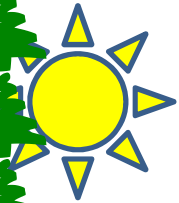

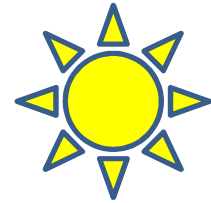

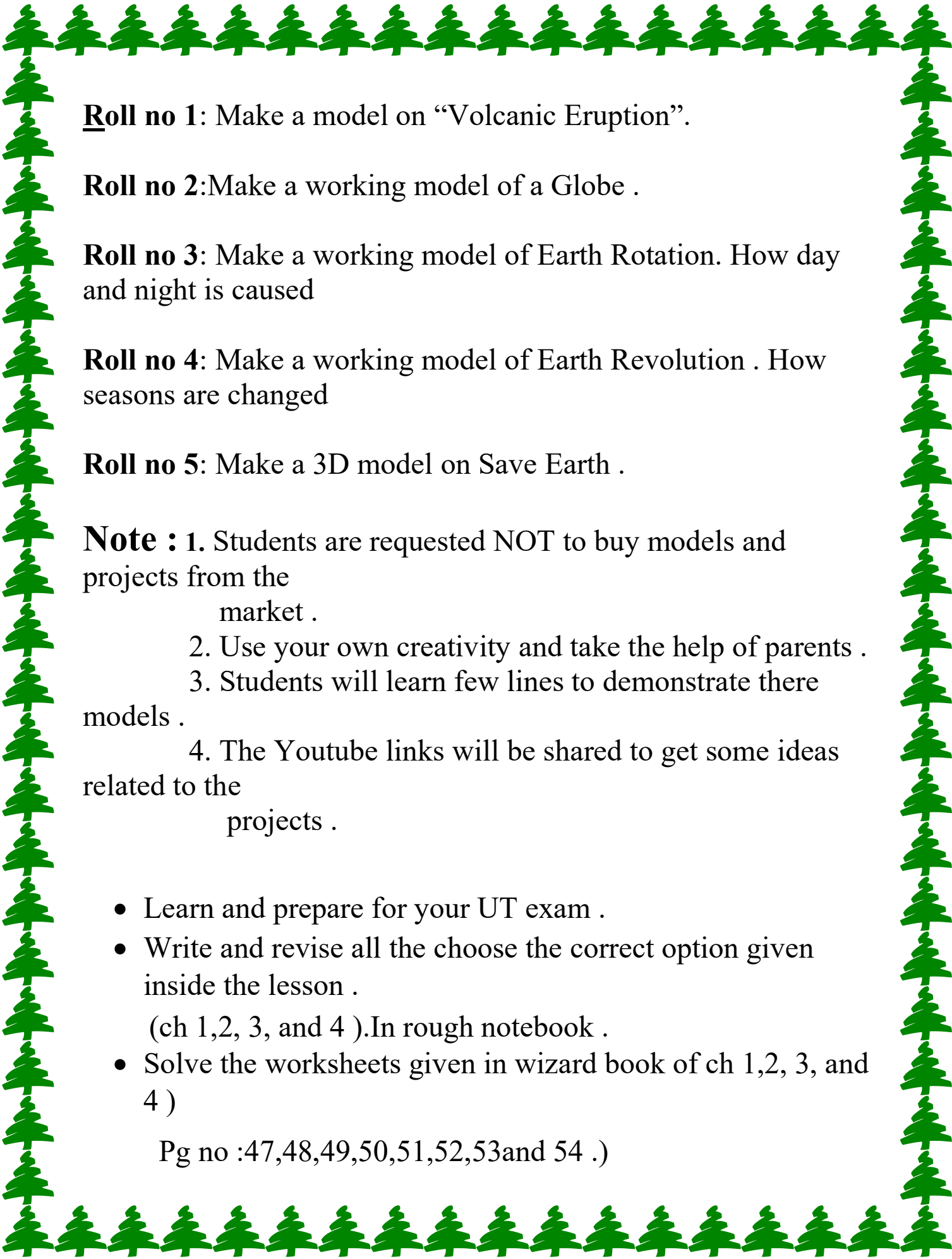


❖ Follow the below mentioned tips to stay healthy and enjoy your SUMMER BREAK.

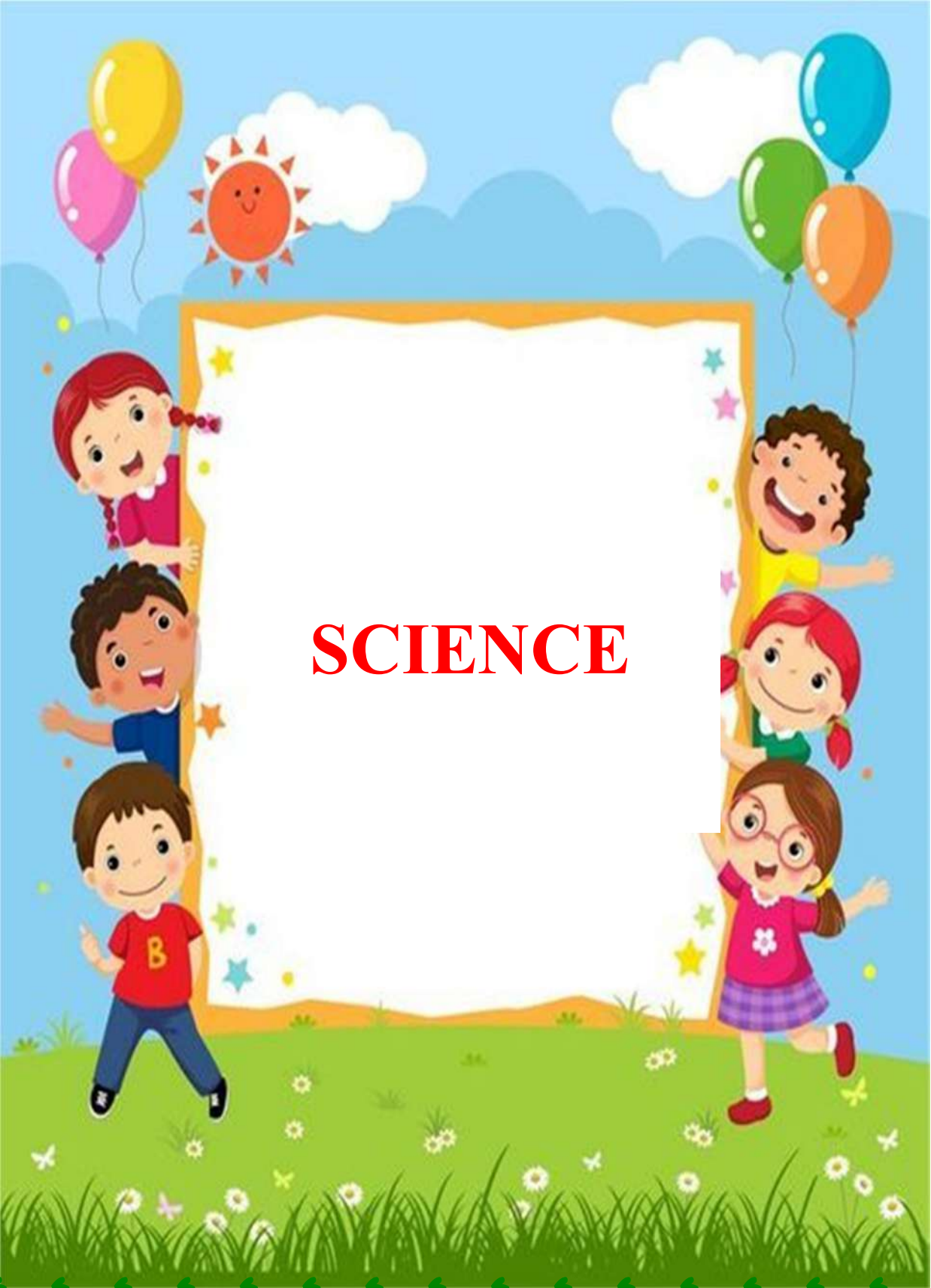

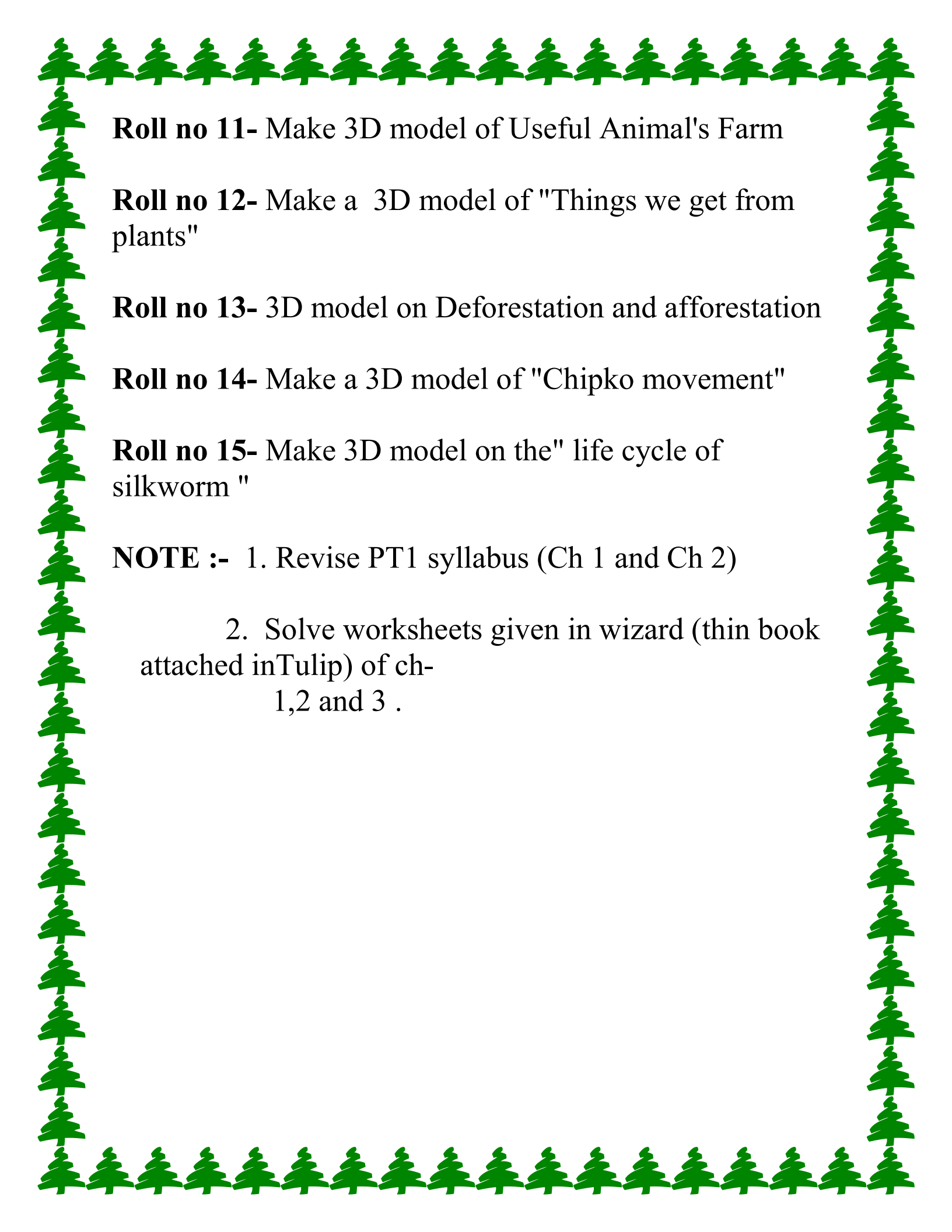

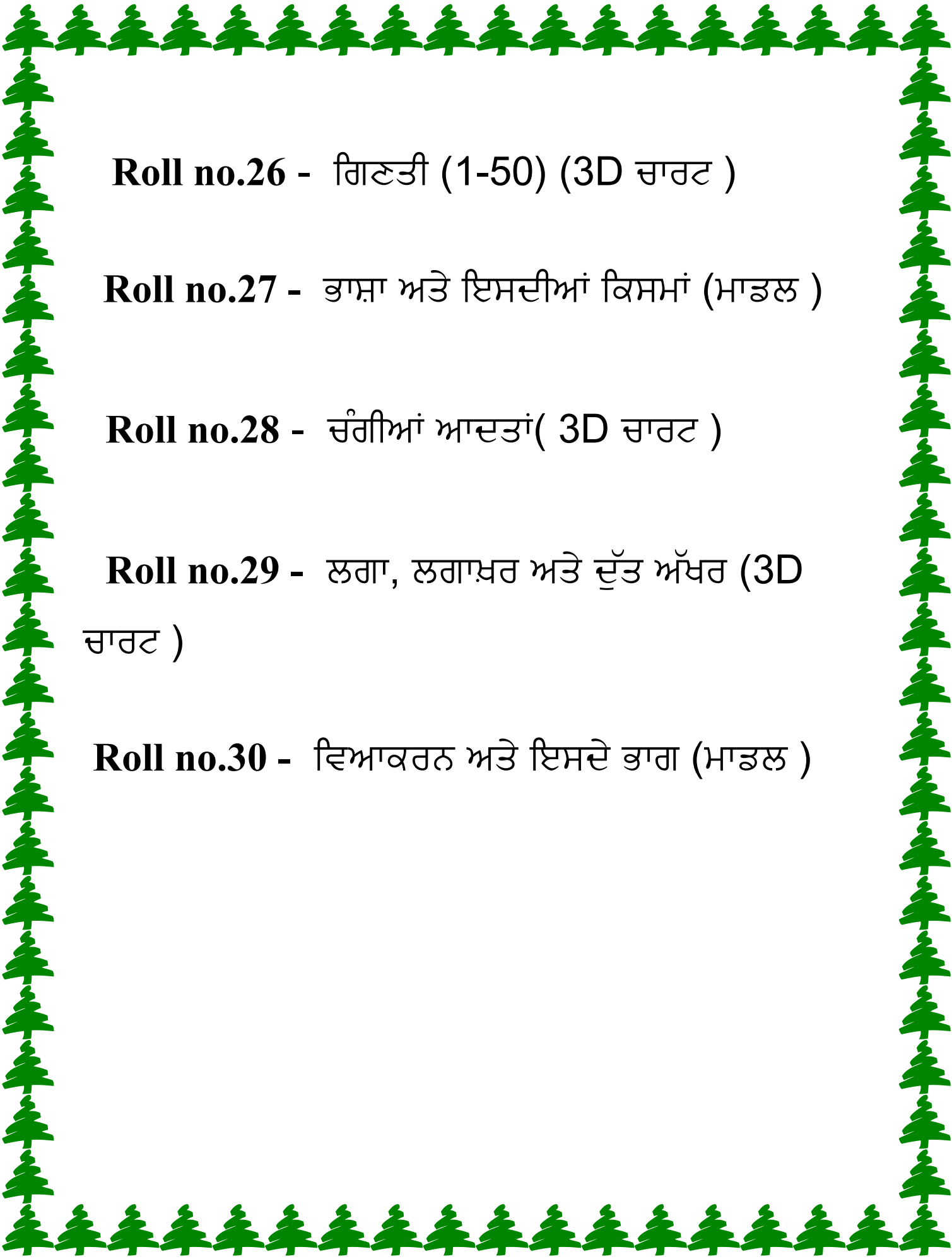

COMPUTER

Roll no. 31 Model on Generations of Computer (Roll No. 29)

Materials: Chart paper, printouts of old and modern computers, markers, glue.

Steps:

1. Divide the chart into five sections: First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth Generation.
2. Paste pictures of computers from each generation.
3. Write the key features of each generation, like technology used (vacuum tubes, transistors, ICs, microprocessors, AI).
4. Highlight examples like ENIAC (1st Gen) and Modern PCs (5th Gen).
5. Use arrows to show the evolution from one generation to the next.

Roll no. 32 Model on Components of Windows 10 (Roll No. 30)

Materials: Chart paper, printouts of Windows 10 screen, markers, glue.

Steps:

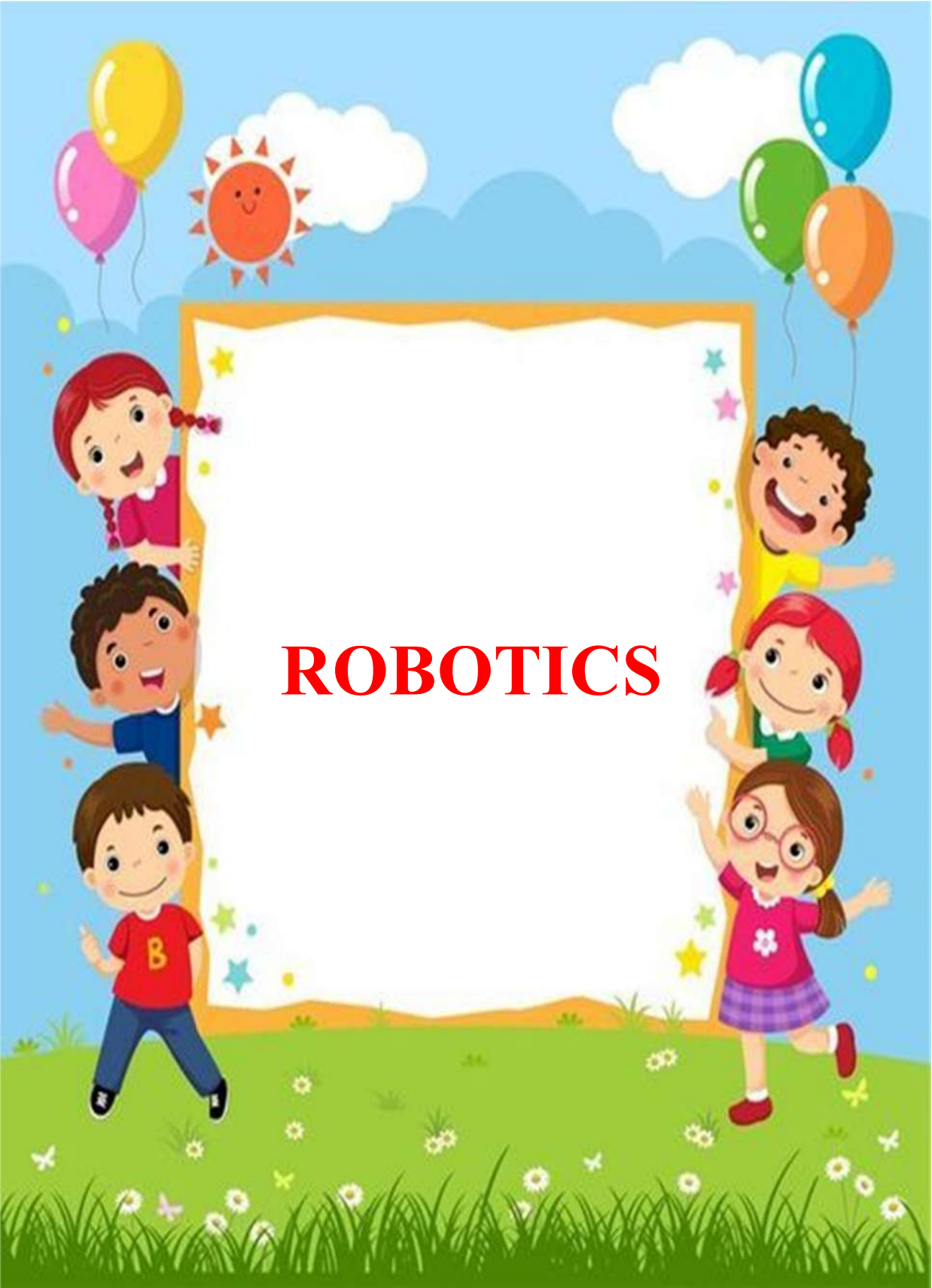
1. Draw or paste an image of a Windows 10 desktop.

Roll no. 33 Model on Mouse Pointer Shapes (Roll No. 31)

Materials: Chart paper, drawings/printouts of mouse pointers, markers.

Steps:

1. Draw different mouse pointer shapes: Arrow, Hourglass, Hand, I-beam, Crosshair.
2. Label each shape with its name and usage (e.g., Arrow: Normal select, Hourglass: Waiting).
3. Arrange them in a grid format for easy understanding.
4. Add a title like "Different Mouse Pointer Shapes."
