Dear Parents,

The much-awaited event of the school, "The Annual Day Celebration" is finally here. It gives us immense pleasure to share with you that our students and staff members are set to showcase their talent and exhibit their physical prowess in the forthcoming Annual Day "Confluence". We invite all the parents to join us in celebrating this very special event. We request you to be present on time on the Annual Day.

Please take a note of the following instructions: For the participant's parents:

- It is compulsory for all the participant students (of 20th and 21st January) to be present on 19th January (Thursday) 2023 for regular practice sessions as well as dress rehearsal. Students can come to school in decent and comfortable civil dress.
- Please check the costumes and make minor alterations, if necessary.
- Students need to bring their empty school bag and extra plastic bag to carry the costume along with them on 19th January 2023 and **no need to bring school books, only a water bottle**. Snacks will be provided to the students.

Other instructions: During the event: 20 and 21 January:

- Bags, jackets and other belongings should be labeled.
- Participants are to come dressed in costumes for their respective events on 20th and 21st January . Basic make-up (foundation, eyeliner, eye-shadow, blush-on, lipstick) and hair styling to be done at home, touch-up of make-up will be done at School. All students must carry a comb, safety-pins, cotton balls, cleansing milk -a small make-up kit. Hair should be freshly shampooed. The girls with short hair must wear a black hair band. Please do not accessorize the hair. Only black hair clips are allowed.
- •No expensive jewellery or watches to be worn. The school will not be responsible for any misplaced items. Mobile phones are strictly not allowed.
- The student should have a light lunch before reaching School. Reaching time to school is sharp at 3.30 pm.
- Refreshments will be provided by the School on 19th, 20th (participants) and 21st January (participants). Participants of 20th January will be having a holiday on 21st January.
- Participants of 21st January need to come to school on 20th January to collect the costume.We will inform you of the timing.
- Attendance for participants on both days is compulsory. (Stage rehearsal and main event)
- After the programme, the students will go home with their respective Parents /Guardian.
- Students have to come along with their school ID card along with the costume.
- Students need to come in their costumes with light makeup and hairdo (hair style).
- Parents are not allowed to collect their children from the stage after their performance. Students will be handed over to parents after the completion of their respective programme. (tentative time at 10.00 pm). Pre-primary will be handed over by 7 pm to their parents.

• Send an extra pair of clothes with your ward in the plastic bag (labeled with the name and class) as they need to return the costumes on the same day.

20th January (Friday): Pre-primary and Std I:

• On 20th January , students will arrive at school campus by 3.30 pm sharp. (Parent are requested to drop them to school)

21st January (Saturday): Std II to XII

- •On 21st January, students will arrive at school campus by 3.30 pm sharp. (Parent are requested to drop them to school)
