
Math Club Activity

4) Recognition and Motivation: Assemblies offer an opportunity to celebrate the achievement and successes of students and teachers.



Primary: Doctor's Day Celebration &

Cancer Awareness

National Doctor's Day is celebrated on 1st July every year in India for the past 32 years, honouring the legendary and renowned Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy. The occasion commemorates the spirit of doctors across the globe who works day and night to ensure wellbeing of patient. To acknowledge the contribution and honour our saviours effort, National Doctor's Day was celebrated in SEM school with great zeal on 1st July 2024.

A seminar on digital effect of eyes was conducted by Dr. Pawan Mandaviya, a renowned doctor from Kiran hospital for standard 3 to 5. He urged the students not to get addicted to mobile phones. Internet and social media is undoubtedly a sea of information and has numerous benefits . But addiction to it does more harm than good. He suggested the students to limit their screen time and engage in other activities preferably outdoors. Parents should set an example for their kids by restricting themselves from over usage of mobile phones. It is essential to realise the shortcomings of phone addiction and take measures to devote less time to trivial infatuations like that of social media . He made the students understand the demerits of mobile phone addiction through the aid of a video.

Another informative seminar was conducted by Dr. Dimpal, an incredibly talented medical practitioner from Kiran hospital on the socially prevalent issue of Cervical cancer. It was conducted for the girls of standard 8 to 12. She made the students aware of preventive measures of cervical cancer. They are caused by HPV i.e high risk types of Human Papilloma Virus .She recommended regular screenings including Pap test and HPV test to detect precancerous cells. She suggested to adopt a cervical cancer prevention lifestyle and diet that are high in anti oxidants and avoid large amounts of saturated and craces fats and sugar. Regular exercise also prevents cervical cancer. It is most effective when given at age 11 - 12 years. It can be given until age 45. Both sessions were useful and informative.



Field Trip : Aquarium

An open heart, a curious mind, and a sense of adventure, the perfect ingredients for a memorable field trip.....

Samithi English Medium School had organized a field trip on 13th July 2024 (Saturday) to the aquarium for the students of Pre-Primary section. 




