KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE

In India, there is a steady rise in the incidents of offences against children. Just 2 minutes of googling and you will find innumerable cases of abuse of children. The big concern among parents is that children don't speak up about it. It is estimated that every 2nd child is exposed to one or the other form of abuse.

As a counsellor, working with children who have been abused, (physically, emotionally, sexually or even cyber abuse) I want to highlight reasons WHY CHILDREN DON'T SPEAK UP ABOUT IT?

- They are afraid that they may be disbelieved. (Since, majority of the times in case of an abuse, the offender is the acquaintance of the family)
- % They have a sense of guilt that perhaps it is 'their own fault' that they've been abused.
- Older Children/adolescents fear that their parents would get to know about their relationships with other gender and so they don't speak about themselves being abused by their partners.

 (During individual counselling sessions young girls disclose sharing their objectionable pictures with their beaus and then are being blackmailed for favours. To make it worse they dread disclosing it to their parents)
- Adolescents do not disclose cyber abuse fearing that their parents would get to know about their digital footprints esp. their social media accounts including chats and texts. (According to the latest developmental research, adolescence period begins at the age of 9)
- The child may have been manipulated by the offender into believing that their relationship is normal. Sometimes the child does not realize that he/she is being abused.
- 🗞 Fear of retaliation and further abuse also forces a child to keep silent.
- Generally, children are not encouraged to talk about their feelings and when they do, adults do not listen or believe. (Thanks to the culture of COMMANDING rather than ACTIVE LISTENING to children)
- Parents have absolutely no idea how adversely this can affect children. Please understand that the trauma associated with abuse can contribute to arrest the development, along with a host of severe psychological and emotional disorders (Generalised Anxiety Disorder, Depression, and Schizophrenia.... to name a few) that they may never overcome throughout their lives. IT IS A MYTH that the child will easily overcome the hurt or trauma.
- Need is great to prevent and even more important, to help children who have been abused.
- 5 TALK about it (Catharsis: by an expert) to get rid of the emotional hurt.
- We should raise awareness of all the children, both boys and girls to prevent the ABUSE.
- Help them understand that it is not their fault.
- Help them understand that you are always with them.
- Help them understand that their safety is in their hands.
- Teach them "If they sense something wrong, it must Be Wrong" and must be conveyed to parents.
- Teach them 'Gone are the days to stay in private if you've been abused; Now is the time to go in Public if you feel someone is trying to abuse you.
- Teach kids not only about good and bad touch, but also confusing touch. (Most of the times I've seen that children bear so much as they are unable to differentiate between them)
- Teach them about e-POCSO (online complaint box for reporting child abuse for Protection of Children from Sexual Offences, Act 2012) and child helpline number ie. 1098.
- Above all 'DON'T JUST HEAR BUT LISTEN' to your children. Active listening involves undivided attention, with focus on non-verbal gestures and emotions as well.
- Together, we can protect our children by teaching them to be Smart, Strong and Safe.

I provide my services in this prestigious institute as a Special Educator and a Resource Teacher which requires me to be sensitive, flexible, understanding and patient.



Other events like swimming, camps and sports events played a very important role to create a dynamic officer. Camps are the important tool to test toughness and teamwork of the group. The day of an officer starts early in the morning with adequate physical and mental conditioning. Duty, Honour, Courage are the core values of our Indian Navy which are inculcated in us during our training days, which stays till our last breath. We are taught 'Safety, Honor and Welfare of your country always come first . The honour, welfare and comfort of the men you command come next.

I have learnt to be resilient. We don't succeed in everything we do & sometimes, it takes a hard fall to know where you really stand. Failure is a part of life and the training here toughens you up, not just physically but also emotionally and mentally. Being in the Armed Forces is all about balance and fortitude and a lot of courage. You are as strong as your weakest link.

In Indian Armed Forces we follow ethos like Espirit-de-Corps which stands for the spirit of comradeship and brotherhood of the brave, regardless of caste, creed or religion. Life in Armed Forces teaches you to learn from your seniors and pass on the legacy to you budding

'One for all, all for one' is the supreme policy. This has instilled in us the ability to work selflessly as a team, the feeling of camaraderie, of mutual trust and friendship.

In the civilian sector, seldom will someone under the age of 25 be placed in charge of large numbers of personnel and equipment. However, it is commonplace for newly commissioned officers, fresh out of Training academy, to be placed in charge of 50 or more service members and thousands- or some cases millions- of rupees' worth of equipment.

So yes, Armed Force is not only just a profession but 'It's a way of life'. The best part is, you will never get bored with what you are doing because every day is a new beginning and a new challenge waiting for you, Being part of the Indian Defence services doesn't mean giving up your social life. In fact, it's quite the opposite, from recreational facilities on base and special entertainment to sports leagues and discounted leisure travel, military personnel often maintain active social lives.

I know that the learning curve for me has just begun; And I am excited to take on the challenges that come in the way of serving our nation. I know this has to be the best thing that has happened to me. So, if you think you have seen it all, well think again and push past your limits and I promise defence forces will give you ample amount of opportunities. I would urge others to join this honour too because the pride of having the privilege to serve your country swells your heart. Being a soldier, I am proud of my own country and the fellow citizens.

To sum this up, I must say each Sacred Heartian truly lives with the motto "Learn and Enlighten". I would envisage each one of you to respect each teacher of yours and value their efforts. Being the naughtiest and at the same time the most adorable child of all my teachers, today, I am affirmative that their countless blessings and love got me wear this uniform.

Biography of RAMANUJAN

Ramanujan's full name was Srinivasa Ramanujan Aiyangar. He was born on 22 December, 1887. He was an Indian mathematician who lived during the British rule in India. He had almost no training in pure mathematics, but he made substantial contributions to mathematical analysis, number theory, infinite series and continued fractions including solutions to mathematical problems then considered unsolvable. Ramanujan developed his own mathematical research in isolation. In 1913 he began a postal correspondence with the English mathematician G.H. Hardy at the University of Cambridge, England. Recognizing Ramanujan's work as extraordinary, Hardy arranged for him to travel to Cambridge. Hardy commented that

Ramanujan had produced ground breaking new theorems. He became one of the youngest fellows of the Royal Society and only the second Indian member, and the first Indian to be elected a fellow of Trinity College, Cambridge. Ramanujan died in 1920 at the age of 32 due to illness.

Does The Sun Rotate Like Earth?

We know that the Earth rotates on its imaginary axis. This rotation effects day and night on earth. The sun rotates too. However, the sun rotates at a much slower pace than earth. It is not difficult for us to calculate the time taken for the earth to make a full rotation on its axis 24 hours because of its solidity. However, the sun is not as solid as the earth and its body is different from that of our planet. Therefore, the sun's rotation is harder to determine. The sun is predominantly made of gases. Its body therefore, is divided into different layers each one of them moving at various speeds. On an average, the sun rotates on its axis once every 27 days. However, its equator, the mid region of the Sun, spins the fastest and takes about 24 days to rotate, while the poles take more than 30 days. The inner parts of the sun spin faster than the outer layers.

WHATSAPP

Whatsapp, owned by Mark Zuckerberg, is currently the largest messaging service in the world with over two billion active users. Whatsapp has everything you would need on a social messaging platform including new-in app features.

- · Group chats work with upto 256 members. We can also broadcast message to multiple contacts.
- · Supports voice and video calls both for group and individuals. But it allows only 8 users at a time for group video calls.
- · One of the most interesting features of Whatsapp is 'Whatsapp status' also known as Whatsapp stories. In this people can post their picture and videos to their chat member that remains active for 24 hours.
- · Whatsapp allows us to share file and documents upto 100 MB, while pictures and videos can be shared within 16MB.
- · We can also share live locations and do payment through Whatsapp.
- · It allows us to delete our messages within a limited time. It does not support self-destructing message.

TELEGRAM

Now comes Telegram which is owned by Pavel Durov.

- It supports groups of upto 200,000 members. Known for its large and massive groups, telegram offers multiple group specific features such as bots, polls, hashtags, quizzes, extensive for large
- Supports voice and video calls both for Android and IOS devices. Supports only individual voice and video calls and not for groups.
- Telegram does not allow to share status with our chats.
- · Size limit for sharing files on Telegram is upto 1.5GB.
- · Telegram supports sharing of locations with our chats while it does not support payment modes.
- · Telegram supports feature of self-destructing messages where messages will get deleted at any point of time.

Coming to latest member Signal, it offers

- · To create groups. But does not allow to broadcast to multiple contacts at once.
- · Secure messaging, voice and video calls with end-to-end encryption. Supports group calling.
- Does not allow to share status.
- To share files and document up to 100MB.
- · To share your current location with your friends.
- · Self-destructing message. Note to self-share your own thoughts and ideas without creating single member groups.

Which App is more secure in terms of Privacy?

The newly launched privacy policy of Whatsapp has caused data privacy and security concerns. Number and private messages shared with your friends on Whatsapp can be accessed. Whatsapp does not encrypt backups (cloud or local) and metadata unlike SIGNAL, which is used to carry communication between two end points. Telegram group chats are not encrypted unless you secret chats, which again only supports single-user

In terms of user privacy, Signal offers most secure form of communication you can get on the internet. But again, Signal lacks a host of features as compared to Whatsapp and Telegram, Signal by default encrypts all the local files with a 4-digit passphrase. It also supports encrypted group calls.
