Ans. Festivals provide occasions for people to come together to spend time with their family and friends in moments of celebration, joy and togetherness.

(c) What special dresses are worn during festivals?

Ans. During festivals, people often wear traditional and ethnic dresses like sarees, kurtas, lehengas, and salwar kameez, that reflects our cultural traditions.

(d) What special foods are prepared during festivals?

Ans. In different festivals, people make different special foods like *gujiya* on Holi, *seviyan* on Eid, *pitha* on Bihu, *thekua* on Chhath Puja, *sadya* on Onam, *holige* on Ugadi, plum cake on Christmas, etc.
