Important Instructions for CBSE Class 10, 12 Board Exam 2023

Students will be subjected to extensive and compulsory physical frisking before entering the examination centre.

- 1. Candidates must report to their respective exam centre dressed in their proper blue school uniform, with their CBSE admit card 2023 and valid school ID card.
- 2. Candidates are required to read and follow the crucial guidelines on the admit card.
- 3. Candidates must ensure appropriate travel plans based on the weather, traffic and other important aspects that may affect their travelling to the exam centre on time.
- 4. To ensure reaching the exam centre on time for the exam, candidates are advised to visit the exam centre a day before the examination starts.
- 5. After 10:00 am, no candidate would be permitted to enter the testing location. So, you must arrive on time.

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Stationery item i.e., Transparent Pouch, Geometry/Pencil Box, Blue/Royal Blue Ink/Ball Point/Gel Pen, Scale, Writing Pad, Eraser, Analogue Watch, Trans-parent Water Bottles and Hand Sanitizer 50 ml.
- Metro Card, Bus Pass.

BARRED ITEMS

- ➤ Any stationery item such as textual material (printed or written), bits of papers, Calculator, Pen Drives,Log Table (shall be provided by the centres), Electronic Pen/ Scanner, etc.
- Any communication device such as Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Earphones, Microphone, Pager, Health Band, Camera, etc.
- > Other items like Wallet, Goggles, Handbags, pouches, etc.
- > Any eatable item opened or packed, except for diabetic students.
- Any other item which could be used for unfair means.
- Use of above or similar items will be treated under "Unfair Means" category and will attract punishment as per rules.
