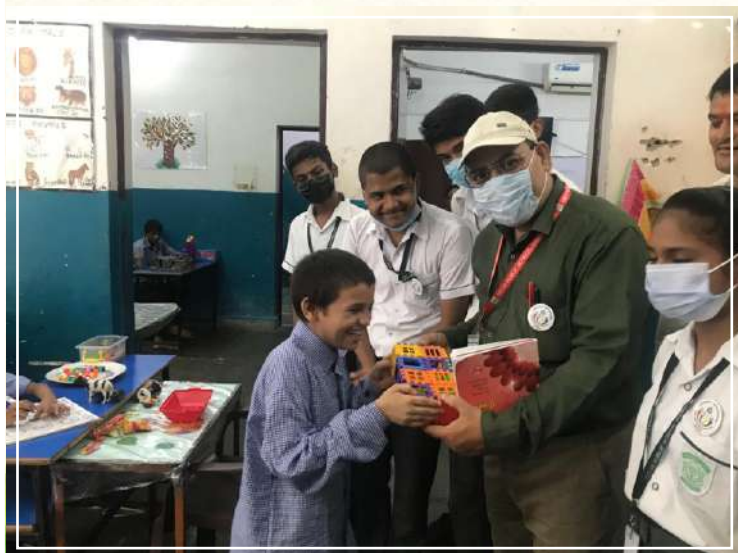
## Proud Moment for DPS Shaheedpath

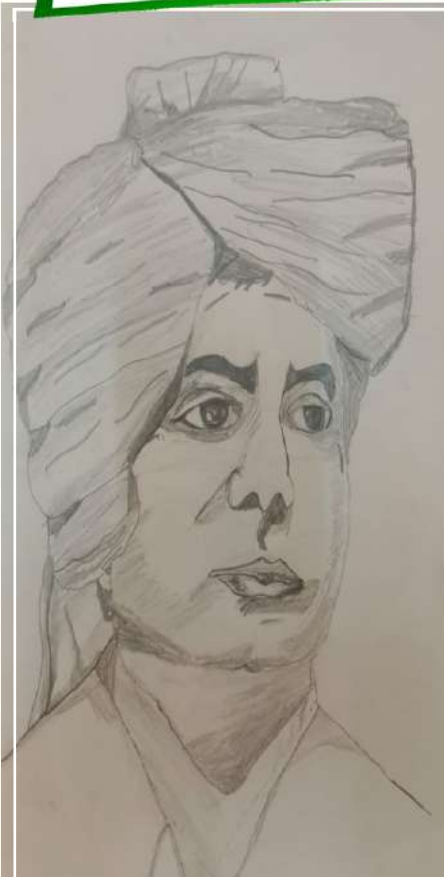

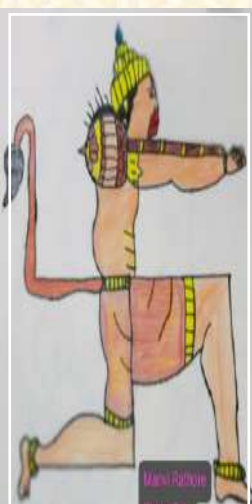
