TOPIC – TRADITIONAL DRESSES OF MANIPUR

General Instructions:

- (iii) It must be completed in 8-9 pages.
- (iv) Use coloured A4 size coloured sheets to write the contents.
- (v) Write on the front page: ART INTEGRATED PROJECT – CLASS VII–
TOPIC – STUDENT'S NAME–
- (vi) Begin with index, acknowledgement and brief Introduction with the title.
- (vii) Add pictures/drawings/graphs/data representation with brief descriptions and subject based points.
- (viii) Write the answer for each subject question in 1–2 pages only and staple all sheets neatly in one folder.
