## From the Desk of Hon'ble Patron

Our personality has a direct bearing on our work. It matters even more in case of managers who are often in public contact. Many times we have to face situation when we are held responsible for certain lapses without any fault or mistake on our part and we have to pay a price for the same. In such a situation, if our personality is weak, we can spoil our future by getting disappointed or worsen the situation by losing our balance. It is, therefore, necessary for a good manager to develop an integrated personality. This write-up is being devoted to this aspect of the management. If we understand the word 'personality' in a wider perspective, stress free management becomes easy.

Each person has distinct personality. Some features of the personality impress us and some not. We all want to have an attractive personality but very few understand the necessary aspects of it. For most good personality means to look handsome and prosperous from outside and they pay no attention to the development of inner personality. That is why that despite lot of intellect at the level of administrators or managers, general reputation is bad. In the process neither the individuals are benefitted nor the society. On the other hand a person with integrated personality is not only an asset for the society, he himself remains happy and peaceful apart from being successful. He is also an inspiration for others.

When we talk of an integrated personality, it indicates that personality has more than one component. Only when all the components are adequately developed, does the personality become integrated or total. What are these components and what are the characteristics attached to them? We shall use the word 'dimension' in place of 'component' in order to give it a large scope. Here is a brief discussion on each.

The first dimension of our personality is 'physical'. It relates to our body, state of health, appearance, etc. Though this dimension is very important, we have little control over it. By and large the shape, size and the colour of our body is determined by our genes. The only thing in our hands is to maintain it well in order to remain healthy. For this, certain discipline is required in our habits. If we cultivate good habits, the body becomes an asset and the development of other dimensions of the personality becomes easier. For example, early rising and early to bed, simple food, regular exercises and cleanliness are habits which keep our bodies healthy. A healthy body generally also means a healthy mind. If the body gives trouble, it becomes difficult to concentrate on other things. Therefore, the development of other dimensions of the personality is also dependent on this dimension which may become less important once the other dimensions develop.

The second dimension of our personality is 'mental'. It relates to the mind which is superior to the body. Thus, this dimension of the personality is superior to the first one. It is the mind which works behind our sense organs. The eye cannot see if the mind refuses to accept the signals and so is the case with other sense organs. Similarly, the mind is capable of making our sense organs indulge in right or wrong activities. Thus, proper development of the 'Mental Dimension' is very important for using the powers of the physical body. It is the mind which makes us educated,



skilled in our jobs and enthusiastic about our progress. Those who apply their minds in the right direction, achieve success in their goals. Some of us become doctors, engineers, businessmen or administrators according to our mental make-up. It is mainly the mental dimension which gives us the capacity to take care of our physical needs. But to say that personality development stops here is not correct. We have to add something more to our personality in order to make it integrated and this takes us to the third dimension.

Before we come to the third dimension, some elaboration is necessary. We all know that certain doctors are very kind, sympathetic and helpful while others are not so. It may be that someone in the latter category is more competent professionally but in terms of personality, the compassionate doctor is always considered to be better. The same goes for other professions also. We always prefer a person who is good, kind, helpful and courteous even if those who are not so, are mentally or professionally more competent. This establishes the fact that there is a superior dimension of personality over the mental one. This dimension is known as 'Intellectual'. As said earlier, the mind, though superior to the sense organs, is capable of playing mischief if not controlled by a superior faculty. This faculty is called the 'Intellect'. It is the intellect which gives us the wisdom to discriminate between good and bad. Obviously a person with such wisdom has a better personality compared to a person which makes us capable of better judgement and, therefore, useful, also for the society at large. In the process we earn respect and are considered to be good.

To add perfection to our personality, some finer qualities have to be acquired, even by good persons who may also suffer if they do not strive for them. This dimension of the personality is the 'Spiritual' one, the highest dimension. It is a fact that the world we live in is transitory. Even our good deeds are forgotten with time. Therefore, there is a need to transcend them too. If we do not do so, the same goodness may become a cause of misery. Also, goodness is only a relative term and its perception varies with persons and time. We do not get the same response from all persons, even for our good behavior or virtues. Therefore, a sense of detachment has to be developed towards our good qualities too. It has been seen that many good and successful persons suffer just because they lack this aspect of the personality. One has to accept that all our actions are only a means to an end and the end is self-realisation. Those who understand this reality, develop the spiritual dimension at the right time and are fully prepared for all the eventualities of life. This dimension is thus superior to the earlier three dimensions and is necessary for the complete integration of the personality.

The idea, without going into more details, is to convey that for an integrated personality, all dimensions are necessary. They, of course, generally follow the order in which they have been described. I consider those four aspects like the four legs of a table which give it stability. Though a table with three or less number of legs may appear to be stable, any push or pressure will destabilise it. Similarly, a person with any of the dimensions missing may appear to be stable but is vulnerable to any accident in life which may disturb his equilibrium.

It is only a person with all the four dimensions developed, who can maintain cool in all circumstances and thus lead a stress free life whether professional or personal.

Mount Etna known as one of the most powerful volcanoes on the planet, may all not be a 'real' volcano after all, claim scientists. According to researchers, Etna produces around seven million tons of steam, carbon, dioxide and sulphur dioxide every year, despite the tones of molten rock it spews across the island of Sicily. Therefore, the mountain is more like a giant hot spring than a 'true volcano' the claim. ## “लाफिंग गैस क्या है? इसके सूंघने से हंसी क्यों आ जाती है?”

ब्रिटेन के जोसेफ प्रीस्टले नामक वैज्ञानिक ने 1772 ई. में नाइट्रस ऑक्साइड (N<sub>2</sub>O) गैस का आविष्कार किया था। इस गैस का उपयोग हेरेस वाल्स द्वारा 1844 ई0 में निश्चेतक के रूप में किया गया और तब से यह बिना दर्द अनुभव किए दांत निकालने के लिए निश्चेतक की तरह उपयोग में आने लगी। धीरे-धीरे इस गैस की एक विशेषता और सामने आई। जब कोई व्यक्ति इस गैस को अधिक मात्रा में सूंघ लेता है तो वह उत्तेजित होकर जोर-जोर से हंसने लगता है। अपने इस गुण के कारण ही नाइट्रस ऑक्साइड (N<sub>2</sub>O) को हंसाने वाली गैस या लाफिंग गैस के नाम से पुकारा जाने लगा।

इसके सूंघने पर हंसी आने का कारण यह है कि यह गैस रक्त में मिलकर मस्तिष्क के हंसी केंद्र को उत्तेजित कर देती है। इस गैस का असर बहुत जल्दी होती है और बहुत कम समय में समाप्त हो जाता है। इसलिए असर समाप्त होते ही मनुष्य शांत भी जल्दी हो जाता है। फिर भी इसे अधिक मात्रा में नहीं सूंघना चाहिए, अन्यथा हिस्टीरिया के हल्के दौर पर सकते हैं।

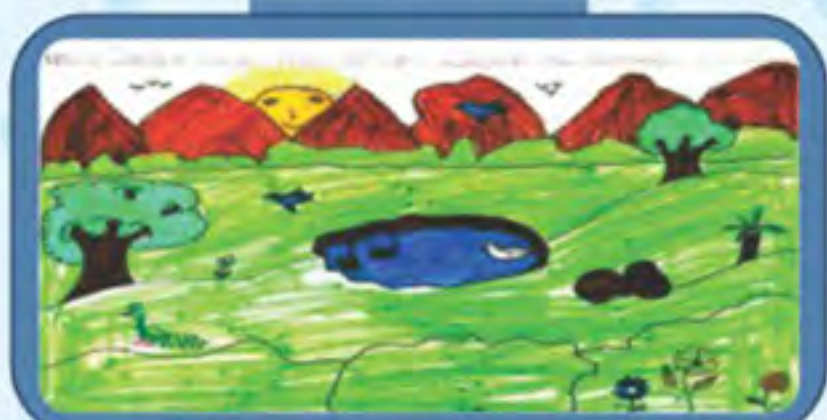

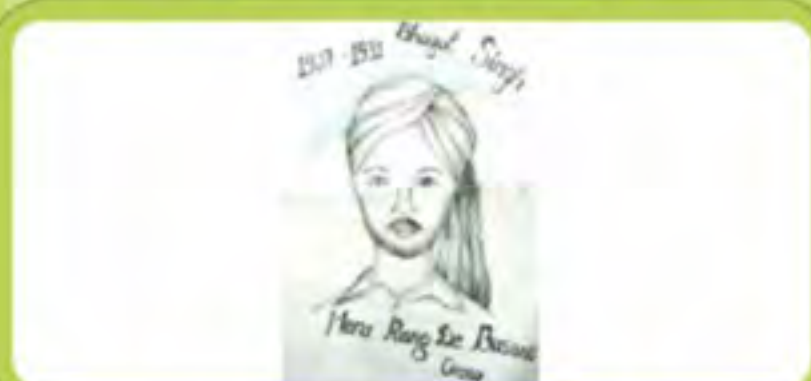

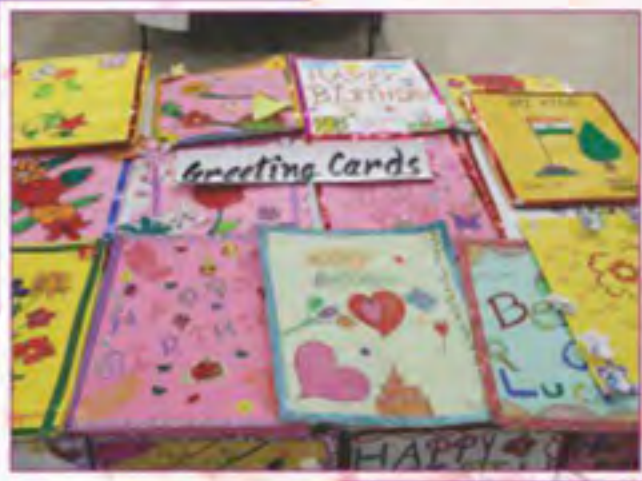

## CHILD LABOUR

Not all children in India are lucky to enjoy their childhood. Many of them are forced to work under inhuman conditions where their miseries know no end. Though there are laws banning child labour, still children continue to be exploited as cheap labour. It is because the authorities are unable to implement the laws meant to protect children from being engaged as labourers.

Unfortunately, the actual number of child labourers in India goes un-detected. Children are forced to work in completely unregulated condition without adequate food, proper wages, and rest. They are subjected to physical, sexual and emotional abuse.

**Causes of Child Labour:** Factors such as poverty, lack of social security, the increasing gap between the rich and the poor have adversely affected children more than any other group. We have failed to provide universal education, which results in children dropping out of school and entering the labour force.

Loss of jobs of parents in a slowdown, farmers' suicide, armed conflicts and high costs of healthcare are other factors contributing to child labour.

**A widespread problem:** Due to high poverty and poor schooling opportunities, child labour is quite prevalent in India. Child labour is found in rural as well as urban areas. The 2001 census found an increase in the number of child labourers from 11.28 million in 1991 to 12.59 million.

Children comprise 40% of the labour in the precious stone cutting sector. They are also employed in other industries such as mining, zari and embroidery, dhabas, tea stalls and restaurants and in homes as domestic labour.

**Conclusion:** Government authorities and civil society organizations need to work in tandem to free children engaged in labour under abysmal conditions. They need to be rescued from exploitative working conditions and supported with adequate education. Above all, there is a need to mobilize public opinion with an aim to bring about an effective policy initiative to abolish child labour in all its forms.

अनियोजित शहरीकरण आज सिक्की एक प्रदेश की नहीं बल्कि पूरे देश की समस्या है आजादी के सत्तर सालों में जहाँ कस्बे शहरी, शहर नगर और नगर महानगर बनते हैं चले गये, वहीं गाँवों की स्थिति में कोई खास बदलाव नहीं आया। तेजी से हो रहे शहरीकरण और नगरीकरण का ही नतीजा है कि चार लेने वाली सड़को पर सरपत दौडती गाड़ियों चौराहो पर चमचमाती तेज लाइटें और सड़को पर रेंगती भीड़ के बीच जीवन का असली मकसद जैसे कही खो गया है शहर विकास में भूमिका निभाते है। अच्छी शिक्षा अच्छा जीवन अच्छे कामकाज, रोजगार एवं चिकित्सा की तलाश में लोग शहरो की ओर भाग रहें है एक अनुमान के अनुसार एक करोड लोग हर हफ्ते रोजी-रोटी और तरक्की के सपने संजोए गाँवों से शहरों की ओर चले आते है। दुनिया की करीब आधी आबादी शहरों में बसने लगी है वातावरण के हर साल घुलने वाली अस्सी फीसदी कार्बन डाई आक्साइड इन्ही शहरों से आती है संयुक्त राष्ट्र का यह मानना है कि अगर शहरों से आती है संयुक्त राष्ट्र का यह मानना है कि अगर शहरों में बढ़ रही आबादी वाले बड़े शहरो पर भविष्य में बाढ़ और अन्य प्राकृतिक आददाओं का खतरा बढ़ जायेगा।

शहरों पर ज्यो-त्यो आबादी का बोझा बढ़ रह है कि लोगों को मिलने वाली सुविधाओं में कमी आ रही है विश्व स्वास्थ्य संगठन के मुताबिक विकासशील देशों में करीब नब्बे करोड़ लोग झुग्गी झोपड़ी में रहते है ऐसे में जहाँ उनके लिए स्वास्थ्य सम्बन्धी परेशानी बढ़ी है वहीं पर्यावरण को भी गंभीर नुकसान पहुँचा है प्रदूषण के चलते शहरों में हर साल करीब दस लाख लोग असमय मौत के शिकार हो जाते है शहरीकरण के कारण रोजमर्रा की समस्याये भी बढ़ी है इसमें जनसंख्या वृत्ति, गरीबी, बेकारी, बाल अपराध, महिला उम्पीडन, भीडभाड, गंदी

बस्तियाँ, आवास की कमी, बिजली एवं जल पूर्ति की कमी, प्रदूषण, मदिरापान, और अन्य मादक पदार्थों के सेवन, संचार एवं यातायात सुविधाओं सम्बन्धी समस्याये प्रमुख है। संघन शहरीकरण का एक प्रभाव भाव-शून्यता, संवेदनहीनता, और उदासीनता के रूप में भी देखने को मिलता है व्यक्ति अपनी समस्यायों में इतना उलझा है कि उने आस-पडोस की खबर भी नहीं होती। बहुमजिला इमारत के ऊपरी माले पर रहने वाला व्यक्ति नीचे माले वाले व्यक्ति को नहीं जानता है।

साल दर साल कस्बों, नगरो, महानगरों की संख्या में निरंतर वृत्ति होती जा रही है। 2001 से 2011 के बीच देश में 2532 नए कस्बे अस्तित्व में आये। 1971 में एक लाख से अधिक आबादी वाले शहरों की संख्या मात्र 151 थी जो आज बढ़कर 302 हो गयी है।

नए-नए नगर महानगर बने इससे भला किसे उतराज हो सकता है लेकिन उके अनुरूप सड़क, बिजली, पानी, आवास, यातायात साफ सफाई की वयवस्था भी तो जुटाई जाए। पर्यावरण को हो रहे नुकसान का प्रमुख हवा तलाश पाना मुश्किल होता जा रहा है। इससे बचाव का एक ही उपाय है लोग जिस कम धंधे की तलाश में गाँव छोडकर शहर आते है अगर गाँव में ही ऐसी व्यवस्था जुटा दी जाए जिससे कि उनकी झमता, योग्यता और आजीविका की तलाश पूरी जाए तो पलायन भी रुक सकेगा और अनियोजित शहरीकरण से उत्पन्न होने वाली समस्यायों पर भी एक हद तक नियंत्रण पाया जा सकेगा।

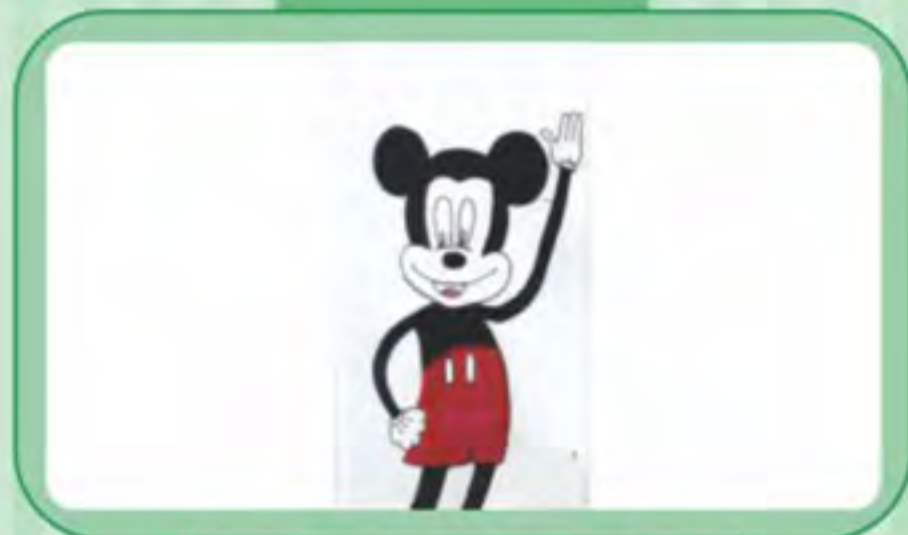

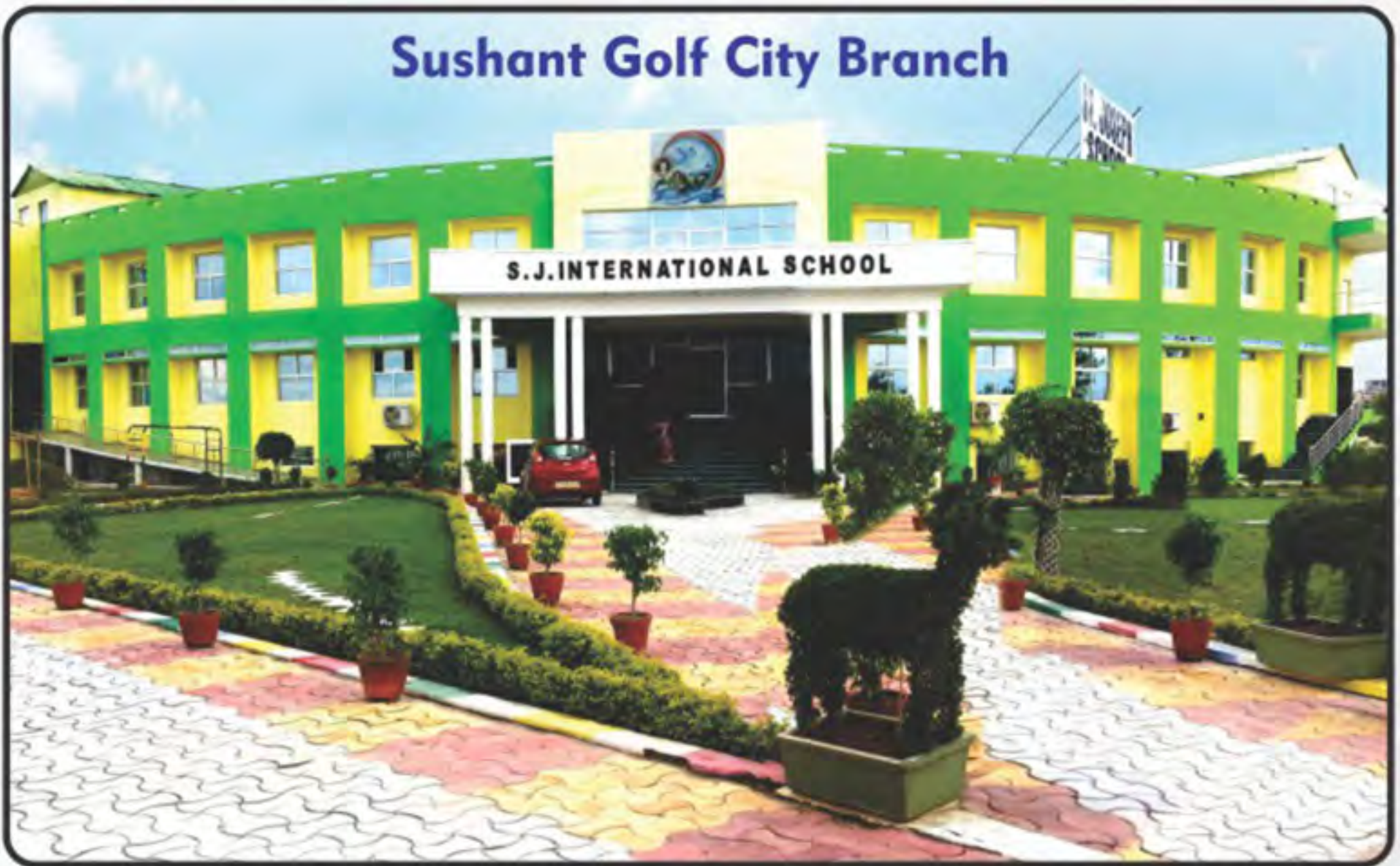
