Following are the guidelines for examination for Std. 2 issued by The Directorate of Education, GNCT of Delhi. Kindly note the following points in this regard:

Guidelines of Examination for Std. 2 for the Academic Session 2026-27

Regular assessment of the student will be done throughout the academic session, through Periodic Tests, Mid Term Exam and Annual Exam.

- Each Periodic Test will be of 20 marks while Mid Term and Annual Exams will be of 50 marks each.
- Duration of Periodic Tests will be 45 minutes each while duration of Mid Term and Annual Exams will be 2 hours each.
- The question paper for Mid Term Exam will be set out of the syllabus of the First Term. The question paper for Annual Exam will be set out of the syllabus of Second Term.
- In each exam, students will answer all the questions in the space provided in the question paper itself.
