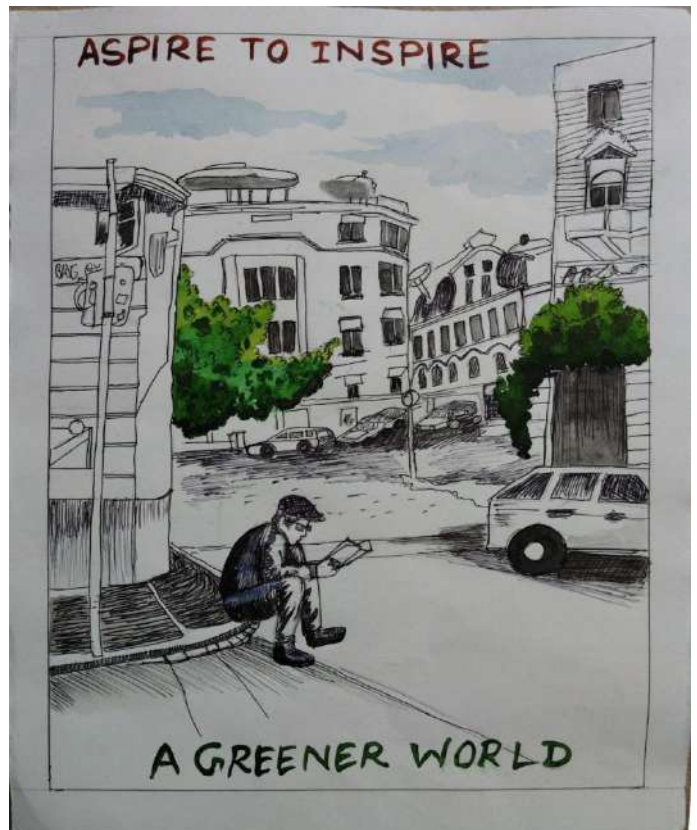
There I am in a battle field,

ORBITING HAZARDS

The Rising Flood of Space Junk is a Risk to Us on Earth—and Governments are on the Hook - The increasing number of space objects poses risks both in orbit and up on re-entry to Earth. -PHYS NEWS

Space junk, or space debris, refers to discarded objects and fragments humans have left in orbit around Earth. These include defunct satellites, spent rocket stages, and fragments from collisions and explosions. As more countries and companies launch satellites and spacecraft, the amount of space junk has significantly increased, posing a threat to operational satellites and future space missions. The sheer volume of debris is alarming, with millions of pieces orbiting our planet, ranging from tiny paint flecks to large, defunct satellites.

The primary issue with space debris is its potential to cause collisions. Even tiny pieces can cause significant damage due to their high speeds, which can exceed 28,000 km per hour. A collision can create thousands of additional particles, exacerbating the problem. This chain reaction, known as the Kessler Syndrome, could render certain orbits unusable and threaten the safety of astronauts and equipment in space. For example, the International Space Station (ISS) must frequently adjust



its orbit to avoid collisions with debris.

To address this problem, space agencies and companies are developing strategies like using robotic arms, deploying nets or harpoons, and designing self-deorbiting satellites. There are also proposals for international regulations to ensure responsible space usage and minimize debris creation. While these solutions are still in the experimental stage, they represent a crucial step toward ensuring the long-term sustainability of space exploration and utilization. By taking action now, we can help preserve space for future generations. As Carl Sagan once said, "The cosmos is within us. We are made of star-stuff. We are a way for the universe to know itself."

So, climb your mountains, but leave the ropes behind, Mark the trails for others, For maybe in you they'll find.

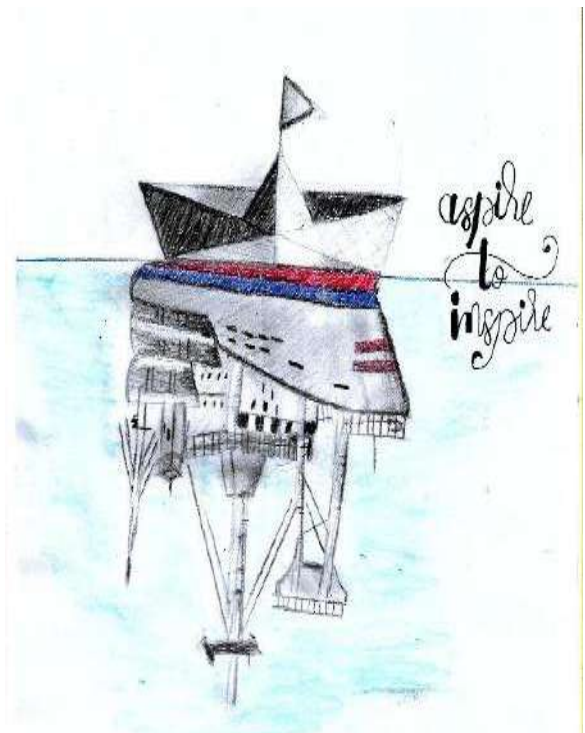

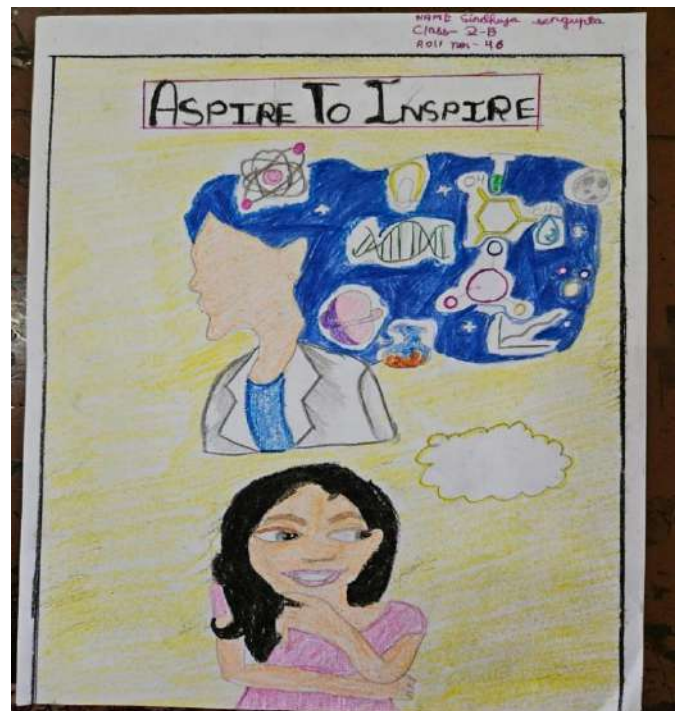
Reconciliation

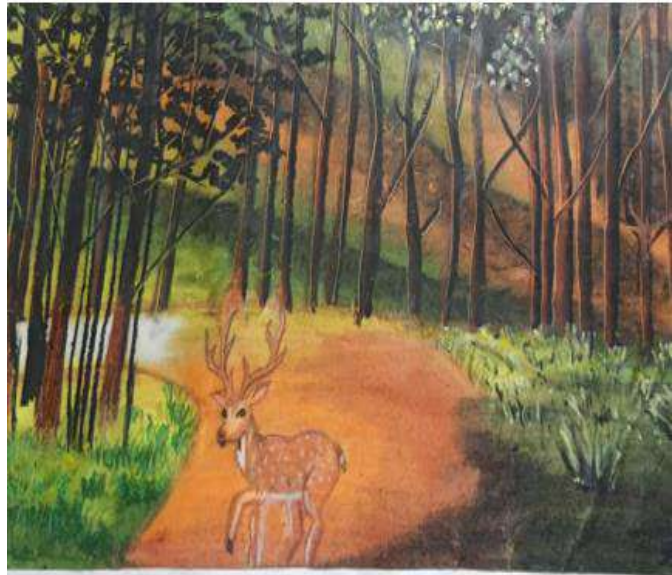

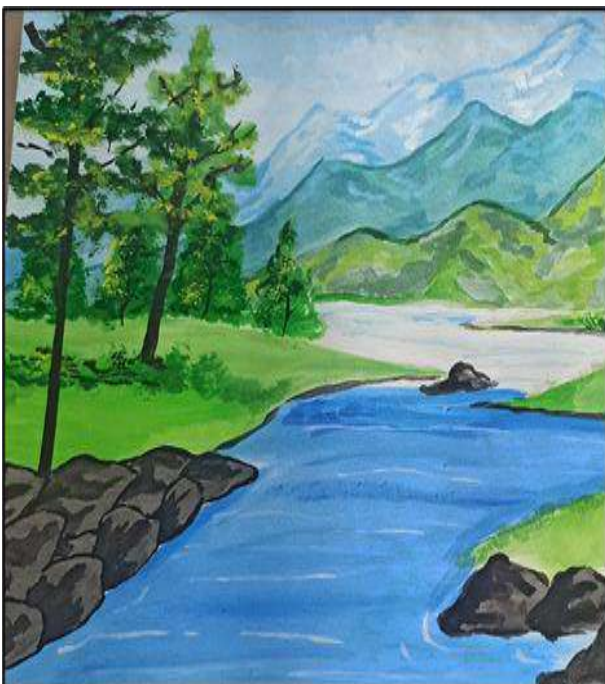

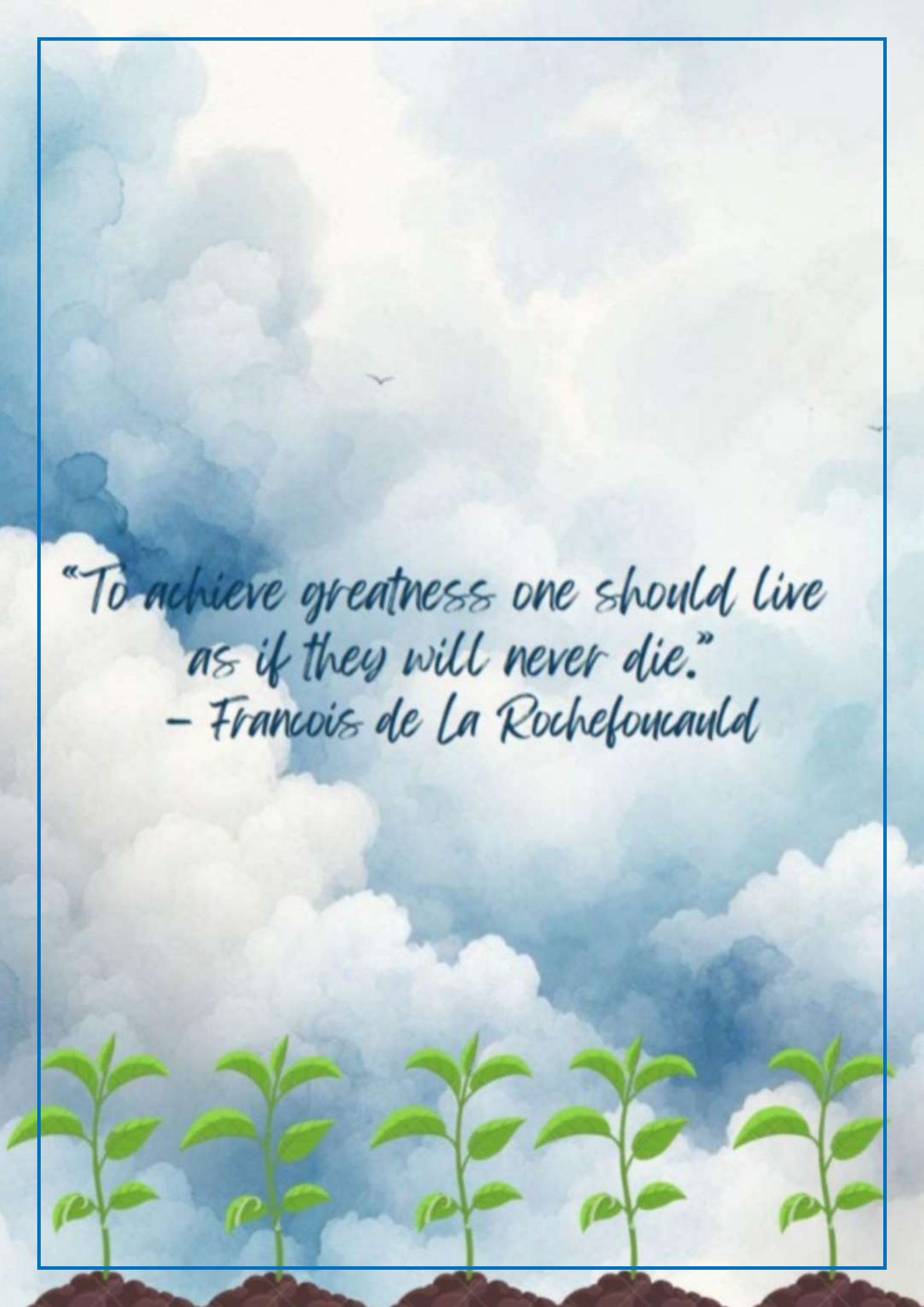
