Notice for Final Examination 2020-2021 STD- 6 and 7

Dear Parents and Students,

The Final Examination for <u>Classes 6 and 7</u> will be held from <u>26th February to 15th March, 2021</u> through Genius Corner in e-Care Pro app's "ASSESSMENT" section. Kindly pay the fee dues before the commencement of the exam.

Guidelines for the Final Examination: -

- 1. It is important and mandatory for all the students to attempt the Final Examination. No retest will be taken.
- 2. The paper will be of 80 marks for Classes 6 and 7.
- 3. The Exam timings will be as follows:

- 4. You are requested to keep monitoring the timer to be on time and complete the assessment within the allotted time. No student will be able to attempt the test after 1.00 p.m.
- 5. The test will have both Objective (Multiple Choice Questions) as well as Subjective type questions together in one paper. For multiple choice questions, the students will be required to click on the radio button to mark the correct answer. For Subjective type questions students will have to write and upload the image of the answer.
- 6. Students can use the same copy/register which they have used for 2nd Unit Test to write the subjective answers of ALL SUBJECTS on the days of the exam. The students must follow the steps as given below: -
- a) First Write their name, class, roll no., subject and date on the top of the page.
- b) Next, Write the Question number clearly and write the answer in the copy/register. Click the image of the answer.
- c) In Case the answer does not fit in one page then, the student may continue the answer on the next page and click the images of both the page/ pages containing the answer and upload it together.
- d) The images must be uploaded through the "Choose File" option given in the question paper for the same purpose. The size of the image should be less than 5 MB.
- 7. <u>Do not type the answers in the box. Typed answers will not be evaluated.</u>
- 8. While submitting the answers, you are advised not to touch the screen of your phone for at least 3-4 seconds. Wait for the "Submit" button to appear on your screen. After clicking on the "Submit" button a pop-up will come for Confirmation. If you are sure that the correct image/images have been uploaded correctly then click on "Yes" else "No" and recheck your process.

Do not click on the "Submit" button unless you are completely sure that the correct images have been uploaded and you have attempted all the questions (both Objective and Subjective).

- 9. Do the entire process carefully. In Case of any difficulty, you may contact your e-Care Support for the same.
- 10. Students, be honest to yourself while attempting the test.
- 11. Online classes will remain suspended on days of the exam.
