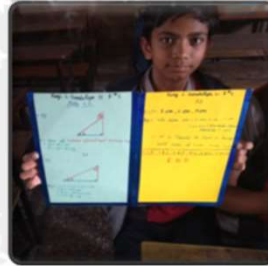
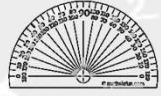


Properties of Triangle

For Learning through activity, students were given the topic 'The Properties of Triangle'. The learning objectives were to identify the property of a triangle, Exterior angle property of a triangle, Sum of the lengths of two sides of a triangle.

For doing these activities, the students used A4 size papers, project papers as well as chart papers. They drew different triangles of different measures. They measured the three angles of a triangle using protractor and got confirmed that the sum of measures of three angles of a triangle is always 180° . They also learnt to find the measure of third angle of a triangle by knowing the measurements of other two angles.

During the process, they learnt the concept of measurements of lengths of a triangle. They measured the lengths of the three sides of a triangle and got it clear that the sum of the lengths of two sides of a triangle is always greater than the length of third side. It was a well engaged period for the students.

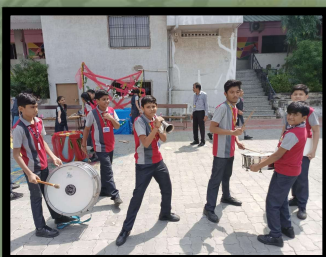


MUSIC NOTES

Activity- Shapes

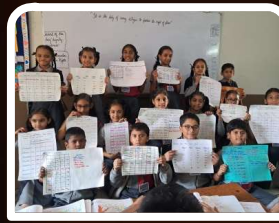
The ability to accurately identify shapes is a foundational mathematical skill, and it is quite rewarding for children because their world is full of shapes.

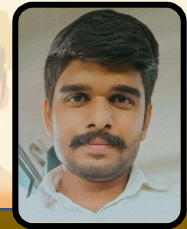
Importance of Role-play in language development

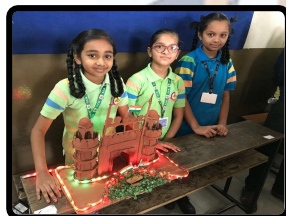

In SEM we are giving a lot of various sports exposures. So that students learnt life skills.

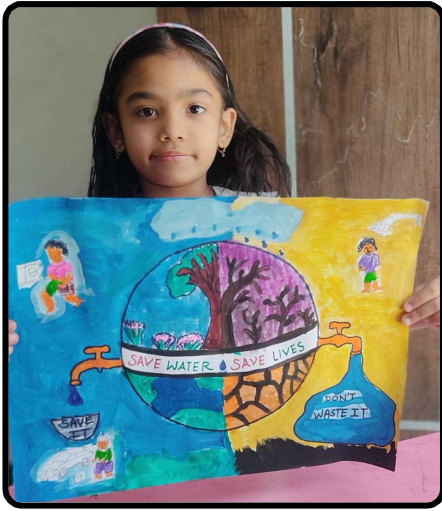
