Glimpses of **Indoor** SUMMER CAMP

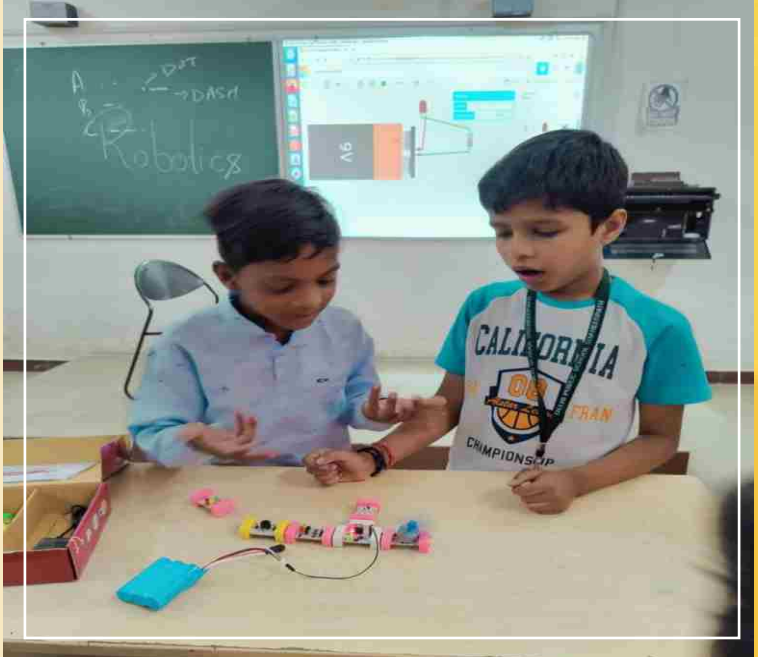

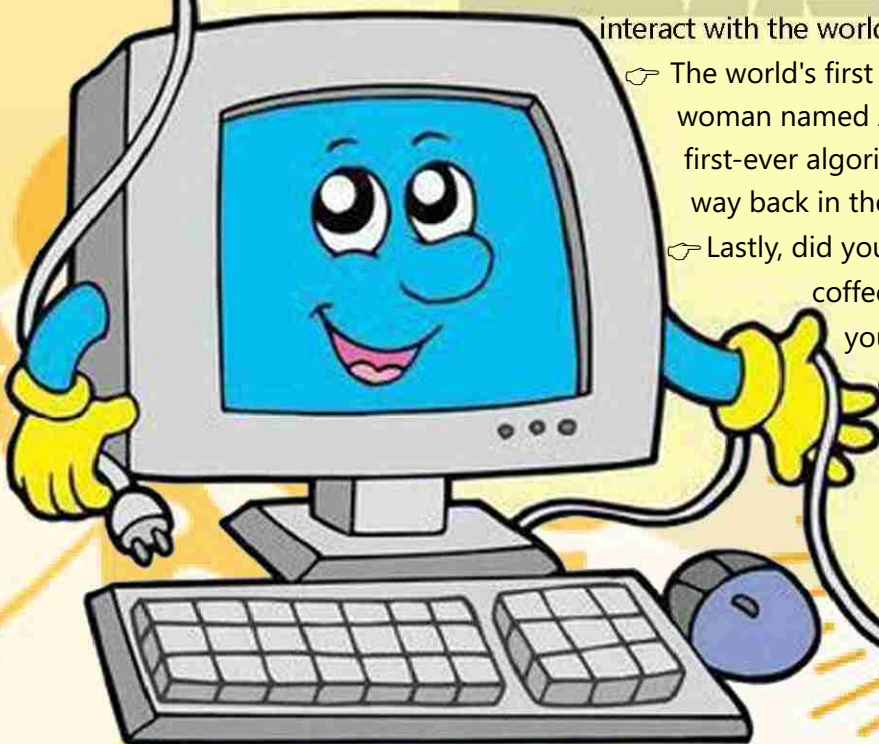

Facts about Computer Science:

- ☞ Computers only understand the language of zeros and ones. So, if you want to tell a computer to do something, you have to speak its language!
- ☞ The first computer "bug" was actually a real insect. In 1947, when computers were huge and used vacuum tubes, a moth got stuck in one of the switches and caused a malfunction. Ever since then, when something goes wrong with a computer, we say there's a bug in it!
- ☞ Do you know how much the world's first hard drive could store? It had a capacity of only 5 megabytes, which is equivalent to about two pictures taken on a smartphone today!
- ☞ Did you know that the first computer mouse was made out of wood? It was created by Doug Engelbart in 1964 and had two wheels that helped move the cursor on the screen.
- ☞ The average computer has about 1,000 times more memory than the Apollo 11 spacecraft that took astronauts to the moon!
- ☞ When you delete a file on a computer, it doesn't actually disappear completely. It's like throwing something into a virtual trash can. The file is still there, but the computer just forgets where it is.
- ☞ There's a secret language that programmers use called "code." It's like a puzzle that tells the computer what to do. If you can crack the code, you can make the computer do amazing things!
- ☞ Computers can't taste or smell, but they can see and hear. They have special parts called cameras and microphones that allow them to interact with the world in their own way.
- ☞ The world's first computer programmer was a woman named Ada Lovelace. She wrote the first-ever algorithm to be processed by a machine, way back in the 1800s.
- ☞ Lastly, did you know that computer scientists love coffee? It's like fuel for their brains. So, if you ever see someone typing away at a computer, there's a good chance there's a cup of coffee nearby!
