Important Note: -

- The school fee will be revised with a marginal increase of **5%**.
- The transport fee will be increased by **₹200 per month**. Please note that transport charges are applicable for **11 months** in the academic year.
- Parents who intend to apply for a **School Leaving Certificate (SLC)** for their ward are requested to submit the application on or before **25th March 2026**. Applications received after this date will be liable to pay the full fee for the subsequent months.
- For withdrawal of the transport facility, a **one-month prior notice** is mandatory. Such requests will be accepted only up to **31st August 2026**. No requests for withdrawal will be entertained thereafter.
- **Summer Vacation (Nursery to Class VIII):**  
From **Wednesday, 27th May 2026** to **Wednesday, 1st July 2026**.  
The school will reopen on **Thursday, 2nd July 2026**.
- **Summer Vacation (Classes IX & X):**  
From **Saturday, 30th May 2026** to **Wednesday, 1st July 2026**.  
The school will reopen on **Thursday, 2nd July 2026**.
- Kindly note that **half-day leave is not permitted**. In case your child is unwell or you need to take your child elsewhere, please apply for full-day leave. Half-day requests will not be sanctioned as per school policy. Leave applications must be submitted before **8:00 a.m.** to enable proper attendance marking. The half-day policy is detailed in the school diary and must be strictly followed.
- Health and well-being are of utmost importance. If your child is unwell, please keep them at home for proper rest and care. Kindly consult a doctor and send your child to school only after full recovery.
