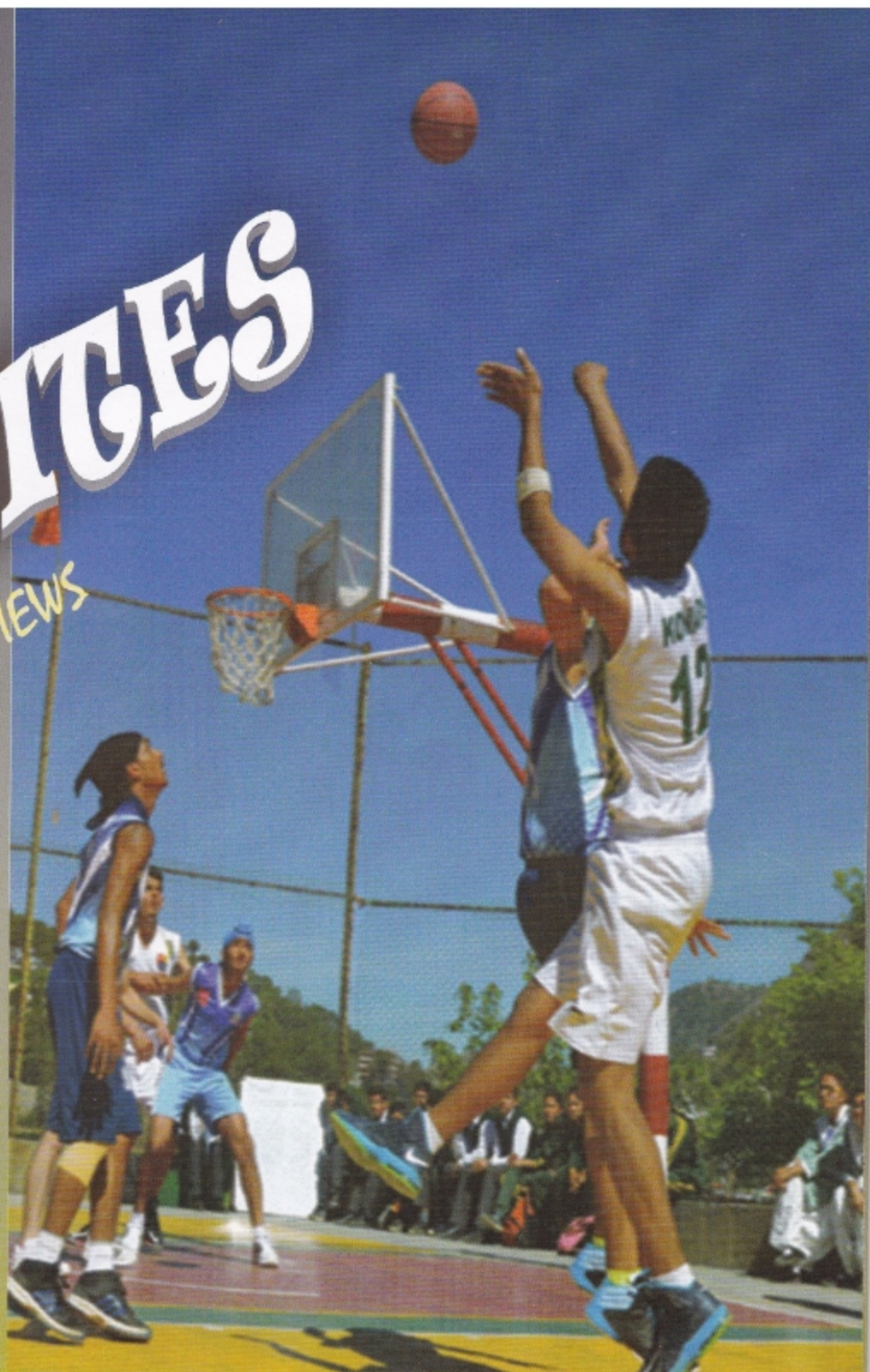

Dear Parents

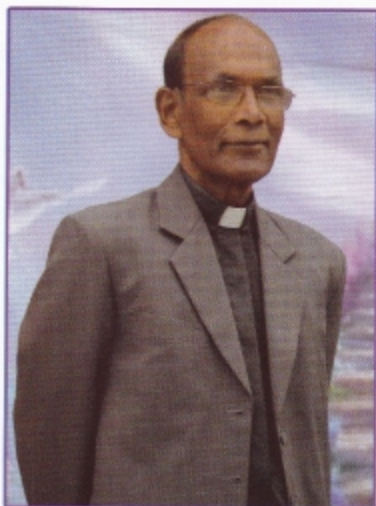

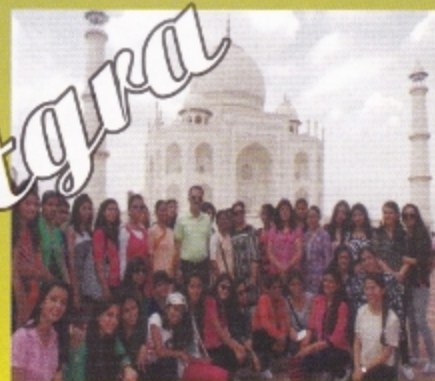

I'll give you a simple example. In 1938, there was a man in the Hungarian army known as Karoly. He was known as the best pistol shooter in the country and had won many national championships. Everyone was sure that Karoly would be the gold medalist in the 1940 Olympics in pistol shooting. He had been practicing for many years and had only one dream and that was to make his hand the best shooting hand in the whole world. But in 1938, exactly 2 years before the Olympics, he lost his right hand in an accident in an army camp, actually a bomb exploded in his hand. He had two options, one was to sit and cry. But he chose the other one, he didn't focus on what he did not have, he focused on what he had and that was his left hand. A hand from which he couldn't even write at that time. It was totally an illusion for him to make his left hand, world's best shooting hand. After one month, he started practicing with his left hand, his right hand was hurting a lot. Still he didn't give up. He came back in National Games in 1939. All the competitors there were competing with their best hand while this man was competing with his only hand. And the man with the only hand won the national championship. He didn't stop there. He focused on the 1940 Olympics. Again everyone was pretty sure that he would win. But such is the irony of life that the 1940 Olympics were cancelled. He tried for the 1944 Olympics but they too got cancelled. He still didn't give up and participated in the 1948 Olympics.

In 1938 he was 28 years old and now he was 38. Also he was not competing with his best hand but with his only hand. Along with this he had to compete with younger participants who were competing with their best hand. And the man with only hand won again. In 1952 Olympics he participated again and again he bagged the gold medal. He was the first shooter to win two gold medals consecutively in the Olympics.

Karoly changed his goggles of pain and depression with that of determination. We all have the capability to do that, all we need to do is change our goggles and thus transform our ILLUSIONS INTO REALITY.

विनम्रता का महत्त्व

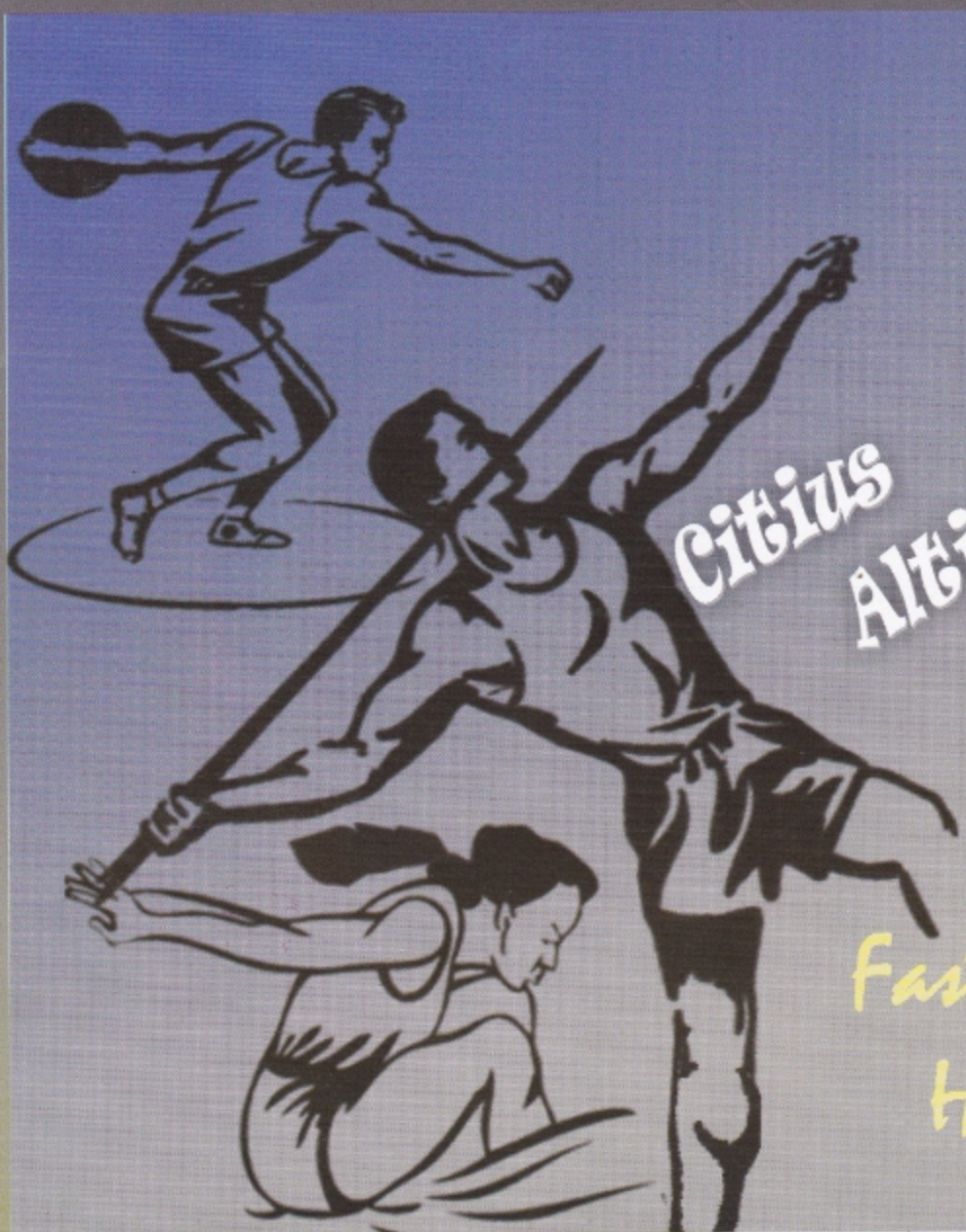
विनम्रता कमजोरी का नहीं बरन् विद्वता, बुद्धिमता और योग्यता का चिह्न है । जिस
