Guidelines for parents

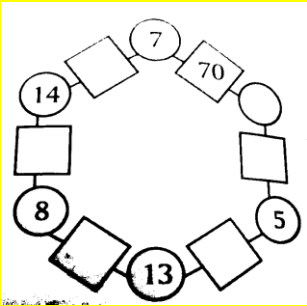
- Watch your child's transformation with a smile of satisfaction.

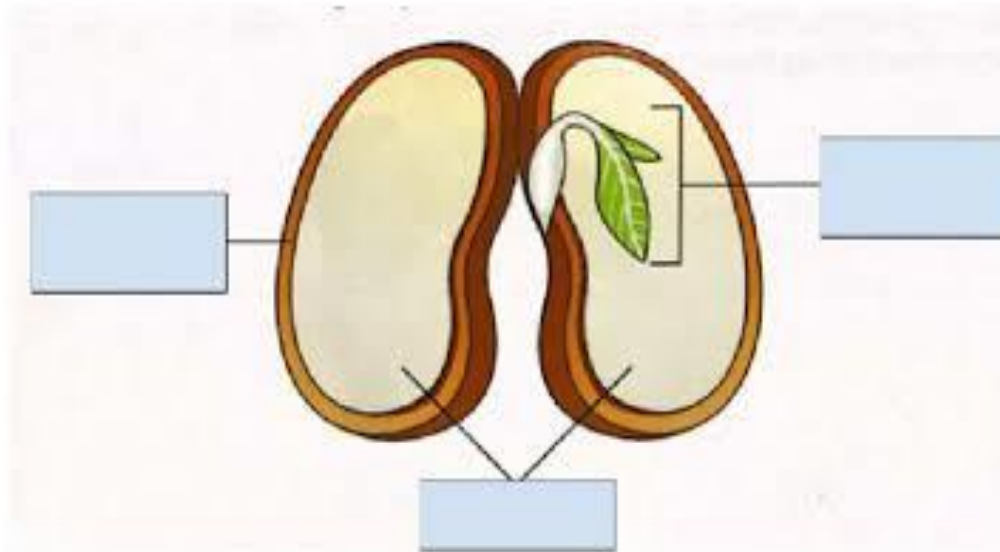
