ACADEMIC ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR CLASS 10 (2024-25)

Dear Parents/Guardians (Std. 10),

This circular is to apprise you all about our format of assessment and statement of marks.

Kindly note:

- Three periodic assessments are to be conducted in a year.
- Mid Term Exam and Pre-Board Exam will be of 3 hours duration and for 80 marks each.
- Internal Assessment for main subjects has the weightage of 20%.

**Our Format of Assessment and Statement of Marks**

Periodic Assessment 1 (PT) – Maximum Marks - 20 - Conducted in July 2024  
(will be converted out of 5)

Periodic Assessment 2 (Mid-term exam) – Maximum Marks - 80 - conducted in September 2024  
(will be converted out of 5)

Periodic Assessment 3 (PT) – Maximum Marks - 20 - To be conducted in November 2024  
(will be converted out of 5)

Using the marks of these Periodic Assessments, Average Periodic Assessment marks out of 5 will be calculated, which will also be a part of the Internal Assessment.

**Mid Term Exam**

- Main Subjects : Maximum Marks – 80.
- Skill Subject : Maximum Marks – 50 Theory, 50 Practicals.  
(Conducted by school as per CBSE curriculum and guidelines in September 2024)

**Pre-Board Exam**

- Main Subjects : Maximum Marks – 80.
- Skill Subject : Maximum Marks – 50 Theory, 50 Practicals.  
(To be conducted by school in January 2025 in the format of Board Exam (CBSE)).

**Kindly remember that non-submission or late submission of Internal Assessment tasks by your ward will affect his/her Internal Assessment marks adversely. Internal Assessment marks will be uploaded on the CBSE portal and will be added to Board Exam score.**

### **ALLOTMENT OF SUBJECT OPTIONS IN Std. 11 (2025-26)**

Marks scored out of 100 by the students in Std. 9 along with score of Std. 10 out of 100 upto Pre-Board Exams will be considered for the allotment of Subjects in Std. 11. Allotment of the different subject options will be strictly in the order of merit and the availability of seats in the option applied for. Request for change of subject option will not be entertained once allotment is done. Kindly consider this matter seriously before the choice is made.


- Option 1 English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and **Mathematics (35 Seats)**
- Option 2 English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and **Psychology (15 Seats)**
- Option 3 English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and **Computer Science (40 Seats)**
- Option 4 English, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and **Economics (10 Seats)**
- Option 5 English, Mathematics, Economics, Business Studies and Accountancy (50 Seats)
- Option 6 English, Accountancy, Business Studies, Informatics Practice and Entrepreneurship (50 Seats)
- Option 7 English, Economics, History, Political Science and **Mathematics (15 Seats)**
- Option 8 English, Economics, History, Political Science and **Psychology (35 Seats)**
- Option 9 English, History, Political Science, Informatics Practices and Psychology (50 Seats)

1. **For Option 1 (Science)**, the student should have a minimum of 70% in aggregate in Science and Mathematics.
2. **For Option 2 (Science)**, the student should have a minimum of 75% in aggregate in Science.
3. **For Option 3 (Science)**, the student should have a minimum of 70% in aggregate in Science and Mathematics.
4. **For Option 4 (Science)**, the student should have a minimum of 75% in aggregate in Science and Mathematics.
5. **For Option 5 (Commerce)**, a minimum of 60% in aggregate in Mathematics is required.
6. **For Option 6 (Commerce)**, a minimum of 50% in aggregate is required.
7. **For Option 7 (Humanities)**, the student should have a minimum of 60% in aggregate in English, Mathematics and Social Sciences.
8. **For Option 8 (Humanities)**, the student should have a minimum of 60% in aggregate in English and Social Sciences.
9. **For Option 9 (Humanities)**, a minimum of 40% in aggregate in English and Social Science is required.

The Application form for the choice of options will be issued in December 2024 and duly filled forms will be collected back in January 2025. Kindly select the subject options according to the aptitude of your ward. Allotment will be done purely on merit. If the form is not submitted on time, it will be presumed that you are not interested in continuing the education of your ward in our School at the Senior Secondary level.
