Release of the Biography of Fr. Thomas V. Kunnunkal S.J.



We gathered on 3rd July to celebrate two very joyous events. The 96th birthday of our veteran guru and guide, the reason for the existence of this magnificent institution, our most dear Padma Shri Fr. Thomas V. Kunnunkal S.J. and the release of his biography.

Father was the Principal of our school during its nascent stage from 1962 to 1974 and from 1977 to 1979. The school owes its very existence and strong foundation to Father. He went on to hold the prestigious post of the Chairman of the Central Board of Secondary Education from 1980 to 1987, where he brought about some radical changes. The National Institute of Open Schooling is father's brainchild and through this revolutionary move thousands of youngsters were able to receive a good education. The underprivileged and marginalized have always been at the core of his philosophy. He was the Research Director of Indian Social Institute, a Jesuit organization for the promotion of human rights. It was a moment of great pride and joy when Father was honoured with the Padma Shri in 1974 by the President of India. These are only some of the feathers in Father's cap.

The driving force behind the book we released is Padma Shri, Prof. Dinesh Singh. It was his vision that has today turned to reality. It was brought to fruition by several alumni, Pawan Jaggi, Batch of 1980, Sanjiv Puri, Batch of 1982 to name a few. The book has in introduction penned down by Prof. Dinesh Singh and shares beautiful memories of father and gives us a deep insight into his work-ethics and ideology.

We also had in our midst Shri Harsha Vardhana Singh an alumnus of the 1974 batch as our esteemed chief guest. He was the highest ranking Indian at the World Trade Centre's Geneva



headquarters holding the post of Deputy Director General in two separate stints for the period of 20 years. He was the senior advisor to the global commission on Internet Governance, with regard to evolving regulatory functions. These are only a few of the expert engagements of Shri Harsha Vardhana Singh. In keeping with our Jesuit mission of caring for the underprivileged, sir has magnanimously donated for the education of over 300 underprivileged children. After the address of Shri Harsha Vardhana, the book, **'The Biography of a life Extra ordInalre'**, *Remembrances and Reminiscences: Life and Works of Padma Shri Rev. Fr. Thomas V. Kunnunkal S.J.*, by Simmi Sarma was released. This ceremony was attended by our Provincial Fr. Soosai Mani S.J., Rector Fr. Augustine Perumalil S.J., Principal Fr. T.J. Jose S.J., DHF Co-chairperson Dr. Simon Thomas, Doxa members, relatives of Dr. Shekhar Aggarwal and staff members.

Inauguration of Junior School Science Laboratory

In an endeavour to inculcate and develop scientific temperament in the young learners of today, St Xavier's Junior School proudly set its steps into the noble mission of knowledge enhancement with the inauguration of the Science laboratory on 6th July 2022 by Rector Fr. Augustine Perumalil, S.J. in the presence of Headmaster Fr. Britto Madalaimuthu A, S.J., Coordinator of Academics Mr. A. K Das and Asst. Headmistress Mrs. Mona Rae. It was indeed a proud moment, especially for the Science Department. The role of laboratory and field learning becomes a key component in understanding Science. We are really grateful to Principal Dr. Fr. T.J. Jose S.J. for helping us to re-establish the Science lab.

The laboratory is very spacious and can accommodate around 50 students at a time. It is well-equipped with highly advanced microscopes, varieties of permanent slides and beautifully painted and well labelled diagrammatic representations of various specimens along with virtual images of specimens as per CBSE norms so that students can visualize and understand a specimen easily and facilitate a more realistic understanding of the topic. Mrs Pretty Abraham and Miss Rachita Trikha have been appointed as Lab in-charges. We hope this tiny step would go a long way in opening new pathways of inquiry and learning for our students.





Mr. K.J. Devasia Memorial Paper Recycling Plant Inauguration

संस्कृत श्लोक - वाचन प्रतियोगिता 2022-23

संत जेवियर विद्यालय की नीतियों के अनुसार प्रत्येक विद्यार्थी किसी न किसी प्रतिभा से संपन्न होता है और उनकी इन्हीं कलाओं और प्रतिभाओं को सामने लाने का हम सबको प्रयास करना चाहिए। इस के लिए विद्यालय वर्ष भर में अनेक शैक्षणिक गतिविधियों के साथ-साथ अन्य सह पाठ्यक्रम संबंधी गतिविधियों और प्रतियोगिताओं का भी आयोजन करता है।

विभिन्न भाषाओं में होने वाली मौखिक प्रतियोगिताएँ इसी शृंखला की कुछ कड़ियाँ हैं। हिंदी और अंग्रेजी की भाँति संस्कृत में भी हर वर्ष आठवीं कक्षा के लिए संस्कृत श्लोक वाचन प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन किया जाता है, जिससे वे विद्यार्थी सामने आ सकें जो आज भी हमारी सांस्कृतिक विरासत को आगे बढ़ाते हुए संस्कृत भाषा के संरक्षण में अपना योगदान देने को आतुर हैं।

हमारी प्राचीन वैदिक और देवभाषा की इसी धरोहर को संभालते हुए इस वर्ष भी 22 जुलाई 2022 को आठवीं कक्षा के लिए संस्कृत श्लोक-वाचन प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन किया गया, जिसमें अनेक विद्यार्थियों ने बढ़-चढ़कर हिस्सा लिया। इसमें मातृभूमि वंदना के साथ-साथ ईश्वर स्तुतियों और वंदनाओं का भी सुंदर वाचन करके विद्यार्थियों ने, न केवल अपनी बेहतर प्रतिभा का प्रदर्शन किया वरन् अपने देश भारत और उसकी परम पूजनीय संस्कृत भाषा के प्रति भी आदर व्यक्त करते हुए देश भक्ति की भावना को पुष्ट किया।

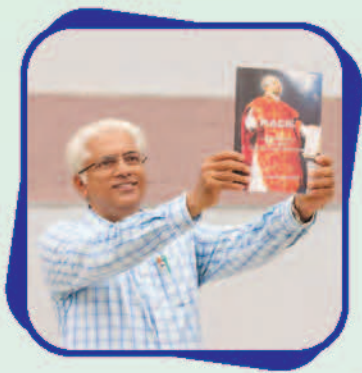
Visit to Orphanage
