FEE RULES

The school fees is collected in advance on monthly basis which is mandatory. The school fee can also be paid in advance on quarterly basis. For monthly payment of fee, the fees should be deposited by the 10th of every month. The new fee structure will be provided on the PTM day by the Class Teacher along with the Report Card.

Fee is to be paid through cheques/debit cards/credit cards at the school fee counter or through online payment. Cheques are to be drawn in favour of **"Somerville School Greater NOIDA"**. Parents are advised to ensure that the name, class, the admission number of their wards & the mobile number of the parent to be clearly written on the reverse side of the cheque.

TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

Bus fee is charged for 11 months in an academic year. At least one calendar months' notice should be given for the discontinuation of the bus facility or one month's bus fees should be deposited in lieu thereof.

Should any private arrangements be made, the parents must give written information regarding these arrangements on the first day, **3rd April 2023** via mail on **transport@somervillegreaternoida.in** along with a passport size photograph and an ID Proof of the driver/guardian.

Parents must ensure that the children are collected from the school latest by 2:15 p.m.

USE OF IDENTITY CARDS

Students will be issued new Identity Cards in April 2023, after the submission of the form with updated information. It is mandatory to wear the Identity Card to school on a daily basis for identification and ready information. Loss of the ID-card must be reported immediately, to initiate the process of issuing a new one for a charge of Rs.50/- (for Student ID) and Rs.100/- (for parent ID)

SAFETY AND SECURITY

No books, papers, food, water, lunchbox etc. will be received at the school gate/reception. Kindly ensure that you help your ward pack her/his bag as per the time-table given, to avoid carrying extra weight in the school bag.
