Dear Parents/Guardians (Std. 5)

Following are the guidelines for examination and promotion for Std. 5 issued by The Directorate of Education, GNCT of Delhi. Kindly note the following points in this regard:

**Guidelines of Examination and Promotion for Std. 5 for the Academic Session 2026-27**

**GUIDELINES OF EXAMINATION**

- Regular assessment of the student will be done throughout the academic session, through Periodic Tests, Mid Term Exam and Annual Exam.
- Each Periodic Test will be of 20 marks while Mid Term and Annual Exams will be of 50 marks each.
- Duration of Periodic Tests will be 45 minutes each while duration of Mid Term and Annual Exams will be 2 hours each.
- The question paper for Mid Term Exam will be set out of the syllabus of the First Term. The question paper for Annual Exam will be set out of the syllabus of Second Term.
- In each exam, students will answer all the questions in the space provided in the question paper itself.

**PASSING CRITERIA FOR CLASS 5**

- In order to be declared "PASS" at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a student must score at least 33% marks in each subject (Internal Assessment plus Mid Term Exam plus Annual Exam).
- The promotion to the next higher class is also subject to the condition that a minimum of 25% of marks must be scored in Mid Term plus Annual Exam i.e. 18 marks out of 70 in each subject.

**RE-EXAMINATION FOR CLASS 5**

- If a student is unable to appear for Annual Exam, he/she will have to appear for Re-Exam.
- A student who has appeared in the Annual exam is required to appear in Re-Exam in all the failing subjects.
- Re-Exam will be conducted on the same syllabus and pattern as the Annual exam i.e. 2 hours duration and 50 marks.
- If a student does not secure at least 25% marks in the subject in which he/she has appeared for Re-Exam and a minimum of 33 out of 100 in that subject,

OR

If a student does not appear in Re-Exam, then he/she will be placed in the category of "ESSENTIAL REPEAT" (ER) and will be held back in the same class.

**ATTENDANCE CRITERIA FOR CLASS 5**

- A student will not be eligible to appear in Annual Exam if he/she doesn't have at least 75% attendance calculated from the beginning of the session/ Date of admission till the date of Annual exam.
- Internal Assessment will include 5 marks for attendance.
