Std. 1 & 2

Colouring.

Instructions:

- Students have to fill colour in the given picture. Picture will be provided.
- They can use crayon colours or pencil colours.
- Duration: 2 periods.
- **Date: 03-12-2025**

Std. 3 & 4

Draw and colour:

Themes: Flower vase or Scenery.

Instructions:

- Students have to draw and colour any one of the above topics. They can give background colours also.
- Students have to bring paper from the drawing note book and required materials from home.
- They can use crayon colours or pencil colours.
- Duration: 2 periods.
- **Date: 03-12-2025**

Note: Drawing and colouring is compulsory for all students from Std. 1 to 4.

Std 5 to 10

Pencil drawing/ Water colouring

Themes:

Std. 5 & 6 – 1) Pollution. 2) Vibrant festivals of India

Std. 7 & 8 – 1) Warli art or Madhubani Painting. 2) Abstract painting

Std 9 & 10 – Golden Jubilee of our School.

Instructions:

- Students can participate in only **one item**, i.e., either pencil drawing or water colouring.
- Students have to select any one of themes given above (for Std. 5 to 8)
- Students have to bring paper from the drawing note book and required materials from home, and can use any type of colours for water colouring (pencil colours, crayons, water colours, acrylic colours, etc.)
- **Duration: 2 to 3 periods (Std 5 to 8); Maximum 2 hours for Std. 9 to 10.**
- **Date: 04-12-2025**
- Interested students have to give their names to their respective class teachers by **02-12-2025**.

Event 2: Story-telling, Elocution

Interested students must give their names to their respective class teacher by **02-12-2025**.

Std 1 to 4: Story-telling (in English)

Instructions:

- Duration: 2 minutes.
- **Date: 09-12-2025 (for Std. 1 to 3)**
06-12-2025 (for Std. 4)

Judgement criteria:

On the basis of Story with moral; Props or Action; Clarity in language; Overall presentation.

Elocution (in English)

Topics:

Std 5 & 6: (Any one)

- 1) My favourite Hobby
- 2) My Role model

Std. 7 & 8: (Any one)

- 1) My life without Gadgets.
- 2) Importance of Yoga

Std. 9 & 10

- 1) Role of youth in Nation building.

Instructions:

- Duration: 2 minutes (for Std. 5 to 8); 3 minutes (for Std 9 & 10)
- **Date: 06-12-2025**

Judgement criteria:

On the basis of content, language clarity & fluency, timings, presentation.

Event 3: Poem recitation - For Std. 1 to 10 (in English or Malayalam)

Instructions:

- Poem recitation in Malayalam and English will be conducted separately. Students can participate in only one (either English or Malayalam)
- Keralite students can participate in Malayalam poem recitation.
- Duration: 2 minutes.
- **Date: 09-12-2025 (for Std. 1 to 3) (both Malayalam and English)**
06-12-2025 (for Std. 4 to 10) (both Malayalam and English)

Judgement criteria:

On the basis of voice modulation, expressions and emotions, clarity & presentation, confidence.

Note:

- **For Std. 5 to 10 - One student can participate in only one event out of 3 events.**
- **For Std. 1 to 4 – One student can participate in only one event out of Event 2 and 3 as Event 1 is compulsory.**
- All interested students are requested to register their names with their respective class teachers on **02-12-2025.**
- Best performers will be awarded with certificates.
