- A **rainbow** with different colored arcs for each type
- **Storage boxes**, where each box holds one kind of noun

- **1 small drawing or symbol** for each type (e.g., a crown for Proper Nouns, a group icon for Collective Nouns)

✂ **Neatness & Labeling:**


- Keep your handwriting legible.

- ✓ A short biography (birth, early life, education, major events)
- ✓ Key contributions in literature (books, poems, genres they worked in)
- ✓ Names of at least 3 famous works
- ✓ Literary style or theme they are known for
- ✓ 2 memorable quotes written in calligraphy
- ✓ A personal reflection: “Why I Chose This Author” – write 3 lines in your own words
- ✓ At least 1 hand-drawn illustration (portrait, book cover, or symbolic item)
