Day to Night

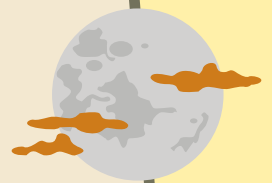


5 o'clock the sun rises

Bhola cyclone 1970

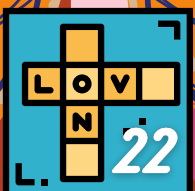
~The nightmare of Bangladesh

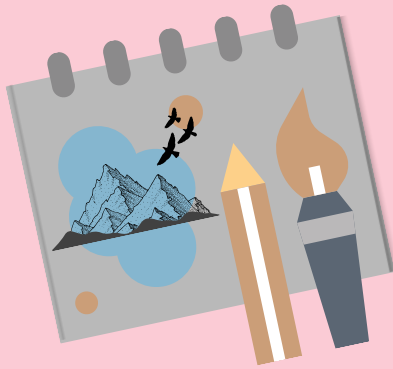

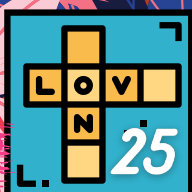

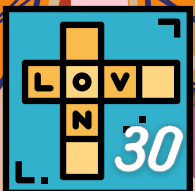
High Priority
