ENGLISH	<p>Make a comic strip based on a self created story on the topic "Importance of traditional medicines."</p> <p>Present your work in the form of a storyboard on an A3 sheet.</p>

By completing this project students will not only learn different types of math puzzles and games but also develop their creativity, problem solving skills and presentation skills.</p>
SCIENCE	<p>Project Topic: Study of plants which are used to make Traditional Medicines in the states of Arunachal Pradesh and Meghalaya</p> <p>Prepare a collage on an A3 sheet about the medicinal plants of the above mentioned states.</p> <p>The collage should provide sufficient information about those plants (minimum 2-3 plants) including their botanical/scientific name, native/local name (to be written in their local font), what purpose they are used for, which part of the plant is used as medicine, how it is extracted, any specific conditions required for their growth (soil and climate type, water requirement etc.) You may include any other additional information about the medicinal plants, if available.</p>

	<p>A Step Further: Additional/extra weightage will be given if students can collect the sapling of the plant/s and include photographs of the place of collection, nurturing etc. into their collage.</p>
