RULES FOR RETRO TO METRO DANCE COMPETITION

GRADES: IIIrd & IVth (Housewise)

Rules and Regulations

1. The competition will be held on 26th April 2025.

2. Theme: The performance must follow the theme "Retro to Metro", representing dance styles or music from any past era (like 70s/80s/90s) and transitioning into a modern/contemporary dance form.

3. Eligibility: Open to from III and IV grades (Housewise).

4. Time Limit: Each performance should be between 3 to 5 minutes. Time limit must be strictly followed. Exceeding the time may result in negative marking.

5. Music: Participants must submit their music track in MP3 format at least [one day] before the event. No changes will be entertained on the day of the competition.

6. Props & Costumes: Props are allowed but must be manageable and not hazardous. Costumes should reflect both retro and metro styles and be appropriate for a school audience.

7. Performance Area: Teams must perform within the stage area allotted. No off-stage movements or audience interaction unless specified.

8. Originality: Dance should be original and choreographed by the participants or under guidance.

9. Judgment Criteria: Performances will be judged on: Theme relevance (Retro to Metro transition)

1. Choreography and creativity

2. Synchronization and coordination

3. Costume and expressions

4. Overall impact and energy
