EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT (Electives)

- **CBSE to conduct external examination at the end of Class 12**
- **Weightage of each subject – 100 Marks each (Theory + Practical)**
- **Qualifying Marks in each subject will be 33%**
- **For Subjects involving Practical work, it is MANDATORY to pass in both Theory and Practical individually -**
 - 33% marks mandatory in Theory **AND**
 - 33% marks mandatory in Practical Exam
