Topic- The Magic Garden of Vocabulary

Create an attractive “Magic Garden of Vocabulary” using new words along with their synonyms and antonyms. Each flower, leaf, tree, or plant in the garden will contain one main word, three synonyms (similar meaning words), and two antonyms (opposite meaning words).

Instructions:

1. Choose any 10 New words.
2. Write 3 synonyms and 2 antonyms for each word.
3. Draw a colourful garden scene using flowers, trees, leaves, pots, grass, butterflies, etc.
4. Write the main words on flowers, leaves, or plant pots.
5. Write the synonyms on petals, leaves, or branches around the word.
6. Write the antonyms in a different colour to make it stand out.
7. Decorate the page neatly using colours, borders, and creative designs.
8. The activity may be done in A3 sheet (Thick)
9. Use neat handwriting and correct spellings.
10. Give a motivational Line/quote also.
