3. **No preponement or postponement of examination will be allowed.**
4. Students suffering from contagious diseases will not be allowed to appear in the exam.
5. **A student who uses unfair means and / or receives or gives assistance to other in any form during tests / exams will be given zero in the subject with a warning letter. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal of the student.**
6. No borrowing or lending will be allowed during the exams.
7. Students should not carry anything objectionable to the examination hall.
8. **Students should come in proper school uniform daily.**
9. School timings during exam days : For classes II to V : 7.45 a.m to 11.00 a.m. and
For classes VI to XII : 7.45 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.

All students should be seated in the examination venue before 7.45 a.m. **The school gate will be closed at 7.50 a.m.**

Late comers will be sent back.

10. **M.Sc.,G.K and Computer Science Exams will be conducted during school hours. Students are not allowed to go home after attending a few periods or after the tests. These days will be half working days for the students.**
11. Students of classes Nursery to XII will have preparatory holidays before exams on September 11 & 12, 2026.
12. Students will have holidays after main exams. The school will reopen on October 5, 2026.
13. There will be compulsory Parent Teacher Meeting on October 17, 2026 between 8.00 a.m to 11.00 a.m.
