Procedure, Rules and Regulations:

- 1. The Management reserves to itself the right of admission.
- 2. The School generally gives preference to its own students. However the admission will not be given in the following cases, if:
 - (a) The student has record of being indisciplined.
 - (b) The student has poor academic record.
 - (c) The parents are irregular in attending the Parent-Teacher Meeting.
 - (d) The students are defaulters in submitting the assignment and are irregular/late to school.
 - (e) The student indulges in the physical fights or mental harassment to other students.
 - (f) The student is found destroying the school property.

3. Before admitting students to the different streams, the school will counsel them regarding appropriate choices, apart from availability of seats in the particular stream.

The minimum percentage required in various streams is as follows:

MEDICAL STREAM - 75% in Science in Pre- Board Examination.

Main Subjects - English Core, Physics, Chemistry and

Biology

Optional - Informatics Practices /Physical Education/Economics

NON MEDICAL - 75% in Science and Maths in Pre-Board Examination

STREAM

Main Subjects - English Core, Maths, Physics and Chemistry

Optional - Informatics Practices/ Physical Education/Economics

COMMERCE STREAM - 60% in Pre-Board Examination with a minimum of

60% in Maths

Main Subjects - English Core, Economics, Accountancy and

Business Studies

Optional - Maths & Physical Education,

Informatics Practices
