Dear Parents,

Summer vacation is a wonderful opportunity for children to learn through play, conversation, reading, and real-life experiences. At this stage, children become more curious, observant, and expressive. The following activities are designed to strengthen their basic concepts in a joyful and stress-free manner.

These are **suggestive activities** meant to encourage learning at home in a fun way. Along with academics, children should also:

- Spend quality time with family
- Play outdoors and stay active
- Develop independence and good habits
- Learn empathy, sharing, and kindness
- Explore hobbies and creative activities

Small daily interactions and meaningful conversations help children learn the most.

Fun Holiday Activities

1. Maths Fun




Help your child practice:

- ❖ Forward counting from 1 to 100
- ❖ Concepts of Greater and Lesser
- ❖ Arranging objects from Big to Small

Activity Ideas:

- Count toys, fruits, or stairs while climbing.
- Compare numbers using flashcards.
- Arrange household objects according to size.
- Ask questions like:
Which number is greater: 45 or 52?
Which object is smaller?

Example:

- ✓  →  → 
(Big to Small)

2. English Language Activity

Help your child practice:

- ❖ Three-letter words (CVC words)
- ❖ Sound blending and word recognition

Activity Ideas:

- Read simple CVC words daily.
- Make word cards using sounds.
- Play "Find the Word" games around the house.
- Encourage children to speak simple sentences.

Example Words:

- ✓ cat
- ✓ bat
- ✓ sun
- ✓ pen
- ✓ dog

Parents are encouraged to read aloud with children and help them identify sounds and words in everyday life.

3. Hindi Reading Activity

Help your child read and recognize:

- ❖ तीन से चार अक्षरों वाले बिना मात्रा के शब्द

Activity Ideas:

- Read simple Hindi words aloud daily.
- Match words with pictures.
- Encourage children to repeat and identify sounds.

Example Words:

- ✓ कमल
- ✓ गमन
- ✓ नमन
- ✓ चरण

Keep the practice joyful and conversational.

4. My Helping Hands

Encourage your child to become more responsible and caring through small daily tasks.

Ask your child to:

- ❖ Arrange books and toys neatly
- ❖ Water plants
- ❖ Help in setting the table
- ❖ Fold small clothes or napkins
- ❖ Show kindness and sharing habits

If your child does something exceptional or thoughtful, parents are requested to click pictures. Once the children are back to school, we would love to share and appreciate their efforts with other children in the class.

Reading Corner

Reading is extremely important at this stage as it helps develop:

- Vocabulary
- Imagination
- Listening skills
- Confidence
- Love for language and learning

Parents are strongly encouraged to read storybooks daily with children in both Hindi and English.

English Books

- ❖ The Gruffalo
- ❖ Pete the Cat

Hindi Books

- ❖ तेनालीराम की कहानियाँ

Even 15-20 minutes of reading every day can make a big difference in language development and create a lifelong love for books.
