Q6. Which animal likes to eat honey?

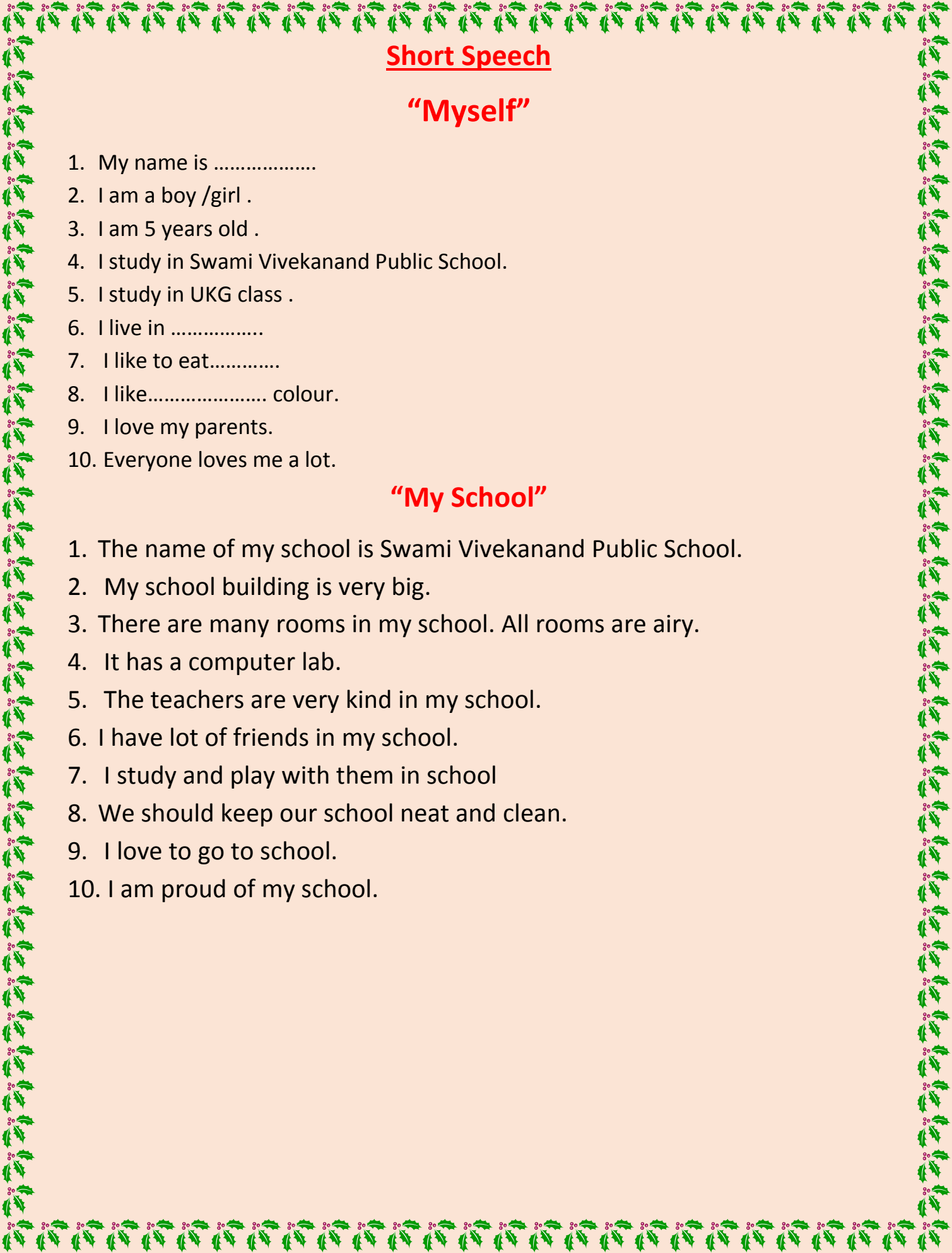
Ans. Bear likes to eat honey.
