

Regarding Re-evaluation and improvement for ICSE/ISC candidates

Dear Parents/Students

Candidates, who are not satisfied with the result of their recheck request, when declared, will get an opportunity to apply for the **Re-evaluation** of their theory answer scripts in the subjects concerned.

Candidates and other stakeholders can apply for **Re-evaluation** using the menu link '**Public Services**' on the CISCE's website: www.cisce.org

Candidates who have attained the **Not Qualified** Result in the year 2025 examination can appear for the improvement examination in the current year of examination in one or maximum of two subjects.

The candidates who have qualified and wish to improve their performance in one or maximum of two subjects can take the Improvement examination this year. These candidates also have the option of improving their performance in one or more subjects, the following year, and appear for the ISC Year 2026 Examination.

Principal

The candidates who are not satisfied **with their** Recheck results in the subjects for which they had applied, will be permitted to apply for Re-evaluation of their answer scripts of those subjects only.

1. **Re-evaluation:** The accuracy of a subject grade awarded will be checked on request, in one or more subjects, provided the Head of the School/Candidate submits the application online. Applications for Re-evaluation must be received by CISCE within THREE days from the date of declaration of the Recheck Results. The date of declaration of Recheck Results will be notified to all the stakeholders, through the website of CISCE (www.cisce.org).

For each Re-evaluation, candidates, through their Schools /Candidates themselves, will be required to pay an online fee of **₹ 1,500/- per subject**.

The charges paid for Re-evaluation of answer scripts will be non-refundable.

The results of all the Re-evaluation requests received by CISCE will be declared together, on the website of CISCE (www.cisce.org).

- (i) The Re-evaluation of answer scripts will be carried out by a competent person appointed by the Chief Executive and Secretary of CISCE.
- (ii) On Re-evaluation of the answer scripts by the subject expert, the marks awarded, whether increased or decreased, will be considered as the FINAL marks.

Important Points:

- (i) No candidate, person or organisation shall be entitled to claim disclosure or inspection of the answer scripts or copies of it and other documents as these are treated as most confidential by CISCE.
- (ii) CISCE will not be responsible for any loss or damage, or any inconvenience caused to the candidate, consequent to the revision of marks and no claims in this regard shall be entertained.
- (iii) The Result documents for the candidates who have applied for Recheck/ Re-evaluation will be released after the result of Re-evaluation is declared.
- (iv) The result of the Recheck/Re-evaluation will be available on DigiLocker as well.

The decision of the Chief Executive & Secretary of CISCE on the result of the Recheck and Re-evaluation shall be final.

GUIDELINES FOR ISC YEAR 2025 — IMPROVEMENT EXAMINATION

Candidates who wish to improve their marks in the same Year Of the Examination, may take the Improvement Examination.

1. Eligibility to appear for the ISC (Class XII) Improvement Examination:

All candidates who appeared for the ISC Year 2025 Main Examination, are eligible to take the Improvement Examination. However, the candidates whose result in the Main Examination is declared as ABSENT will not be eligible for the Improvement Examination.

2. Number of Subjects permitted:

The candidates will be permitted to appear in a maximum Plump two rafb that they would have enrolled themselves for in the ISC Year 2025 Main Examination.

3. Papers to appear in:

The candidates appearing for a particular subject in the Improvement Examination are required to compulsorily appear for the Theory Paper of the subject.

Practical/ Project work: For the ISC, the marks of the Practical/Project Work of the subject, already awarded to the candidate in the Main Examination, will be carried forward. However, if the candidate was absent earlier either in Practical Exarrination or during assessment of Project Work in the subject, then the candldate, in addition to taking the Theory Examination, is also permitted to submit the Project Work and/or appear foi Practical Examination, which should then be assessed, and marks awarded and submitted.

4. Registration of candidates for Improvement Examination:

Schools will be able to register the candidates, onllne, for the Improvement Examination, during the month of June/ July in the given year of Examination.

5. Examination Charges:

The Examlnation Charges for the Improvement Examination are I 500/- per Subject / Paper. For the subject English, the Improvement Examlnation charges would be I 1,000/-, as the subject involves two Papers, i.e., Paper 1 and Paper 2. The payment will have to be made online at the time of registration for the Improvement Examination.

6. Date of the Examination:

CISCE will notify the Schools of the ISC Year 2025 Improvement Examination schedule.

7. Tabulation of Result:

The higher of the two m irks obtained by the crindiilnte in a subject in lhe tv o examinations (i.e., the Miiin Examiniition unit the Improvement ExiiminRtion) will be considered as the finiil marks.

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8. Result Declaration:

Schools will be notified of the date of declaration of result. The result will generally be declared after a month from the date of the last examination.

9. Issue of Examination Result Documents:

The candidates whose Result changes from 'Not Qualified' to 'Qualified' must submit the Statement of Marks document in original, to CISCE through their school. On receipt of the same, the revised document will be sent to the candidates' school.

Similarly, for the other candidates who appear for the Improvement Examination, on declaration of results, must submit their previous document in original, to CISCE through their school. On receiving the same, the revised document will be sent to the candidates' school.

10. Candidates with *Not Qualified* Result at the Main Examination and Absent at the **Improvement Examination:**

The candidates who do not qualify for the ISC Year 2025 Main Examination and are absent from the ISC Year 2025 Improvement Examination will be required to re-appear in all the subjects for which they were registered for the Main Examination, in the following year of Examination. The candidates with *Not Qualified* result will be permitted to re-appear for the examination only once in the following year, but not thereafter, without further attendance at an affiliated and registered school.

GUIDELINES FOR SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION

1. Candidates who have *Qualified* the ISC Year 2025 Examination or have attained a PCA Result (*Pass Certificate Awarded*) prior to ISC Year 2025 Examination and wish to improve their marks in **ONE or MORE** subjects, may appear for the ISC Year 2026 Supplementary Examination as:

- (a) Candidates in regular attendance at a CISCE affiliated school presenting candidates for the ISC Year 2026 Examination (Type 2 candidates). The Principal Of the School concerned will submit the entries of these candidates to CISCE, online. The last date for admission to Class XII is **31st August 2025**.

OR

- (b) Candidates without attendance at a CISCE affiliated school (Type 4 candidates). To enter for the ISC Year 2026 Examination, the candidates are required to contact the Principal of the school concerned, who would then submit the entries to the office of CISCE, online.

2. Candidates who have been awarded PCA Result - Pass Certificate Awarded in ISC Examination conducted in the Year 2024 or earlier and have further appeared for a Supplementary Examination in the ISC Year 2025 Examination, will be permitted to enter for a Supplementary Examination in any/all of the subjects offered in the last ISC Examination taken by them as candidates in regular attendance *provided that the subjects under consideration are still being offered for the examination in the year in which the candidates wish to enter*), without further attendance at an affiliated and registered school. These candidates may appear for the ISC Year 2026 Examination as:

- (a) Candidates in regular attendance at a CISCE affiliated school presenting candidates for the ISC Year 2026 Examination (Type 2 candidates). The Principal Of the School concerned will submit the entries of these candidates to CISCE, online. The last date for admission to Class XII is **31st August 2025**.

OR

- (b) Candidates without attendance at a CISCE affiliated school (Type 4 candidates). To enter for the ISC Year 2026 Examination, the candidates are required to contact the Principal Of the School concerned, who would then submit the entries to the office of CISCE, online.

Please note, entries of candidates wishing to reappear for the ISC Examination to be held in the Year 2026 without attendance at an affiliated school (Type 4 candidates) must be submitted to the office of CISCE online, through the CAREERS Portal by **31st August 2025**, with the Examination charges as prescribed by CISCE.

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All the candidates who will be appearing for the ISC Year 2026 Examination would have to follow the Regulations & Revised Syllabuses and textbooks prescribed for the ISC Year 2026 Examination. For subjects that have a Theory and a Practical component, the candidates are required to appear for both the components of the Examination. The Admission Card, Timetable and other information regarding the Examination will be made available through the CAREERS Portal to the Principal of the School by the last week of January 2026. The candidates may kindly contact the Principal of the School concerned, to collect the printed copy of the Admission Card and the Examination Timetable.
