Fun Holiday Activities

1. Maths Fun



Help your child practice:

- Forward counting from 1 to 50
- Understanding the concept of Big and Small

Activity Ideas:

- ❖ Count toys, fruits, or steps while walking.
- ❖ Arrange objects from big to small.
- ❖ Compare sizes of household items.

Example:

- ✓  Big —  Small

2. English Recognition Activity

Help your child recognize:

- Uppercase cursive letters
- Lowercase cursive letters

Activity Ideas:

- ❖ Identify letters from storybooks or charts.
- ❖ Match uppercase cursive with lowercase cursive letters.
- ❖ Air trace letters with fingers.
- ❖ Sing alphabet songs together.

3. Hindi Practice Activity

Help your child practice:

- Swar
- Vyanjan

Activity Ideas:

- ❖ Read aloud Hindi letters daily.
- ❖ Identify letters from flashcards or newspapers.
- ❖ Match letters with pictures.

Example:

- ✓ अ - अनार
- ✓ क - कमल

4. My Helping Hands

Encourage your child to do small helpful tasks at home.

Ask your child to:

- Arrange toys neatly
- Water plants
- Help in keeping books properly
- Share and care for others

If your child does something exceptional or thoughtful, parents are requested to click pictures. Once the children are back to school, we would love to share and appreciate their efforts with other children in the class.

Note for Parents

Parents are encouraged to read a variety of Hindi and English storybooks to their children during the holidays. Even 10-15 minutes of storytelling every day can create a love for reading and learning in children.
