From The Desk of The Principal

The Inception of SMCS, Ghaziabad (UP)

"Great indeed are your works Oh! Lord ____"

These words of the Psalmist indeed become so true today as I look back to the past 25 eventful years.

Twenty-five years have passed somewhat swiftly. It is indeed a moment of great joy, and certainly of gratitude to God, and to many persons who were part and parcel of the building up of this Institution. Twenty-five years ago, precisely on 23rd July 1979, we started St. Mary's Convent School in a small rented apartment in Model Town. This humble beginning was made in response to an invitation received by Sister Gemma, the then Superior General of our Congregation from late Rev. Father Amedeous, ofmcap, the Parish Priest of Sacred Heart Church, Ghaziabad to start a school especially for the children of the Railway Colony. We were four of us: Sister Margaret, Sister Lillian, Sister Shalini and I who pioneered this new School. Today it is a moment of pride for me to be back in St. Mary's at its Jubilee year. I gratefully recall the help and support given by late Rev. Father Amedeous ofmcap of revered memory.

The school premises had to be shifted from Model Town to Nehru Nagar after some three months for better accommodation. In 1986 Sister Gemma took charge of the School and she found it necessary to shift the school once again to a larger accommodation in Kavinagar. With God's blessing and with the help of many people Sister Gemma was able to buy the present plot of land from Ghaziabad Development Authority during the tenure of Mr. P.N. Misra, I.A.S the Vice Chairman, and had the foundation stone laid for this building on 15th July 1988 by the commissioner of Meerut, Mr.V.K. Dewan I.A.S.

The first phase of the building was completed and it was blessed by Rev. Fr. Bernard Daniel and inaugurated by Mr. P.N. Misra on 22nd July 1989.

The School has seen a steady progress over the years with the help of God and our Blessed Mother Mary, the Patroness of this School, and with the sustained efforts of the various Principals and managers who held the helm of affairs during these past twenty five years. The management, which rests with the Franciscan Sisters of Our Lady of Graces, has put in many resources for the development and expansion of this School. Here I would like to thank in a special way the Superiors General: Sister Gemma. Sister Jane, Sister Matilda, and Sister Mercy the present Superior General for the keen interest they have taken for the advancement of this School. Here I would like to recall the valuable service made by all our Sisters who were part of our Community over these years. I would like to make a special mention of Sister Kathleen and Sister Smitha who have assisted much in the expansion work of the building. The School Auditorium has been the latest addition to the infrastructure.

Several persons have helped us in different manners especially in the initial years of the School - they are our benefactors and well-wishers to all of whom I want to say a big thank you. I would like to make a special mention of: Mr. R.K Tyagi, Mr. N.K Chibber, Mr J.K. Bansal Mr. E.J. Thomas, Mr. P.J. Joseph and Mr. P.A. Paul.

We are happy to say that St. Mary's Convent School is one of the leading Schools of the city today. The First Batch of ICSE students gave the Examination in March 1997 and came out with cent percent First Division Result and high





distinctions. The subsequent Batches continued the trend and brought laurels to the School. We have a team of hard working and committed teachers to whom I am grateful for their spirit of dedication and loyalty. I would also like to remember gratefully all those former members of the staff who have given their best to this institution. May God bless them all.

The School gives a special emphasis on the character formation and the overall development of the personality of the children inculcating in them spiritual and humane values. The alumnae of our School take pride in their Alma Mater and

are today well placed in various sectors of Service, and are contributing to the development of the Nation.

I thank God Almighty for the marvelous way He has guided our footsteps along these twentyfive years of our growth and development. I entrust ourselves into His loving hands and ask Him to help us to make still greater strides in the years to come.

We honour our Present Superior General and the President of the educational Society SMCS Rev. Sr. Mercy FSLG for her kind support and able guidance.



well as girls team did exceedingly well at the recently held "Inter house basketball competition and won first position in the volleyball tournament.



various themes related to National Integration and Unity.


- Christmas Celebration: During this

The Great Tsunami Disaster

26 December 2004, around 6:00 am in the morning, when people, still asleep in their cozy beds, tired of the enjoyments of the Christmas, yet fresh enough for welcoming the new year. But, their cozy beds were no longer the same, because it happened to be the dooms day call at about 6.00 in the morning. A great earthquake epicentred near Indonesia caused great havoc to various countries in South east Asia. The Tsunami disaster that has claimed over 150,000 lives in south-east Asia, was triggered by the world's biggest earthquake in four decades. Several countries of the region are severely struck by it. These include India, SriLanka, Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia, Myanmar, Somalia and Bangladesh.

Tsunami, in Japanese means 'Tidal waves' that played havoc recently. It spread north and west across the Bay of Bengal and Indian Ocean with a magnitude of 8.9 on the Richter Scale, one of the most powerful in history, off the Indonesian island of Sumatra, devastated southern Asia and triggered waves up to

30 feet high.

These waves are usually caused by seismic disturbances-coastal earth quakes, volcanoes (eruptions) or under sea landslides that shake the ocean floor. A Tsunami is not a single wave, but a series of waves, that can travel across the ocean at the speed of more than 800 kms an hour.

Many people have lost their lives while returning home, thinking that the waves had stopped, because these waves may or may not be continuous. The recent one was triggered by ten earthquakes - four in

Sumatra and six in Nicobar.

The recent Tsunami, presented a dreadful scenario before us. Many big buildings in coastal cities like Nagapattinam and Karaikal had developed cracks and many were even blown up due to the water pressure. People suffered a highly pathetic situation. Firstly, they were shaken by the earthquake and then were washed away by the great waves. There was chaos and disorder everywhere. The huts and slums were swept, the electric poles were bent near the beaches and many cars were seen crushed by these



waves. Mr.Kofi Annan, the Secretary General of the UN said, "What misdeeds have I done, so I'm seeing the hell", while in Sumatra during his visit there. The southernmost point of India, Indira point is no more on the map of India. Various small islands near the Andaman and Nicobar have the population of just 20 to 30 people. There is no connection between this world and the world where thousands of innocent lives are gone.

But, we Indians have great sympathy for those our brothers and sisters who lost their lives in this great disaster. People all over the country generously donated money and now it's more than Rs. 500 crore in the prime minister's relief fund. As many as 17,500 personnels from the three services of the armed forces were involved in the relief operations in Andaman and Nicobar island. These include 8000 army men, 5,500 navy personnel and 2,000 from the Indian Air Force. Operations from India were also sent to Sri Lanka.

According to experts, India or any other country badly affected could not receive the Tsunami warning signals because none of these places had such

mechanisms so as to receive the signals.

People who have lost their near and dear ones can never come out of the shocking distress of losing them.

Let's all pray to God for them.




Fast Food A Sweet Poison







My teacher told me that the school magazine was going to be published. A smile came on my face because I got a chance to express my feelings and my dream.





Divide by the common factor, (x-y) gives


y=x+y




The Child Is The Father Of Man

their facial feathers funnel sound to the ear canal. With one flat disc like ear larger than the other, placed slightly above the other, spotting a small animal becomes a much more accurate affair.

Large, light-sensitive eyes located in front of their faces give them binocular vision. They can see at least 10 times better than we can. Interestingly, because their eyes are so big, there is no room left for eye muscles. This is why, unlike humans and many other animals, owls cannot move their

eyes and they must turn their entire heads to follow

moving objects!


child, who was more engrossed in his studies most of the time.





"सुनामी का कहर"

"जब महानगर ने ली अंगड़ाई, महाप्रलय के रूप में सुनामी आयी। थर-थर काँप गयी धरती भी, चारों ओर महाविनाश की घटा छाई।।"

भारत की प्राकृतिक आपदा के इतिहास में 26 दिसम्बर, 2004 की तारीख मोटे अक्षरों में दर्ज हो गई है। इस दिन सुबह पूर्वी समुद्र तट से टकरायी सागर की विकराल लहरों ने हजारों जाने ले लीं।

हजारों को लापता और लाखों को बेघर कर दिया। करोड़ों की संपत्ति देखते ही देखते मटियामेट को गयी। वह कारनामा उन सुनामी लहरों का था, जिनसे हिन्दुस्तान को सुरक्षित माना जाता था।

सन् 2004 की आखिरी इतवार की सुबह थी। खबर मिली कि सुमात्रा के पास सागर में जोरदार भूकंप आया है। किन्तु कोई खास नुकसान न होने के कारण इस खबर को ज्यादा अहमियत नहीं दी गयी। लेकिन समुद्र के रास्ते एक महाविपदा दबे पांव हिन्दुस्तान के सागर तटों की ओर बढ़ रही थी। आम जनों से लेकर प्रशासक और वैज्ञानिक तक तेजी से आगे बढ़ रहे इस खतरे से अनजान थे। अभी लोगों की दिनचर्या शुरू भी नहीं हुई थी कि सागर की लहरों ने विकराल रूप धारण कर समुद्र तट पर हमला बोल दिया। बेरोकटोक-बेखौफ लहरें अपनी सीमा तोड़कर अंदर घुस आयीं। अपने साथ सबकुछ बहा ले गयीं। देखते-देखते हर ओर मौत और तबाही का भयानक मंजर दिखायी देने लगा और इसके साथ ही देश के घर-घर में एक नया नाम बार-बार गूँजने लगा- सुनामी.... सुनामी, सुनामी। सुनने में यह नाम जितना मीठा, मधुर लगता है, इसके कारनामे उतने ही खतरनाक, और भयानक हैं। जापानी मूल के इस शब्द का अर्थ है- ''बंदरगाह की लहरें''। लेकिन ये अपने नाम के ठीक विपरीत कार्य करती हुई बंदरगाह से बहुत दूर तक उपद्रव मचाती हैं। इनमें मौजूद अथाह ऊर्जा विध्वंस का कारण बनती हैं।

विनाशकारी सुनामी लहरों को कई बार बड़े आकार की ज्वार की लहरें मान लिया जाता है, जबिक इन दोनों के बीच मात्र इतनी ही समानता है कि दोनों सागर में उत्पन्न हाती हैं। दोनों के जन्म की कहानी पूर्णत: अलग है। ज्वार की लहरें चन्द्रमा के आकर्षण का नतीजा है जबिक सुनामी लहरें भूकंप, भूस्खलन या ज्वालामुखी विस्फोट का परिणाम होती हैं।

हाल में सागर में किसी बड़े श्रुदग्रह यानी ऐस्टोरॉयड के गिरने की सभांवना को भी सुनामी की उत्पत्ति का जिरया माना जा रहा है। विज्ञान की भाषा में कहें तो यह सारा खेल बेहद बड़े पैमाने पर पानी के विस्थापन का है।

भूंकप या भूस्खलन के कारण जब भी सागर की तलहटी में कोई बड़ा बदलाव आता है, कोई हलचल होती है तो उसे जगह देने के लिए उतना ही ज्यादा पानी अपनी जगह से विस्थापित होता है और लहरों के रूप में किनारों की ओर चल देता है। यही लहरें सुनामी लहरें कहलाती हैं। यह भी कह सकते हैं कि सुनामी लहरें सागर में आए बदलाव को संतुलित करने का प्राकृतिक प्रयास है। "उजड़ गए चमन कहाँ गया अमन, चारों ओर उदासीनता छाई। भय, क्रोध, शोक, असमंजस की, काली घटा आसमान पर छाई।।"

सुनामी की ऊर्जा का अन्दाजा लगाना भी कठिन है। हम बस इतना मान सकते हैं कि सुनामी की ऊर्जा हिरोशिमा पर गिराए गए परमाणु बम से 350 गुना ज्यादा पायी गयी। इन विनाशकारी लहरों में पाँच मेगाटन ऊर्जा समाई थी, जबिक परमाणु बम से केवल 15 किलोटन ऊर्जा ही निकली थी। सुनामी लहरें अपनी विशेष प्रकृति के कारण इस ऊर्जा को बड़ी तेज रफ्तार से सागर तटों तक पहुँचाने में सक्षम होती है। अगर सागर में उत्पन्न होने वाली सामान्य लहरों से इनकी तुलना करें तो पता चलता है कि आम लहरों में दो तरगों के बीच का समय मात्र पाँच से बीस सेकेंड़ होता है, जबिक सुनामी में यह समय 10 मिनट से लेकर दो घंटे तक हो सकता है। इन विनाशकारी सुनामी लहरों की रफ्तार लगभग 100 कि. मी. प्रति घंटा आंकी गयी। इन्हीं तथ्यों से सुनामी की विनाशकारी ताकत का सहज अनुमान लगाया जा सकता है।

लंबे अरसे से भारत को सुनामी से सुरक्षित समझा जाने के कारण भारत ने इस कहर से बचने के लिए कोई अलग चेतावनी प्रणाली स्थापित नहीं की थी। परंतु 'देर आए, दुरूस्त आए' की तर्ज पर काम करते हुए भारत ने भी आधुनिक सुनामी चेतावनी प्रणाली स्थापित करने की योजना बना ली है। इसके लिए विशेष 'बाय' बनाए जाएंगे, जिन्हें हिन्द महासागर में 6 कि. मी. की गहराई पर जगह—जगह स्थापित किया जाएगा और इसकी सहायता से इंडोनेशिया तक आने वाले भूकंपों का सागर पर प्रभाव आंका जा सकेगा। यह प्रणाली इतनी संवेदी होगी कि सागर के जल स्तर में मात्र एक सेंटीमीटर का अचानक आया उफान भी इसकी नजरों से बच नहीं पाएगा इस प्रणाली को स्थापित करने का खर्च लगभग 125 करोड़ रूपये होने का अनुमान है। परन्तु सुनामी की वर्तमान विभीषिका को देखते हुए यह खर्च नगण्य प्रतीत होता है।

उचित समय पर चेतावनी जारी हाने के बाद भी यह तो निश्चित है कि सुनामी की विकराल लहरें तट पर हमला अवश्य बोलेंगी। परन्तु फिलहाल हमारे लिए आवश्यक है कि हम सुनामी लहरों से उत्पन्न होने वाली आपदा से विशेष प्रबंधन की तैयारी करें, ताकि यह विभीषिका फिर से तबाही का मंजर पैदा न कर सके। साथ ही हम इस प्राकृतिक आपदा का डट कर सामना करें और यह याद रखें कि:

"जिन्दगी फिर खुशियाँ लाएगी, रात के बाद नई सुबह आएगी। नया जोश नया उत्साह, आत्मविश्वास व आशा की किरण जगाएगी।।"







''सफलता के शिखर पर पहुँचने हेतु विद्यार्थियों के लिए स्वर्णिम सूत्र''

आज की जीवन शैली का सर्वाधिक वांछित लक्ष्य है सफलता, जो अंतत: यह निश्चित करती है कि किसने क्या खोया क्या पाया। एक सफल व्यक्ति के पास ही सफलता के बंद दरवाजों की चाबी होती है। वह अपने लिए ही नहीं दूसरों के लिए भी कई नए अवसर सृजन कर सकता है।

सफलता के उच्च शिखर पर पहुँच चुके अधिकतर लोग सफलता को कठिन परिश्रम, मनोहारी-व्यक्तित्व, अपने प्रयास के प्रति पूरी ईमानदारी, प्रत्येक उतार चढ़ाव को बर्दाश्त करने की शिक्त की परिणित के रूप में परिभाषित करते हैं। कुछ सफल व्यक्ति इसे ईश्वर की कृपा या फिर किस्मत की अनुकूलता के रूप में स्वीकार करते हैं। फिर भी कुछ सूत्र ऐसे हैं जिन्हे अपनाकर व्यक्ति सफलता के शिखर पर पहुँच सकते हैं।

पहला सूत्र है - लक्ष्य का निर्धारण इसके लिए व्यक्ति को अपनी प्रतिभा व अपनी कमजोरियों के बारे में सजग होकर सोचना पड़ता है लक्ष्य के मार्ग तक पहुँचने के सर्वोत्तम व सहज मार्ग को तैयार करना चाहिए।

दूसरा सूत्र है - संसाधनों का सदुपयोग। एक मानव के रूप में हमें जन्म सें ही कुछ सुविधायें उपलब्ध है जैसे:- भोजन, आवास, स्वास्थय व शिक्षा। इसके अतिरिक्त अभिभावकों व शिक्षकों द्वारा प्रदत्त ज्ञान व विज्ञान का अतुल भंड़ार। सफलता पाने के लिए इन संसाधनों का अधिकतम प्रयोग सोच समझकर, सूझ-बूझ से व संयम के साथ करना चाहिए।

तीसरा सूत्र है - सीखने की चाह। अंहकारी व्यक्ति को अपना लक्ष्य पाने में अनेक बाधाओं का सामना करना पड़ता है। दुनिया का सर्वोत्तम शिक्षक भी ऐसे व्यक्ति में ज्ञान की ज्योति नहीं जला सकता। नए विचारों को सीखने व ग्रहण करने की प्रवृति विकसित करनी चाहिए। ईर्ष्या व द्वेष से दूर रहना चाहिए।

चौथा सूत्र है - सवांद कौशल। अपनी बात को समुचित व सशकत तरीके से प्रस्तुत करना चाहिए। यह हुनर घर व बाहर दोनों जगह उपयोगी है। संक्षिप्त व स्पष्ट भाषा में अपनी बात कहनी चाहिए। पाचंवा सूत्र है - नेतृत्व करने की योग्यता। आत्मविश्वास, विचारों की स्पष्टता व दृढ़ निश्चय वाला व्यक्ति ही सफल नेतृत्व कर सकता है। असफलता को भी साहस के साथ स्वीकार करना चाहिए। अपने अन्दर की प्रतिभा व क्षमता को पहचान कर आगे बढ़ना चाहिये।

छठा सूत्र है - प्रशासनिक कौशल। किसी निर्दिष्ट कार्य को समय पर पूरा करना चाहिए। किसी अन्य व्यक्ति की कार्य क्षमता व गुणवत्ता को कम समय में ही जान लेना भी प्रशासनिक गुण है।

सातवाँ सूत्र है - क्षमा, करूणा व सहयोग की भावना। सफलता की राह पर हमें अनेक बाधाओं का सामना करना पड़ता है। कई बार हम किसी अन्य की गलती के कारण विफल हो जाते हैं ऐसे में क्रोध की अपेक्षा उसे क्षमा कर देना चाहिए। इसके लिए हमें जप व ध्यान करना चाहिए क्योंकि यह काम आसान नहीं है।

आठवा सूत्र है - आत्मविश्वास। प्रत्येक व्यक्ति में आत्मविश्वास भरा पड़ा है। आवश्यकता है उसे जगाने की। इससे सोचने का ढ़ंग भी बदल जाता है। असंभव लगने वाला कार्य भी संभव लगने लगता है। इसके बिना कोई सफलता के शिखर पर नहीं पहुँच सकता।

नवाँ सूत्र है - सही समय पर सही कार्य करना। व्यक्ति को समय का सही व संतुलित प्रयोग करना चाहिए।

दसवाँ सूत्र है - सकारात्मक सोच। सकारात्मक सोच वाला व्यक्ति ही सफलता के शिखर पर पहुँचता है। यद्यपि यह आसान नहीं है। -मैं क्या कर सकता हूँ, कैसे कर सकता हूँ प्रश्नों को मन से निकाल देना चाहिये। इसके स्थान पर मैं सब कुछ कर सकता हूँ कुछ भी असंभव नहीं है। इसे अपनी सोच का अनिवार्य हिस्सा बना लेना चाहिए।

अत: परमात्मा ने प्रत्येक व्यक्ति को प्रगति के समान अवसर प्रदान किए हैं, आवश्यकता सिर्फ उन अवसरों का समुचित रूप से लाभ उठाने की है।

उपर्युक्त सूत्रों को अपनाकर कोई भी व्यक्ति शून्य से शिखर तक की यात्रा तय कर सकता है।

इतने में मियाँ भी आए,


देख मियाँ को सब घबराए।।
