

### Word of the day

#### Fanaticism

An oft-used word these days, fanaticism means extreme beliefs that can lead to someone being unreasonable or exhibiting violent behaviour. Informally, it is used to express extreme interest in something, sometimes to a degree that people find unreasonable.

#### Origin

Fanaticism finds its origin in the Latin word fanaticus which originally meant "of or relating to a temple." It was later used to refer to pious individuals inspired by a god or goddess. However, over a period of time "frantic, frenzied, mad" started to be associated with the behaviour of such people because they were thought to be possessed by a deity. That was the first meaning of the word fanatic. In course of time, it came to mean "excessively enthusiastic, especially about religious matters." This was later expanded to simply mean "excessively enthusiastic or unreasonable."

#### Example sentence

Her fanaticism for football knew no bounds as she would religiously sit in front of the television to watch a match the whole night.


