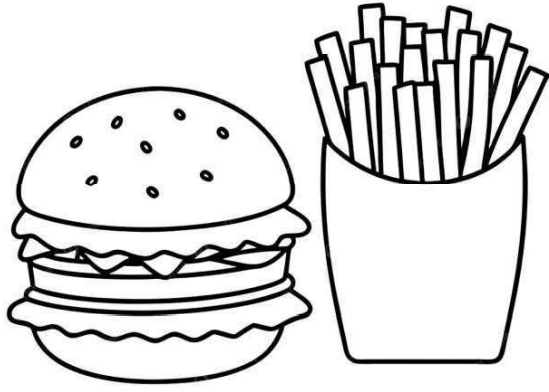
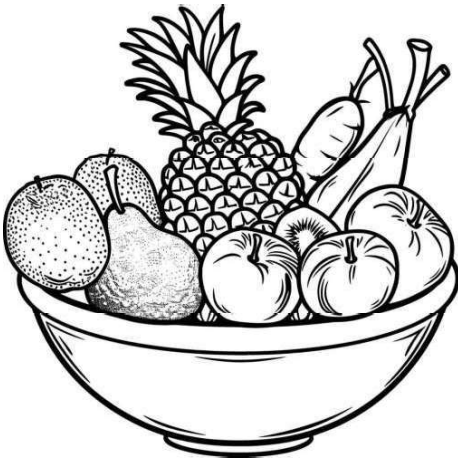
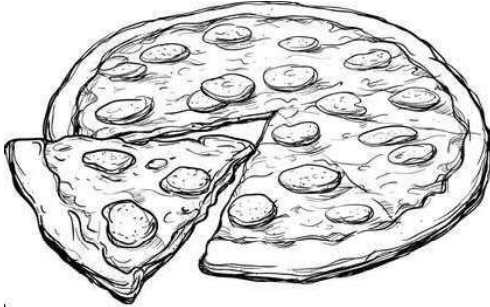
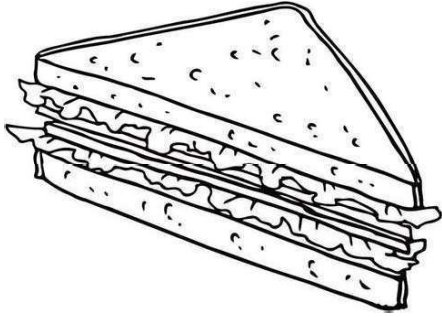
1. Cucumber

PROCEDURE:

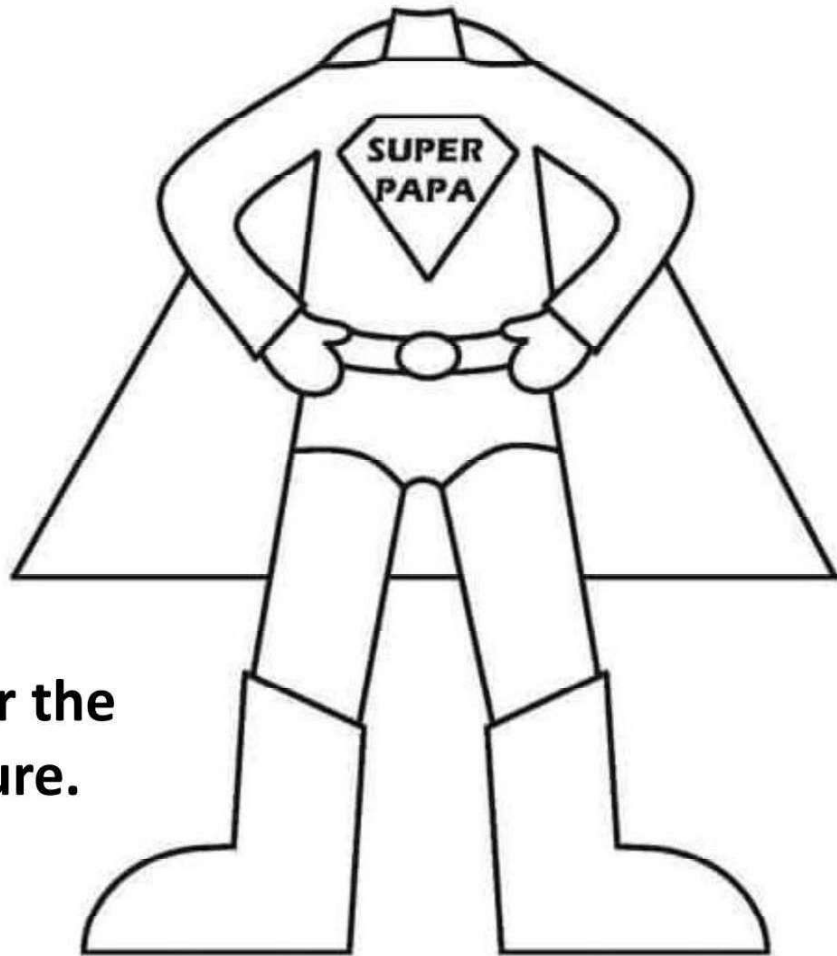
1. Take a bowl.
