BOARD EXAMINATION 2026

Class 12: After the pre-Board examination, the 12th graders are now busy preparing for the Board examinations, which will commence on February 17, 2026. Students are also busy with CBSE project viva and practical examinations, which will conclude in the 2nd week of February 2026.

Class 10: The students of class 10 will have board examinations from February 17, 2026 to March 18, 2026. We pray that our children are blessed with good health of mind and body as they attempt these Board examinations, which are an integral part of school life.

THE SCHOOL ANNUAL EXAMINATION

The Prep School will have the Annual Examination on March 2, 6 and 9, 2026.

The Xavier Aptitude Test (XAT) for Junior School students is scheduled to be held on Friday, February 13, 2026.

The annual examination for classes 2 to 7 begins on Saturday, February 21, 2026 and ends on Thursday, March 12, 2026.

The Annual examination for classes 8, 9 and 11 begins on Saturday, February 7, 2026 and ends on Monday, February 23, 2026. Kindly check the school website for the date sheet.

The Physical Education Practical Examination for class 11 has been scheduled for Tuesday, February 3, 2026.

The Project Viva and Practical Examinations of all other subjects for the students of class 11 have been scheduled from 24th February to 2nd March 2026. Practical Schedule will be shared in the class groups and posted on the website.

Kindly note that on February 7, 9, 12, 16, 19, 23, 24, 27 and March 2, 6, 9 and 12, 2026, the school will get over at 12.00 noon. On all other days upto February 21, 2026 the school will get over at the usual time.

The School is organizing a skill enhancement camp for students of Std. 2, 3 and 4 after their annual examinations from March 13 to 24, 2026.

NEW ACADEMIC YEAR (2026 – 27)

The new academic session 2026-27 for Bal Vatika 1 and KG will commence on Monday, April 6, 2026.

The new academic session 2026-27 for class 1 will commence on Thursday, April 9, 2026.

The new academic session 2026-27 for classes 2 to 9 will commence on Monday, April 6, 2026.

The new academic session 2026-27 for Classes 10 and 12 will commence earlier than the date scheduled for other classes. The date of commencement will be announced later.

SUMMER VACATION

Balvatika 1 to Std. 9 and 11: Summer vacations for students will commence from Saturday, May 16, 2026 to Tuesday, June 30, 2026.

Classes 10 and 12: Summer Vacations for students will commence from Saturday, May 30, 2026 to Tuesday, June 30, 2026. Students of classes 10 and 12 are requested to plan their vacation according to the above mentioned dates as teachers will be covering a lot of syllabus during this time.

The School will reopen after summer vacations for all classes on Wednesday, July 1, 2026.

Summer Camp for the Junior school students will be held from Monday, May 18, 2026 to Friday, May 29, 2026.

MOBILES, SMARTWATCHES and RESTRICTED ARTICLES

The Directorate of Education and CBSE have issued directives that the students are strictly prohibited from bringing mobile phones, smart watches and other restricted articles as mentioned in the school diary and on posters displayed in the campus. We would once again like to remind you of the importance of ensuring that your ward adheres to all rules. The safety of our children is of paramount importance and without parental support it is difficult to deal with these major distractions in our children's lives.

SCHOOL FEES

All the parents who have not cleared the pending dues of their ward are requested to do so at the earliest. Owing to the increased expenditure and rising costs, the school management has decided to increase the school fees for the academic session 2026-27. We are trying to provide our children with the state-of-the-art infrastructure to ensure that they receive the highest quality of education in our school. Hence, the increase in the fees is imperative. The Parents have been provided with the option of paying the school fee on a monthly, quarterly or on annual basis. However, according to the option chosen, late fee will be charged starting from 11th day of the month. We urge all parents to pay the school fees on time.

SAFETY POLICY

As per the Safety Policy, all the parents who send their wards by private vans, cars and buses must ensure that updated police verification certificates of all drivers, guards and lady attendants in the vehicles are procured by them and further they are once again advised that the private vans, cars, buses, etc. should also have a lady attendant in the vehicle. Kindly ensure that it is filled correctly. As per the school Safety Policy, it is also mandatory that your ward wears the school Identity Card and carries the school diary to school daily. The safety of our children is of utmost importance and we require the whole-hearted support of parents to ensure this is done.
