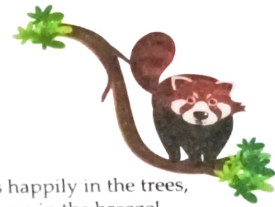

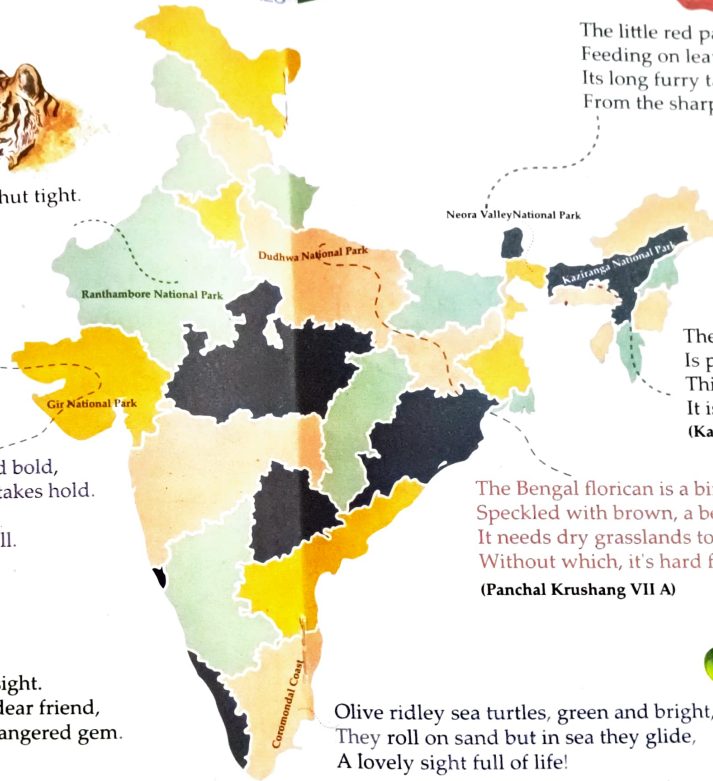
In the woods of Gir, dense and wild,

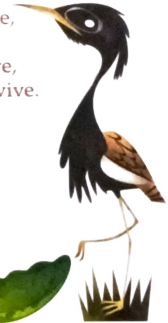


Deep down in the sea so wide,

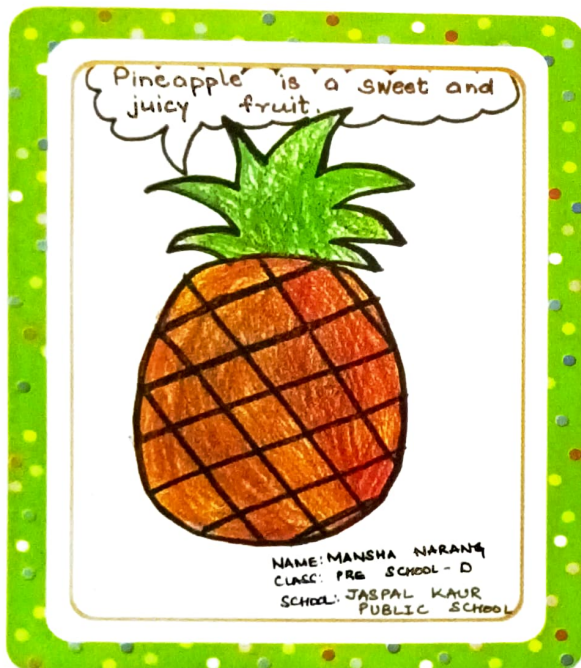
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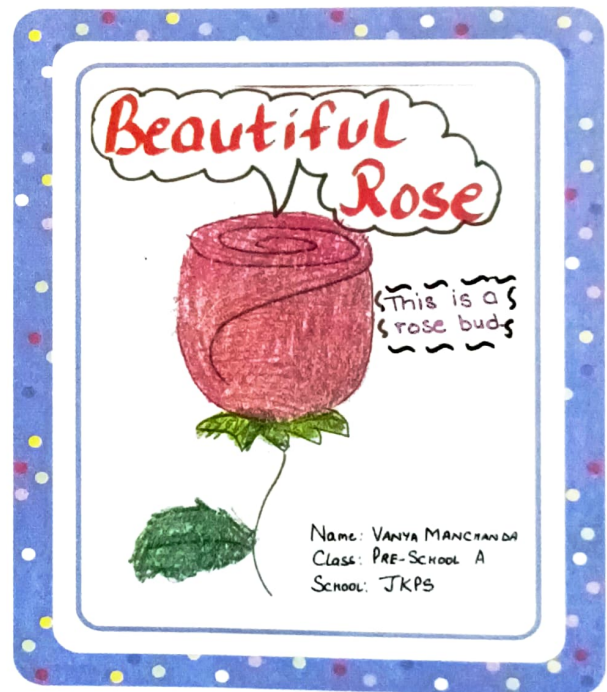
