I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of Inspiration Public School documenting its developments and achievements. The year 2016-17 was marked with many events and success stories. Our students set standards and goals for themselves and strive to achieve them and it has been proved by Prakrati Joshi and Rahul Bhatt of class XII (2015-16) by qualifying Medical Entrance Exam and by our Mathematicians Suyash Mahar, Amulya Gaur and Nikhil Singh, who qualified JEE Advance 2016 with flying colours.

Ayushii Balutia (XII C), Ashish Agarwal (XII C), Tushar Dauthal (XII A) and Abhishek Joshi (XI C) represented the school at Birla Vidya Mandir, Nainital in Inter School 'Business Quiz' and brought laurels by winning the trophy.

In keeping with the schools policy of continuous up gradation of knowledge and skills various workshops and seminars are organized time to time for students and teachers as well. X-seed has been included in the curriculum for better learning of

juniors. CPD, a teacher's training programme by QEA had been a part of the session for the teachers to improve their academic transaction skills and to update their capabilities. Workshops and motivating sessions organized by TWIN-WIN for students provided ample

opportunities to them to show their caliber and to develop their personality. Harsh Joshi has been acknowledged as an exceptionally talented child in the Twin-Win session. The school has two fully equipped Computer Labs, Mathematics Lab along with Science Labs. Teach Next smart boards are installed in class rooms, the content is updated time to time. Participation in the Science, Math and English Olympiad itself is the biggest competition where a student competes to outshine others. It infuses a healthy competitive spirit through reward based assessment.

Sports competitions inculcate the spirit of positive challenges and sportsmanship among the students and prepare them for the life ahead. 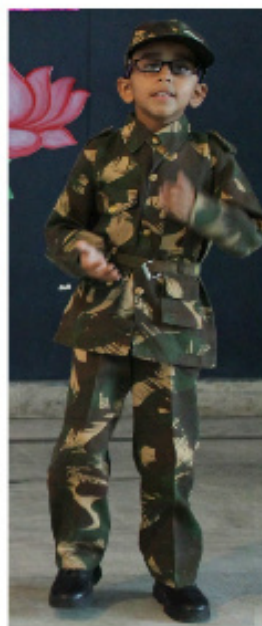

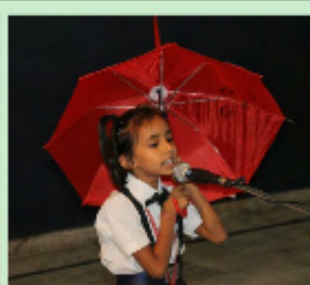




## Who's the best *Orator?*

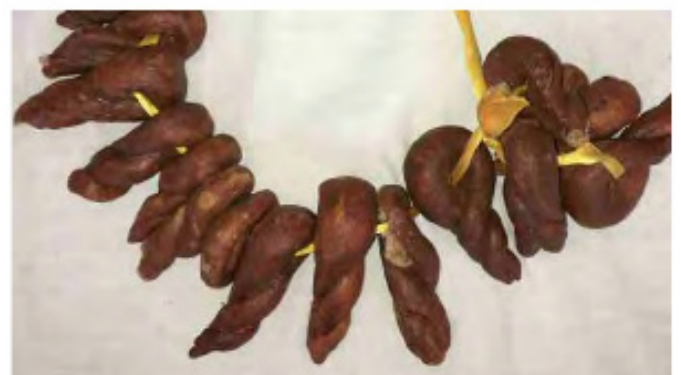


## Respecting Culture - The Traditional Display of Uttarakhand

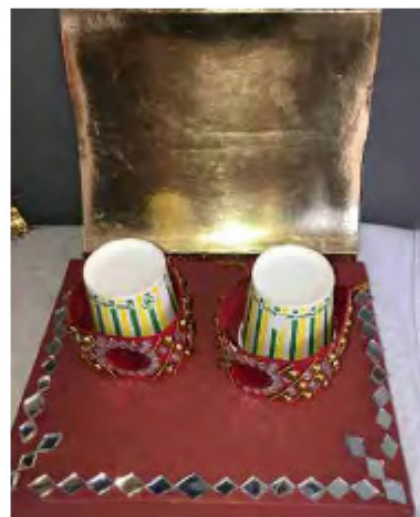
