

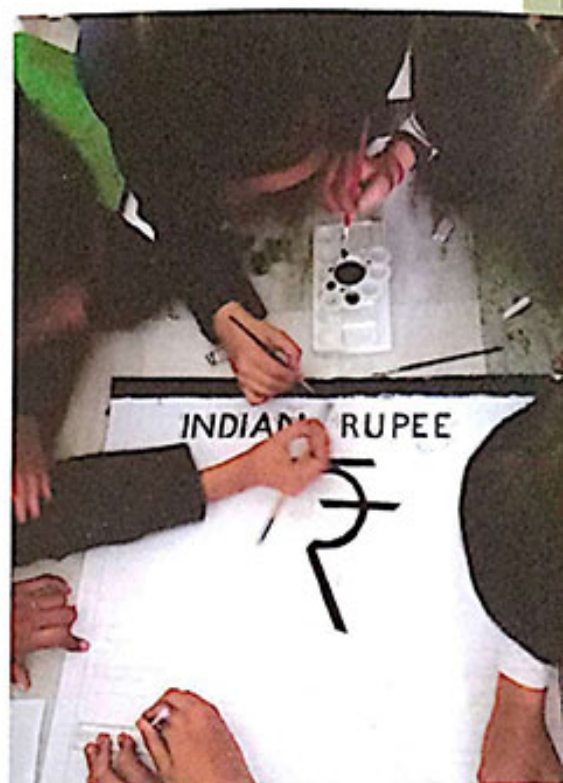
## Report on Quiz Competition

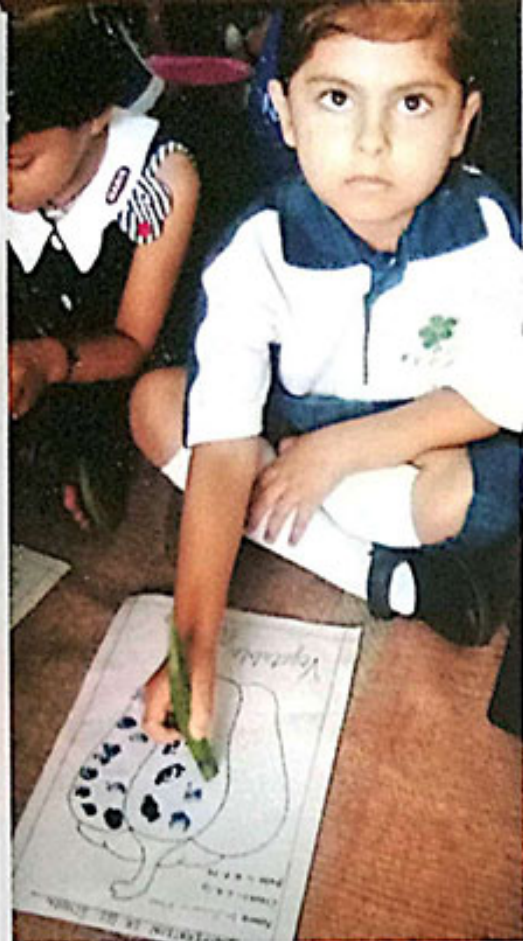

Nursery- shape of Brinjal

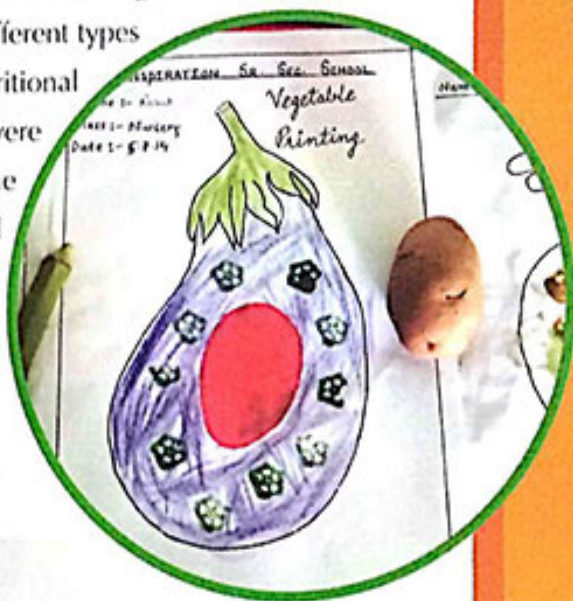
LKG- Shape of Capsicum

Everybody enjoyed the performances by the tiny tots. There were three winners from each class. Winners were awarded with medals and certificates. Beautiful atmosphere was created.

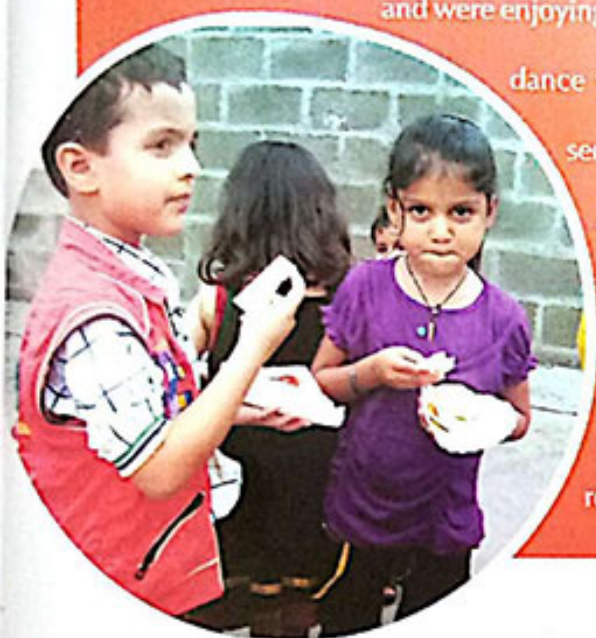




# SANDWICH PARTY

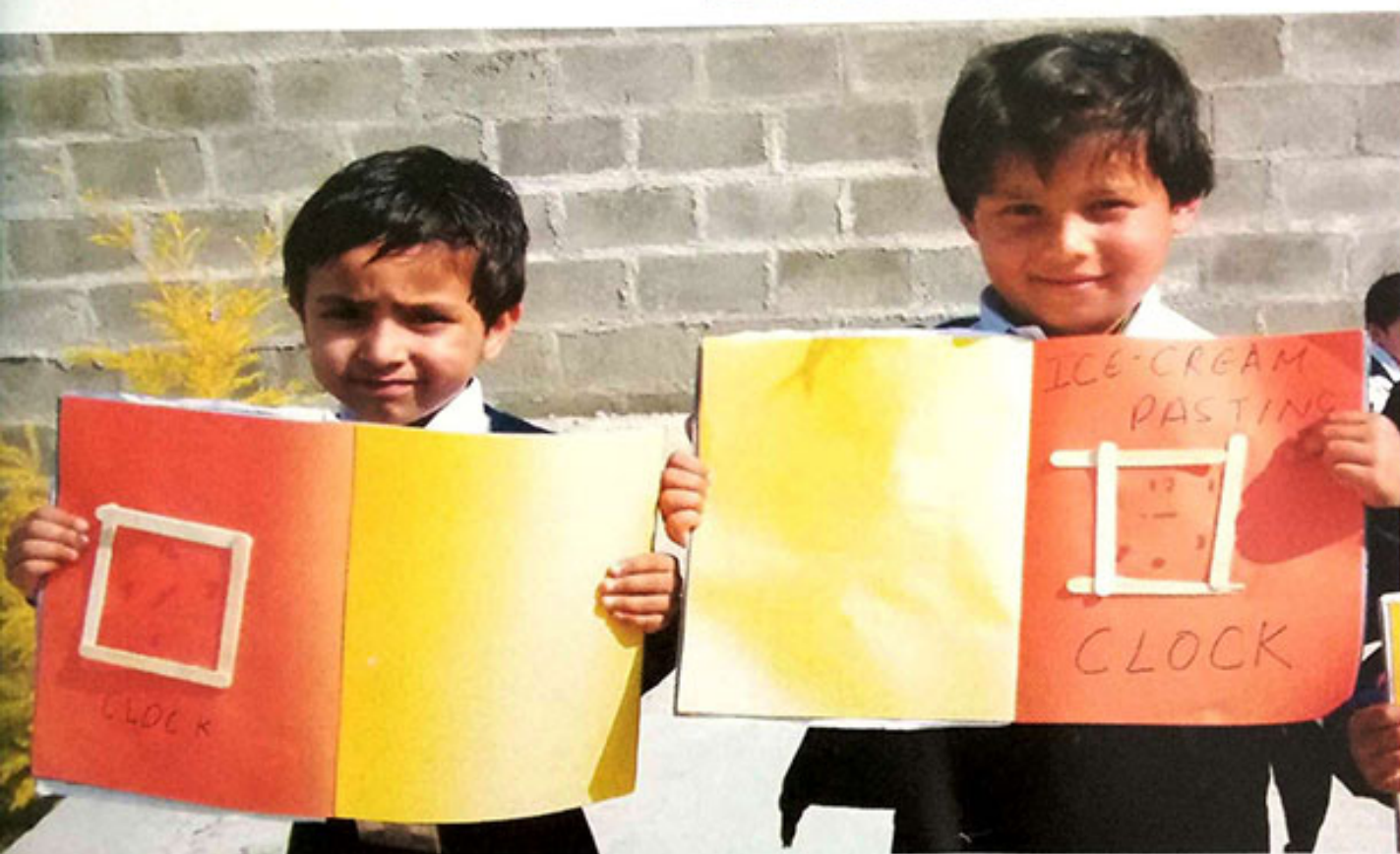

## English Essay Writing Competition

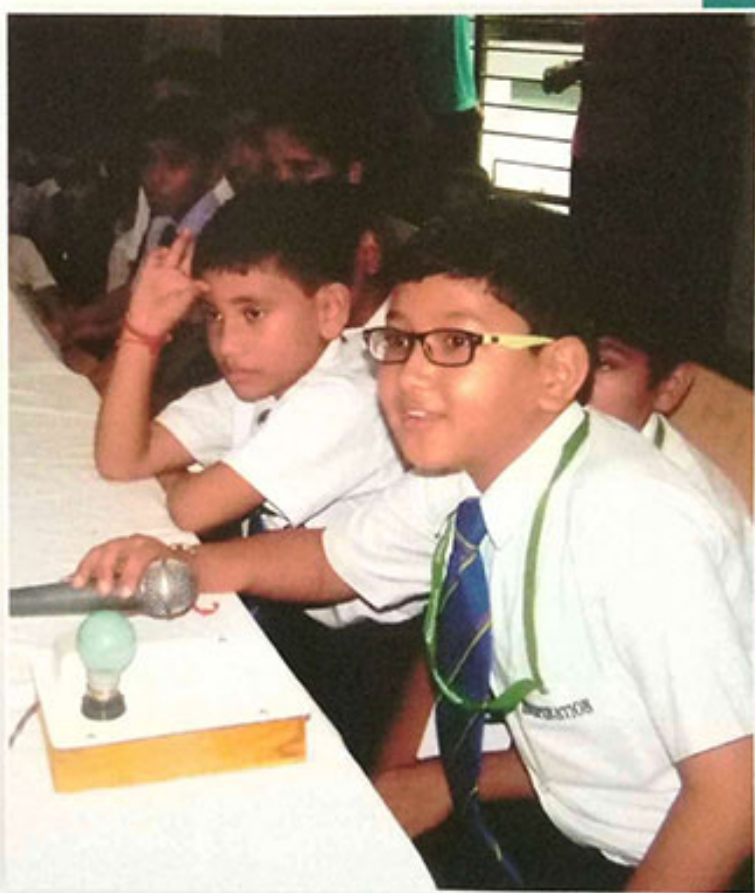

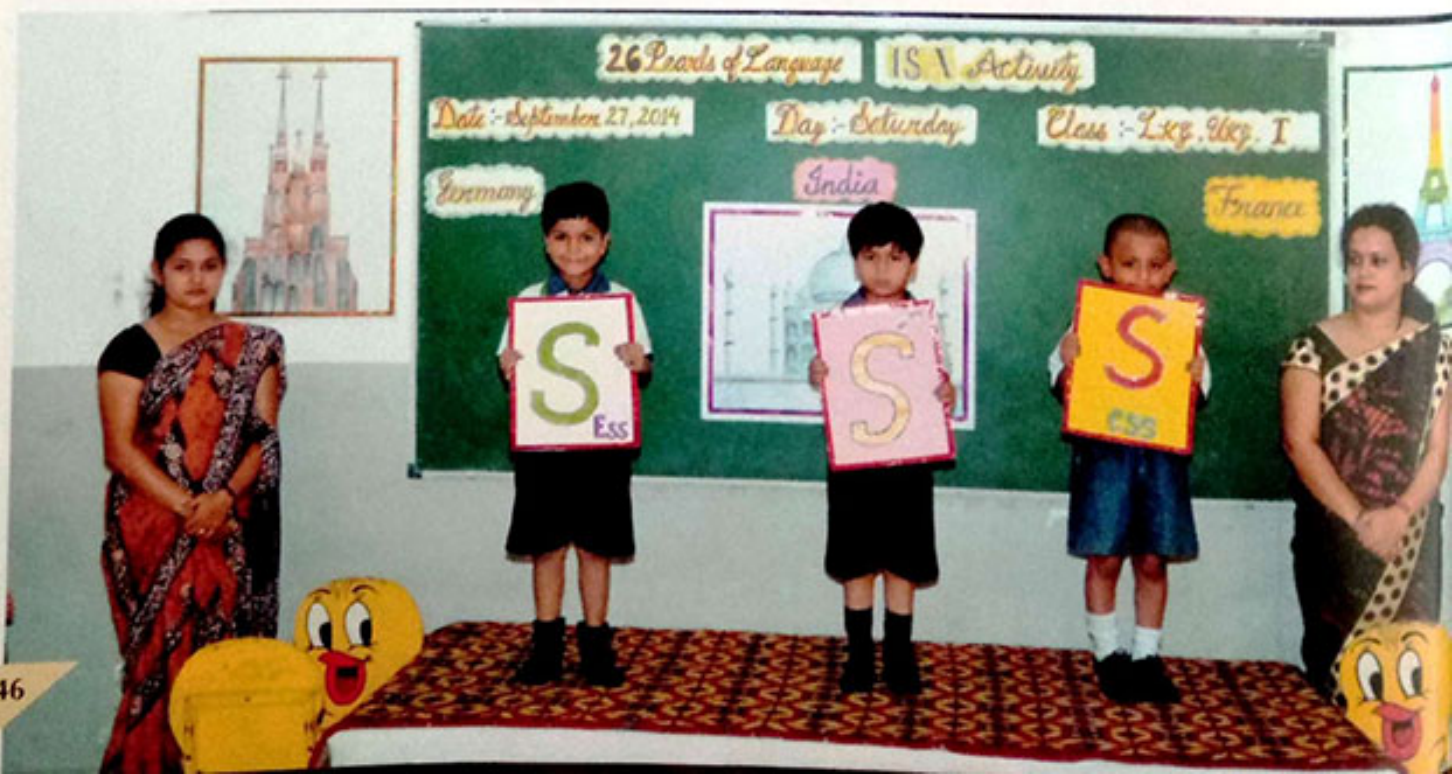




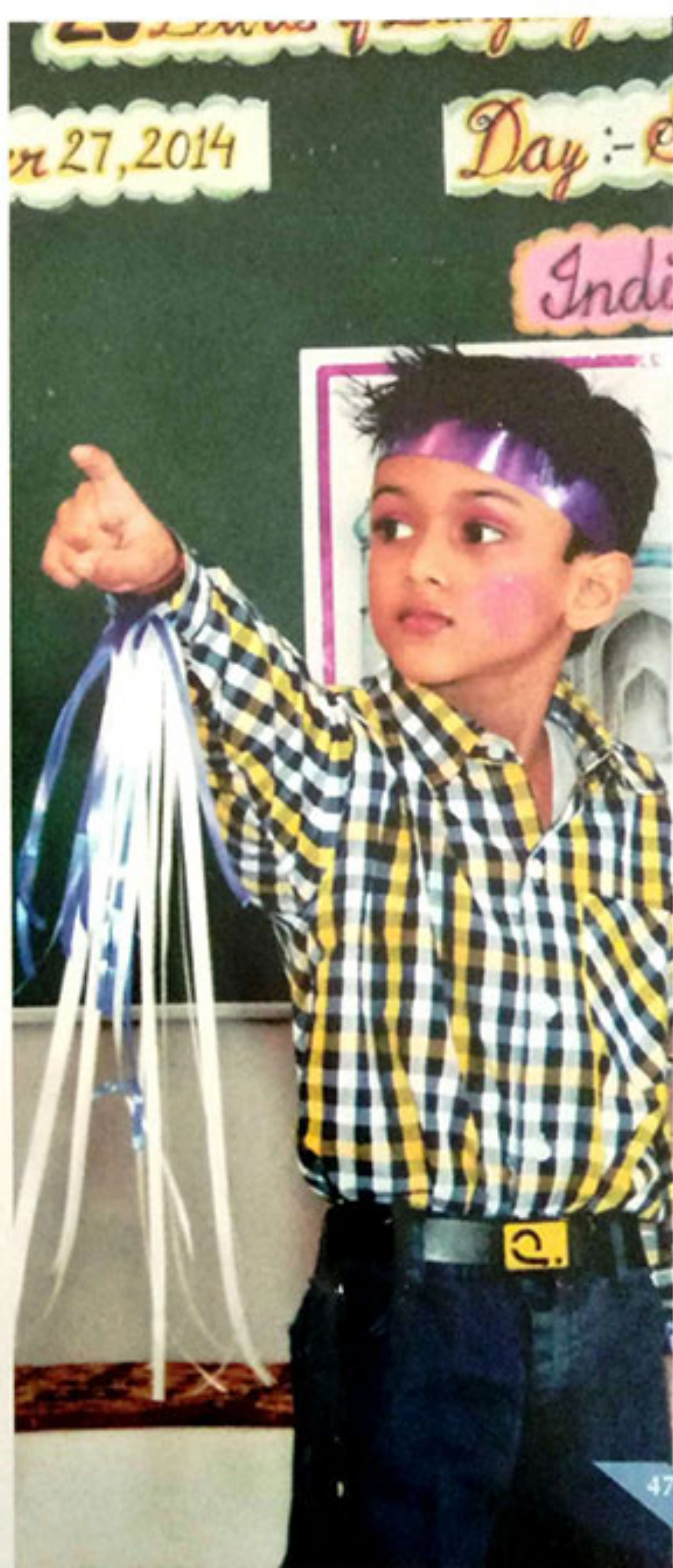


## 26 Pearls of Language

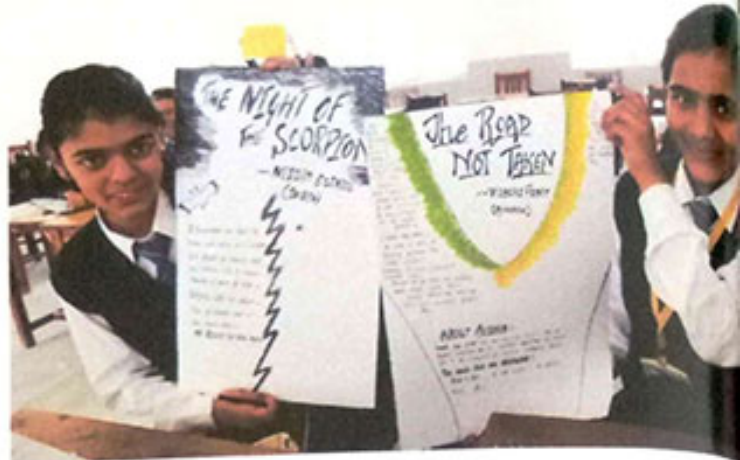




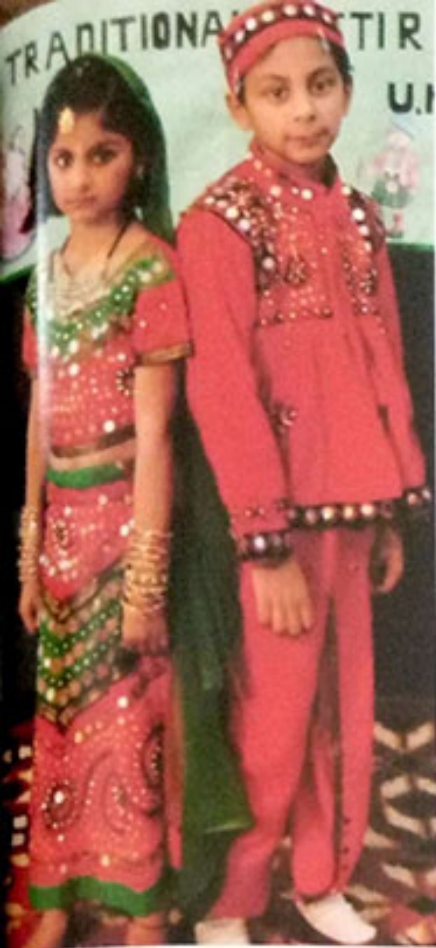


# Distinguished Contribution of Poets across the globe

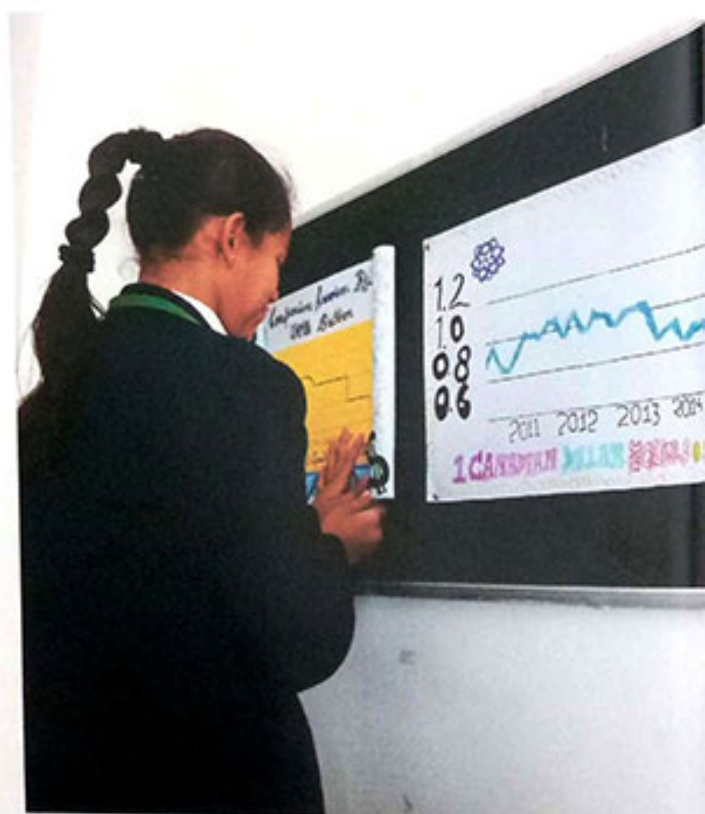
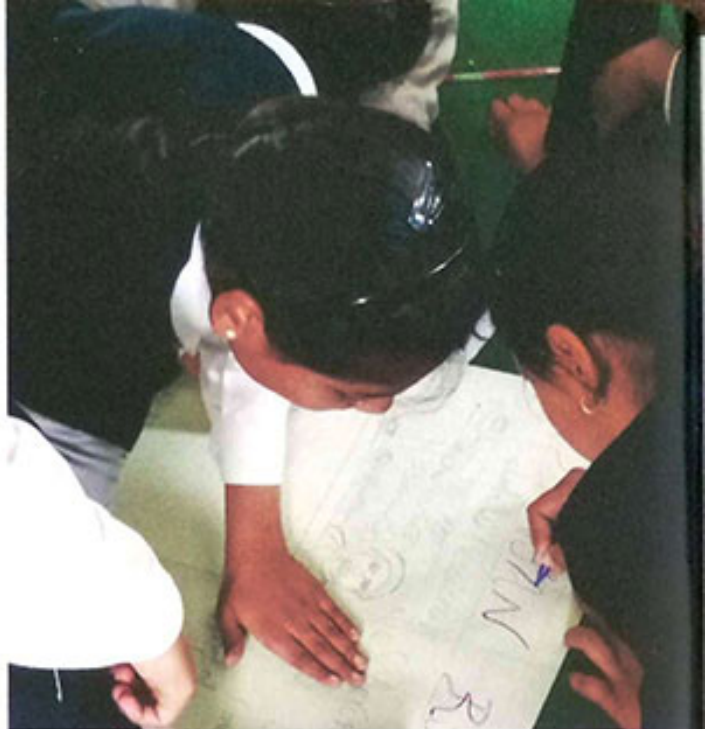

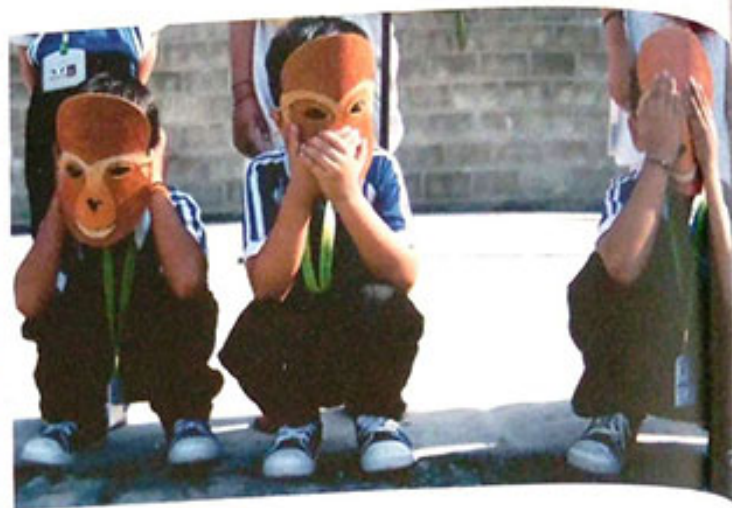

## Christmas Day

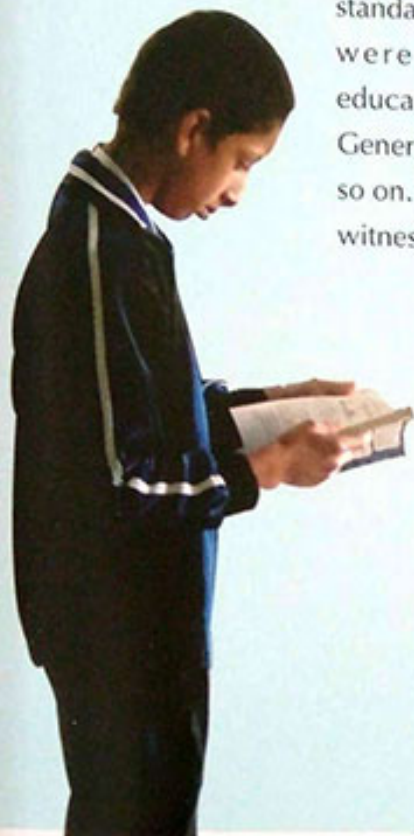

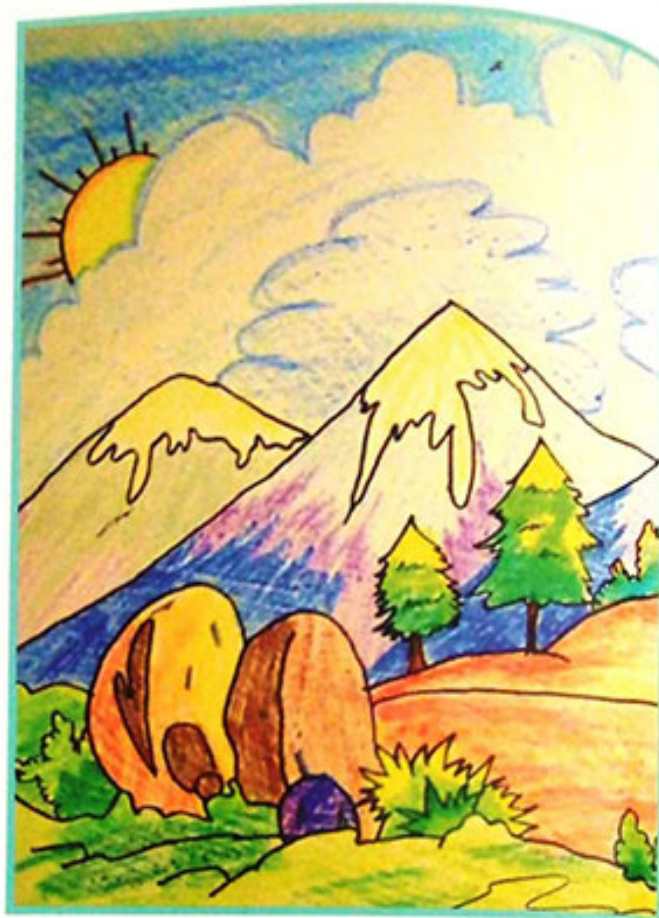
## हिमालय रो रहा है

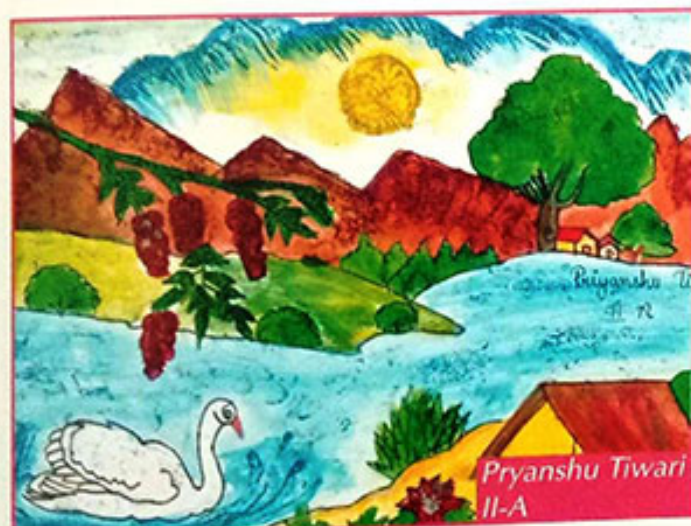

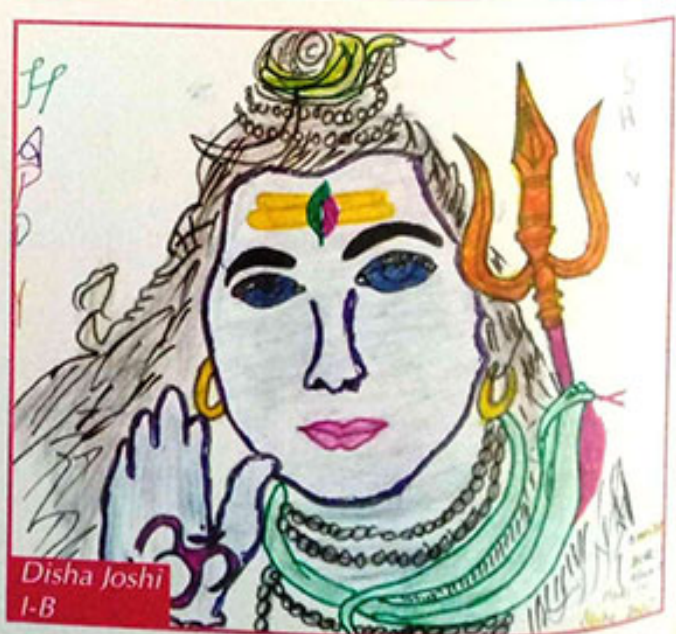
