

Meaning: Anathema is something or someone vehemently disliked. If something is anathema to you, you strongly hate it.

Origin: The term comes from the Late Latin anathema, meaning "anything dedicated to evil" via Greek anatithenai (ana meaning "up" + tithenai meaning "to place"). The original Greek meaning of the word was simply "an offering".

The term "anathema" is commonly used without "an" or "the". The first-known use of the term in English was in the early 16th Century.
