General Instructions

1. Evaluation will be held in the month of May, September, December and March.
2. Attendance will be marked on every Parent Teacher Meet and the children should accompany their parents in School Uniform only.
3. The School Almanac should be checked and counter signed by the parents regularly.
4. Label all the belongings of your ward with permanent marker.
5. It is mandatory that one cycling shorts should be there in the bag daily.
6. Ensure that the nails of your ward should be pared every Sunday as there will be a regular surprise check.
7. Ensure that the hair (for non-sikh boys) should be cut when needed (once in a month) as there will be a regular surprise check. For non-sikh boys, crew cut is mandatory.
