Include:

- ✓ All **8 parts of speech**: Noun, Pronoun, Verb, Adjective, Adverb, Preposition, Conjunction, Interjection
- ✓ A **definition** in your own words for each
- ✓ At least **2 original example sentences** per part
- ✓ **One drawing or creative symbol** for each part to show meaning (e.g., a crown for nouns = naming words)

Colors: Use **different colors** for each part of speech to make your chart eye-catching and clear.

Neatness: Keep your handwriting legible and your design tidy—**don't overcrowd**.

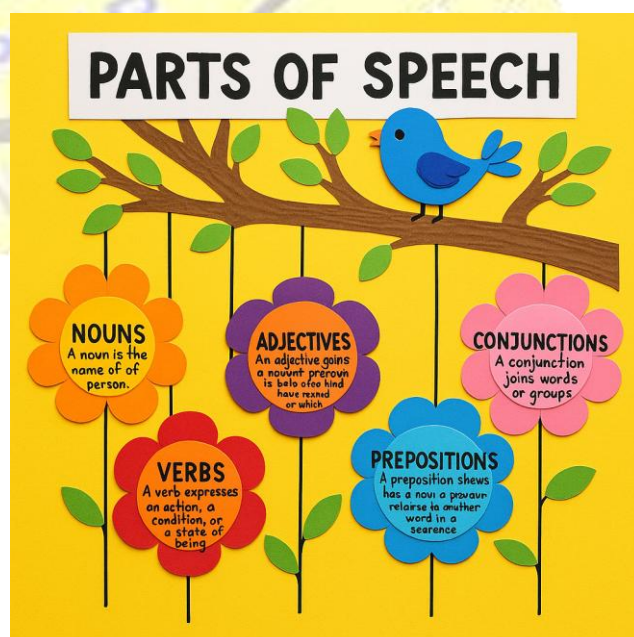
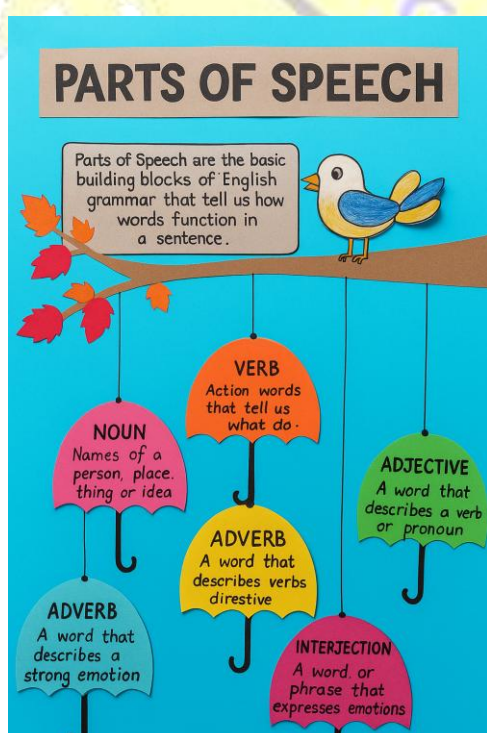

Include the Following:

- ✓ A short biography (birth, childhood, family, early life)
- ✓ Key achievements (plays, poems, theaters founded)
- ✓ His famous works (at least 5 play/poem titles)
- ✓ His contributions to English literature and theatre
- ✓ 2 famous quotes by Shakespeare
- ✓ A section on "*Why is Shakespeare still remembered today?*" in your own words
- ✓ At least 2 hand-drawn illustrations (e.g., Globe Theatre, Shakespeare portrait, dramatic masks)


 **Color & Creativity:** Use borders, calligraphy, and visuals to enhance appeal. Organize neatly with headings and subheadings.

 **Neatness:** Keep handwriting legible and layout organized. Avoid too much text in one area.

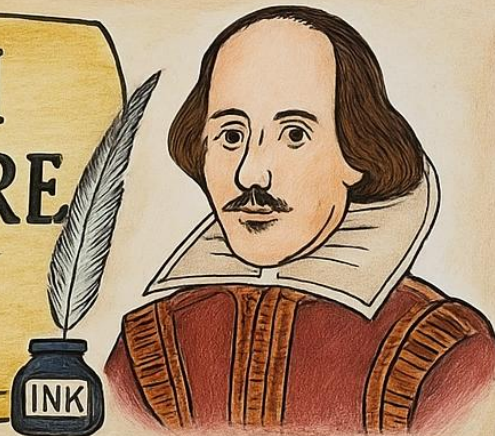

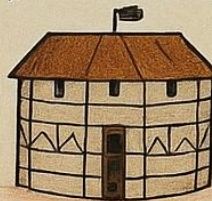
