ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR Std. 9 (2024-25)

Dear Parents/Guardians (Std. 9),

This circular is to apprise you all about our format of assessment and statement of marks.

Kindly note:

1. Three periodic tests are to be conducted in a year.
2. Mid Term Exam and Annual Exam will be of 3 hours duration and 80 marks each.
3. Internal Assessment has the weightage of 20%.

Our Format of Assessment and Statement of Marks

Internal Assessment

Periodic Test 1 – Maximum Marks - 20 - Conducted in July 2024

Periodic Test 2 – Maximum Marks - 20 - Conducted in August 2024

Periodic Test 3 – Maximum Marks - 20 - To be conducted in November 2024

Using the marks of these periodic tests, Annual Average Periodic Test marks out of 5 marks will be calculated, which will also be a part of the Internal Assessment.

Term 1 - Mid Term Exam – Maximum Marks 80 - conducted as per CBSE curriculum and guidelines in September 2024.

Term 2 - Annual Exam – Maximum Marks 80 - to be conducted as per CBSE curriculum and guidelines in February/March 2025.

Kindly remember that non-submission or late submission of Internal Assessment tasks by your ward will affect his/her Internal Assessment marks adversely.

Annual Report card which will be issued after the Annual Exam will show:

For the 5 main subjects

Breakup of Internal Assessment 20 marks

Mid Term Exam marks converted out of 20 marks

Annual Exam marks converted out of 60 marks

Annual total out of 100 for each subject along with grade as per CBSE guidelines will be reflected in the report card.

For Skill Subject (Physical Activity Trainer)

Mid term Theory: 50 marks to be converted out of 25

Mid term Practical : 50 marks to be converted out of 25

Annual Exam Theory: 50 marks to be converted out of 25

Annual Exam Practical : 50 marks to be converted out of 25

Annual total out of 100 along with grade as per CBSE guidelines will be reflected in the report card.

ANNUAL TOTAL out of 100 AND GRADE

Grade Scale for Scholastic areas is as follows:

Students will also be assessed in Co-Scholastic areas given below. These will be graded in a five point scale (A to E) according to their performance level.

1. Art Education
2. Health & Physical Education (HPE) - Work Education is subsumed
3. Discipline


Annual Report Card as per CBSE requirement will be issued at the end of the academic year. As per CBSE guidelines, in each of the five main subjects, students have to secure 33 marks out of 100 in **Annual Total**. The promotion is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25 percent of marks should be secured in annual exam. In the skill subject, to be declared pass, a student has to secure 33 percent marks in practical and theory exam separately.

Please note :

1. Any modifications or changes announced by the CBSE in future will be incorporated and informed to you.
2. **Marks scored out of 100 by the students in Class 9 along with score of Class 10 out of 100 upto Pre-Board Exams will be considered for the allotment of subject options in Class 11.**
